



# MAGNUM MOON STAYS PERFECT WITH ARKANSAS DERBY WIN

There are clearly lessons Magnum Moon still needs to learn, as evidenced by the fact that as he reached the Oaklawn Park stretch April 14, both his focus and his stride started to wander.

That the son of Malibu Moon looked every bit like the novice he is while never once appearing to be in danger of losing, however, was the most noteworthy part of the Todd Pletcher trainee's performance.

In a barn bursting with top contenders for the first leg of the Triple Crown, it is the colt who didn't even start his career until January who has accumulated the most qualifying points toward the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1). Despite facing pressure from Quip on the front end and then drifting out several paths in the lane, Robert and Lawana Low's Magnum Moon proved much the best with a gate-to-

wire, four-length victory in the \$1 million Arkansas Derby (G1).

After picking up the 100 qualifying points bestowed to the winner of Saturday's 1 1/8-mile test, Magnum Moon now sits atop the Kentucky Derby leaderboard with 150. Considering how green he was still acting in the stretch, you could argue that if the bay colt gets his mind right by May 5, he could the top dog in a Pletcher armada that includes Xpressbet Florida Derby (G1) winner Audible, Wood Memorial Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (G2) hero Vino Rosso, and Twinspires.com Louisiana Derby (G2) victor Noble Indy.

"I thought (his race) was very good," said Pletcher, whose charges occupy four of the top five positions on the points standings. "Very pleased with the outcome. (I was) a little concerned that he drifted out the last part, but it looked like he sort of halfway thought about jumping over the tire marks when he went by the eighth pole where the gate was and sort of skipped over those.

"I think he was maybe just drifting away from that. Aside from that, I thought he finished with good energy and was pulling away from some nice horses."

Unraced as a juvenile, Magnum Moon began his assault on the so-called 'Curse of Apollo'—no horse since Apollo in 1882 has won the Kentucky Derby without a start as a 2-year-old—when he broke his maiden at first asking at Gulfstream Park Jan. 13. Following an allowance optional-claiming win at Tampa Bay Downs Feb. 15, Magnum Moon let it be known he was a legit contender in a 3-year-old class packed with talent when he captured the March 17 Rebel Stakes (G2) by 3 1/2 lengths over grade 1-placed Solomini.

Even with Solomini back in for the Arkansas Derby and graded stakes winner Quip shipping in for his first try in a top-level test, Magnum Moon was sent off as the clear 4-5 favorite in the ninehorse field Saturday. Jockey Luis Saez said it wasn't necessarily the plan to go to the lead, but his mount took him there when he broke sharply out of post 6 and outran Quip for the advantage going into the first turn.

"I thought there was going to be a little speed," Saez said. "We were in a good position. He broke really sharp. I'm not going to choke him. I am just going to stay there, and he was very comfortable into the turn. He was traveling pretty good. When I came to the stretch, I felt like he was looking at the gate marks, so when we got there, I touched him a little and he went on."

Quip stayed right off Magnum Moon's neck through fractions of :23.34 and :48.60, and he was about on even terms with the pacesetter as they rounded the far turn. Combatant and Solomini tried to join the fight with three- and four-wide moves, respectively, but Magnum Moon made all those challenges futile as he reached the stretch.

"He had me worried to death when I saw we were on the lead. But Luis (Saez) gave him a masterful ride," Robert Low said.

Added Pletcher, "He showed his versatility. He's won a number of different ways now, and I think he's proven that he's the kind of horse that doesn't need the race to unfold a certain way, that he's able to kind of make his own race."

Magnum Moon covered the distance in 1:49.86 over a track rated fast, with Quip holding on for place money. Solomini, who needed a top-three finish to secure enough points to make the Kentucky Derby field, got his head down over Combatant for third despite not switching leads in the stretch.

"He didn't break as sharply as we would have liked. He was third-best today," said Justin Zayat of Zayat Stables, which co-owns Solomini with Coolmore partners. "The winner is a really nice horse. We'll talk to (trainer) Bob (Baffert), but I thought it was

a good race, and now it's on to Kentucky."

Bred by Ramona Bass out of the Unbridled's Song mare Dazzling Song, Magnum Moon bolstered his earnings to \$1,177,800 while remaining unbeaten in four starts. He was purchased by the Lows for \$380,000 from Claiborne Farm's consignment to the 2016 Keeneland September yearling sale. BH

# RUNAWAY GHOST INJURED, WILL MISS KENTUCKY DERBY

oe Peacock's Sunland Derby (G3) winner Runaway Ghost will miss the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1) because of a shin injury, trainer Todd Fincher said April 14.

Fincher said the Ghostzapper colt came out of his timed workout at Sunland Park "sore," and the trainer is "98% sure" the cause is a hairline fracture in one of his shins. Runaway Ghost breezed six furlongs in 1:13 4/5 Saturday in New Mexico.

"It looks like he's got a little fracture in his shin," Fincher said. "He started to show some soreness as we were cooling him out after his work this morning."

Runaway Ghost earned a spot in the Derby with an impressive, 2 3/4-length victory despite a wide trip in the March 25 Sunland Derby.

"The bad news is we're missing the big dance," Fincher said. "The good news is there will be no surgery,



and he's going to be fine. He's going to heal up fine. It's a good thing that it came up now, because if it didn't show until the Derby, they can snap right off."

Runaway Ghost started his career with trainer Mike Machowsky in Southern California, where he broke his maiden in June at second asking. He then shipped to Golden Gate Fields, where he won the Golden Nugget Stakes, and wrapped up his 2-year-old campaign with a last-place run in the Los Alamitos Cash Call Futurity (G1).

After moving to Fincher for his 3-year-old season, Runaway Ghost won the Riley Allison Stakes and finished second in the Mine That Bird Derby, both at Sunland, before his Sunland Derby victory. BH



# LEGENDARY WRITER BILL NACK DIES AT AGE 77

William "Bill" Nack, a renowned sports journalist and author, died April 13 at his home in Washington D.C. after a lengthy illness, according to Secretariat.com. He was 77.

A seven-time media Eclipse Award winner, Nack was best known for his coverage of Secretariat. His acclaimed biography on "Big Red" is considered the definitive account chronicling the history of the Meadow Stable colt and his ascent to the 1973 Triple Crown. The book was used as the inspiration for the 2010 Disney movie "Secretariat."

Nack joined Sports Illustrated in 1978 and became one of the signature voices of the publication. He wrote on everything from racing to boxing to chess. Nack left the magazine in 2001 and freelanced for numerous publications, including ESPN and GQ.

"We are very saddened to learn of Bill's passing. He was as much a part of the Secretariat story as anyone, and his book 'Secretariat: The Making of a Champion' remains the benchmark for excellence in equine journalism," representatives from the Secretariat team, including the Penny Chenery/ Tweedy family, Ron Turcotte, and Secretariat.com said in a statement. "Bill was a master storyteller whose incredible talent was only matched by his vast knowledge in a diverse spectrum of interests, including film and entertainment, poetry and literature, history, politics, and of course his favorite subject—horse racing.

"In this sad time, we take solace in the fact that his legacy, and the legacy he helped shape of Secretariat, live on in the hearts of countless generations of racing fans."

Nack was born in Chicago in 1941 and then moved with his family to Skokie, Ill., at the age of 10. After graduating from the University of Illinois in 1966 and serving in the army, he moved to New York and worked with *Newsday*, covering sports, politics, and the environment for 11 years before joining Sports Illustrated, <u>SI.com</u> reported.

Among the many awards Nack won throughout his career were the ESPN Lifetime Achievement Award for Literary Sportswriting in 2017 and the 1992 Walter Haight Award for career excellence in turf

> writing presented by the National Turf Writers Association. He was inducted into the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame's Joe Hirsch Media Roll of Honor in 2010.

Nack is survived by his wife, Carolyne, and four children. Service arrangements are being determined and will be announced soon.

# WINX MAKES IT 25 STRAIGHT WITH QUEEN ELIZABETH VICTORY

Last of 10 early, Winx unleashed a sweeping move to seize the lead about a furlong from the wire and drew off to a 3 3/4-length win in the April 14 Longines Queen Elizabeth Stakes (G1) at Royal Randwick.

The 6-year-old Street Cry mare matched Australian-based sprinter Black Caviar's 25 straight victories. Black Caviar won all 25 of her races and then was retired. Winx had a 4-3-0 record from 10 starts at the beginning of her career before she began her win streak in May of 2015.

The win capped a huge day for trainer Chris Waller's stable, as Waller and Winx's regular rider Hugh Bowman combined to win James Boag's Premium Australian Oaks (G1) with Unforgotten, while Blake Shinn piloted 17-1 longshot Who Shot Thebarman to victory in the Schweppes Sydney Cup (G1).

It is the second straight year Winx has won the AU\$4 million (about US\$3.1 million) Queen Elizabeth,

and the wins are the two most lucrative of her career. She has won 18 group 1 stakes, and her earnings have moved past AU\$16.5 million.

Winx was followed home by 25-1 longshot Gailo Chop and Happy Clapper, who entered off a group 1 score in the April 7 The Star Doncaster Mile at Randwick after he finished three-quarters of a length behind Winx in March's The Agency George Ryder Stakes (G1). Humidor, who came within a half-length of Winx in last year's Ladbrokes Cox Plate (G1), finished fourth.

Magic Bloodstock Racing, Richard Treweeke, and Debbie Kepitis's Winx completed the 2,000-meter test (about 1 1/4 miles) in 2:01.65.

"This is the most amazing day," said Peter Tighe of Magic Bloodstock, as quoted by multiple outlets. "This is the best horse in the world, with the best jockey in the world, and the best trainer in the world. It seemed the world was on our shoulders today. She just makes us prouder every time she goes around." BH

# SISTERCHARLIE FRESH OFF BENCH IN JENNY WILEY

Her last start was a runner-up finish in the July 8 Belmont Oaks Invitational Stakes (G1T) at Belmont Park, but Peter Brant's Sistercharlie was primed for a big effort off the bench April 14 in the \$350,000 Coolmore Jenny Wiley Stakes (G1T) at Keeneland.

The 4-year-old daughter of Myboycharlie rewarded her team's dedication when she shifted out with a strong rally and won the 1 1/16-mile test on firm turf by 2 1/4 lengths. Her top-level victory came after months spent nursing her back to health from the severe lung infection that derailed the remainder of her 2017 season.

"After her (last) race last year (the Belmont Oaks), she got really sick on us," trainer Chad Brown said. "We have a great team of veterinarians that worked on her. She had a lung infection that turned real bad. We rested her and Peter Brant was very, very patient to give her all that time. My staff did a tremendous job bringing her back after such a lengthy layoff."

Reserved early by Hall of Fame jockey John Velazquez—who collected his 50th Keeneland stakes score—Sistercharlie got a rail-skimming trip mid-pack after favored Dona Bruja shot to the front out of the gate under Jose Ortiz and reeled off fractions of :23.48, :47.76, and 1:12.14 with La Coronel in close pursuit. Leaving

the far turn and approaching the head of the stretch, the two opened a daylight advantage that was quickly eliminated once Sistercharlie made her move.

"I got good position going to the first turn, a position where I wanted to be," Velazquez said. "She sat really well. By the threeeighths pole, I knew I was in a good position—just looking for where I was going to shoot through. I got through ... and had the best horse."

It was the first win in the United States for Sistercharlie. Bred in Ireland by Ecurie Des Monceaux out of the Galileo mare Starlet's Sister, she was a group 3 winner in France and finished second in the 2017 Prix de Diane Longines (G1) before she was imported by Brant.

"She's really matured, and this was really a team effort," Brown said.

The final time on a turf course labeled firm was 1:41.41. The victory increased Sistercharlie's earnings to \$731,403, with four wins and two seconds from seven starts. She returned \$8.80, \$5.40, and \$4.20.

Brown trainees completed the Jenny Wiley trifecta, as Fourstar Crook surged through on the rail to finish second and Off Limits rallied widest of all to claim third. La Coronel finished another halflength back in fourth and was followed in order by Dona Bruja, Cambodia, Kitten's Roar, Proctor's Ledge, Bletchley, Ultra Brat, and Lovely Bernadette. BH

# MY BOY JACK GETS IT DONE IN LEXINGTON STAKES

**B** y a slim margin, My Boy Jack made sure he has another start in the state of Kentucky in his immediate future.

Needing a top-two finish to ensure himself enough qualifying points for the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1), My Boy Jack delivered in the \$200,000 Stonestreet Lexington Stakes (G3) at Keeneland April 14 when he put in a three-wide bid in the lane and caught Telekinesis by a head at the wire.

The 1 1/16-mile Lexington Stakes offered 20 points to the winner on the Road to the Kentucky Derby, a most valuable commodity for the My Boy Jack team. Going into the race, the son of Creative Cause and his 32 points were on the outside looking in, with the Arkansas Derby (G1) also up for grabs Saturday.

When the dust settled on the day's racing action, My Boy Jack had a solid spot on the Kentucky Derby leaderboard at No. 14.

Jockey Kent Desormeaux, who took some heat for his ride on My Boy Jack during the colt's third-place finish in the March 24 Twinspires.com Louisiana Derby (G2), had his timing down just right in the Lexington Stakes. After angling his mount toward the rail out of post 10 to save ground around the first turn, the Hall of Fame rider tucked My Boy Jack into ninth down the backstretch before urging the graded stakes winner to put in a sustained bid on the outside—cementing himself a spot in the gate for the first leg of the Triple Crown.

"He was very, very comfortable in his stride, and that was pretty much a repeat of his last start," Desormeaux said of My Boy Jack. "Fortunately, I didn't grab a hot dog at the quarter pole, and that made the difference."

A stakes winner on turf during his 2-year-old season, My Boy Jack has answered a couple different questions in his transition into a classic hopeful this year. After running third to grade 1 winner McKinzie during his season debut in the Jan. 6 Sham Stakes (G3), the dark bay colt uncorked a 4 1/2-length victory in the Southwest Stakes (G3) over a muddy (sealed) track Feb. 19 at Oaklawn Park.

While he fell three-quarters of a length short in the Louisiana Derby—when trainer Keith Desormeaux said his brother may have hit the 'go' button on the colt too early—My Boy Jack did show he wasn't simply moved up by the off track in the Southwest Stakes.

He backed that up again Saturday, biding his time next to last in the 10-horse field as graded stakes winner Greyvitos led the procession through fractions of :23.28 and :47.11 over a track rated fast. When Greyvitos came off the final turn, it looked as though Telekinesis, surging up the rail, would be his biggest problem.

Telekinesis took a half-length lead in midstretch. But just when he had Greyvitos put away, My Boy Jack and his closing kick came bearing down on him, covering the distance in 1:44.22.

Sent off at odds of 3-2, My Boy Jack paid \$5, \$3.20 and \$2.40.

"Unbelievable. Everyone knows we came here to get points, and he got the job done today," said Kirk Godby, whose Don't Tell My Wife Stables co-owns My Boy Jack with Sol Kumin's Monomoy Stables. "We're just thrilled. When I saw Kent bring him out down the backstretch and we were within six or seven lengths, I felt pretty good about it. I was just hoping he had the gas to get home in the short stretch."

Telekinesis held for second in his graded stakes debut and third career start. The Ontario-bred son of Ghostzapper who finished third against elder horses in an allowance/optional claimer at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots March 9 could be a candidate for the Queen's Plate, according to trainer Mark Casse.

"He is a star. We're just playing catch-up with him right now," Casse said. "What we do with him, I'll have to talk to the Stonestreet team and see, but he rated pretty nice today."

Pony Up rallied after being last early to get up for third, with Greyvitos fourth and Seven Trumpets fifth.

Bred by Brereton Jones out of Mineshaft mare Gold N Shaft, My Boy Jack improved his record to three wins from 10 starts, with earnings of \$645,145. He was purchased by Don't Tell My Wife Stable for \$20,000 out of the 2016 Keeneland September yearling sale. BH

# TRIPLE CHELSEA UPSETS LADY AURELIA IN GIANT'S CAUSEWAY

When Brad Grady and trainer Joe Sharp claimed Triple Chelsea for \$62,500 in September at Kentucky Downs, it was because Sharp thought she looked like a game and versatile runner.

That grit was on display April 14 at Keeneland, where the 5-year-old daughter of Hat Trick dug deep to run down European champion Lady Aurelia in the final sixteenth of the \$100,000 Giant's Causeway Stakes, giving Sharp his first Keeneland stakes score in the process.

In excellent form off a successful winter at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots, where she won the Jan. 6 Pan Zareta Stakes and the March 10 Nelson J. Menard Memorial Overnight Stakes—and finished third in two other black-type events—Triple Chelsea rated off the pace in the 5 1/2-furlong turf sprint, then extended her stride when called upon by jockey Adam Beschizza off the turn for home.

"She's just blossomed since we got her," Sharp said.
"She was in great condition when we got her, and we just found her niche. Adam learned her timing and knew she needed to sit off (the pace) a little bit, and today everything just worked out."

Lady Aurelia, who made her season debut as a 3-5 favorite in a race she won last year, and second choice Morticia dueled for the lead in the early stretch after 116-1 shot Brave Daisey briefly showed the way through a quarter in :22.26. But after Lady Aurelia put away Morticia, 8-1 Triple Chelsea rolled by with powerful momentum to win by 1 1/2 lengths.

The final time was 1:02.40 on a firm turf course, and the winner returned \$18.60, \$5.20, and \$3. Morticia held for third by a length and was followed by Excessivespending and Jennifer Lynnette to complete the top five.

Although Lady Aurelia was defeated in her first start off a 10th in the Nov. 4 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint (G1T) at Del Mar, trainer Wesley Ward was satisfied with her effort off the bench. He said the 4-year-old Scat Daddy filly is on course for a return to Europe for the third straight year. Her international conquests include the 2016 Queen Mary Stakes (G2) and Darley Prix Morny

(G1) and the 2017 King's Stand Stakes (G1).

"She ran a good race, and any time you're coming off a layoff, you're always a little vulnerable," Ward said. "Last year in this race, she was a little more relaxed. Johnny (Velazquez) said that the rider on the longshot (Rogelio Miranda on Brave Daisey) was chirping to his horse and hustling his filly along, and that kind of kept Lady Aurelia from being as relaxed as she was last year. I take nothing away from the winner. She beat us on the square. (Lady Aurelia) hadn't had a race and now she has, so she should be ready."

It was the third stakes victory in four starts this year for Triple Chelsea, who has finished no worse than third since being claimed by her current connections. Bred in Kentucky by Liberty Road Stables out of the Ocean of Wisdom mare Oceane Music, she now has an 8-2-6 record from 20 starts, with \$368,789 in earnings. She was a \$22,000 purchase by Calvin Johnston from Gainesway's consignment to the 2014 Keeneland September yearling sale.

"The race panned out beautifully. She's definitely a filly that likes to be in a nice stalking position, and we were following the right horses into the final eighth," said Beschizza, who also earned his first Keeneland stakes win.

"(She) won two of four at the Fair Grounds," Sharp added. "At this time of year, options for turf sprinting fillies are a little limited. I felt she was in as good form as she's ever been. I wasn't excited to see Lady Aurelia in the entries, but it worked out." BH

# HIGHLAND REEL TO SWETTENHAM FOR SOUTHERN SEASON

The adventures of the globe-trotting Highland Reel are far from over.

In a boost to Australia's stallion ranks, Swettenham Stud has announced the champion son of Galileo will stand in Victoria this spring. Highland Reel retired at the end of 2017 to stand the 2018 season at Coolmore Ireland. Among his wins are the 2016 Longines Breeders' Cup Turf (G1T) and 2015 Secretariat Stakes (G1T), the 2017 and 2015 editions of the Longines Hong Kong Vase (G1), the 2016 QIPCO King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes (G1), the 2017 Prince Of Wales' Stakes, and that year's edition of the Investec Coronation Cup (G1).

"Swettenham Stud is extremely excited to have secured Highland Reel from Coolmore Stud for stallion duties in the Southern Hemisphere," Swettenham Stud principal Adam Sangster said. "And while he might be standing at our Nagambie base, Highland Reel's appeal is truly global."

Highland Reel will join the Swettenham roster at an

introductory fee of \$15,000 plus GST.

"With his tremendous race record and what is clearly a stallion's pedigree, I'm highly confident he will attract broodmare owners from all states, particularly at such a competitive fee," Sangster added.

Highland Reel was a group 2 winner as a 2-year-old and took his seven group 1 victories between the ages of 3 and 5. He campaigned at the highest level in seven countries—including a third behind champion Winx in her 2015 William Hill Cox Plate (G1)—and won nearly €9,500,000 (US\$12,526,459), more than any other European-trained horse in history.

"An incredible horse with pace and courage and tactical speed ... he has everything," trainer Aidan O'Brien said of Highland Reel in a Swettenham release.

The release emphasized the appeal Highland Reel will have for Australian breeders, noting he is bred on the same potent Galileo/Danehill cross as Frankel and Teofilo. Highland Reel is out of the group 1-placed, Australian-bred Danehill mare Hveger, who also produced Highland Reel's full brother Idaho, a dual group 1 winner, and his half brother Valdemoro, runner-up in group 1 company.

Hveger is out of the AJC Australian Oaks (G1) winner Circles of Gold, a genuine blue hen and one of Australia's most influential broodmares.

Highland Reel is also closely related to champion sprinter and leading sire Starspangledbanner (AUS), who campaigned successfully in both hemispheres and has produced groupwinning juveniles in Europe and Australia.

Pedigree expert Brian
Messner added, "His bloodlines
on his dam's side have at least
80% in common with the most
successful proven stallions in
this part of the world, such as
Redoute's Choice and I Am
Invincible." BH

# WHITMORE SURGES LATE TO TAKE COUNT FLEET

It appeared Whitmore would spin his wheels for the entire stretch run of the \$400,000 Count Fleet Sprint Handicap (G<sub>3</sub>) April 14 at Oaklawn Park.

The 5-year-old Pleasantly Perfect gelding brought up the rear as the six-horse field turned for home and wasn't making up much ground, but something changed in the final furlong.

Still last approaching the furlong pole, jockey Ricardo Santana Jr. got Whitmore in the clear on the outside, and a different animal appeared.

With nothing ahead to block his path, Whitmore went from hopeless to a sure winner from the furlong pole to the sixteenth pole and padded his victory with a surge to the wire to win by three-quarters of a length over Wilbo. Whitmore hit the wire in 1:09.77 for six furlongs to clinch his fourth graded win and second straight in the Count Fleet Sprint for owners Southern Springs Stables, Robert

LaPenta, and Head of Plains Partners.

The late-running sprinter trained by Ron Moquett pushed his earnings past \$1.5 million with his second victory of the year following his season debut in the March 10 Hot Springs Stakes at Oaklawn.

"I was really happy with how he did it because he didn't have to use him but the last quarter of a mile, so I was real proud of the way Santana rode him," Moquett said. "We're going to look at our options, obviously, but we've always wanted to try him at Churchill Downs in one of those stakes races there, and hopefully he comes back home there to run in the Breeders' Cup."

Whitmore ran eighth in the Nov. 4 TwinSpires Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) at Del Mar. Bred in Kentucky by John Liviakis out of the Scat Daddy mare Melody's Spirit, he has 10 wins from 18 starts and five other placings.

"I rode the horse before, and he's a class horse," Santana said. "Today, there was a lot of speed, and I wanted to be off of it. His class won out. He ran a really good race. When he got in the clear, he became a different horse. He just blew by them."

> A head behind Wilbo at the wire came Hot Springs runner-up Wynn Time, followed by Smart Spree, Ivan Fallunovalot, and Wings Locked Up.

> Smart Spree, who entered the Count Fleet on a four-race win streak at the allowance and claiming levels, set the pace, covering the first quarter in :21.98 and opening up a one-length lead through a half-mile in :45.64. The speedy Smart Strike gelding still had a length advantage with a furlong to run, but he couldn't hold off the offthe-pace runners in deep stretch. BH

# CITY OF LIGHT EDGES ACCELERATE IN OAKLAWN HANDICAP

The West Coast invaders were in a race of their own when they entered the stretch in the \$750,000 Oaklawn Handicap (G2) April 14 at Oaklawn Park.

At the quarter pole in the 1 1/8-mile test, grade 1 winners City of Light and Accelerate had already blown away a large field of challengers.

Mr. and Mrs. William Warren's City of Light, the last-out Triple Bend Stakes (G1) winner who had made a four-wide move just behind Hronis Racing's Santa Anita Handicap Presented by San Manuel Indian Bingo and Casino (G1) victor Accelerate, put his neck in front as they turned for home, but his rival was not done.

A half-length in front under jockey Drayden Van Dyke with a furlong to run, City of Light could not shake Accelerate, who dug in on the rail under jockey Victor Espinoza but could only cut the margin to a neck at the wire.

"Drayden was able to dictate his trip," said winning trainer Michael McCarthy. "He was loaded at the half-mile pole. At the time I was nervous, because you worry if they are going to show up after the running starts, but when they got to the quarter pole and Drayden hadn't moved his hands, I had the utmost confidence in my horse."

In his first start around two turns, City of Light earned his third straight graded score and finished the distance in 1:48.26. Grade 3 winner Untrapped came in third, another 10 lengths back.

"He broke sharp and put me in a good spot," Van Dyke said. "Down the backside, he was completely loaded, and (I) had a lot of horse the entire way. Just had to wait for the home stretch to let him loose, and he did the rest himself. He's a talented horse, and (I'm) glad I could sit on him."

The two horses based in Southern California immediately had to overcome an obstacle with the outside positions (Accelerate was in post 10 and City of Light was the farthest outside in the field of 11), and Accelerate delayed the start by refusing to enter the gate.

But by the time they reached the backstretch as Untrapped set fractions of :22.97, :46.63, and 1:11.53 through six furlongs, the pair were comfortably tracking the leaders. Accelerate stalked in third while City of Light was wider in fourth, another length back.

"He ran good. It set up like I wanted," Espinoza said.

"He didn't want to load but broke sharp, and I was tracking the leaders. I just couldn't keep up with the winner. He tried to come back pretty good, but I just ran out of room."

Accelerate's trainer, John Sadler, also pointed out that the 5-year-old son of Lookin At Lucky carried three more pounds than his younger rival, a 4-year-old colt by Quality Road.

"First time out of town, and I thought he ran a great race," Sadler said. "I was pleased. Remember, it was a handicap, and we were giving away the weight."

McCarthy indicated earlier in the week that the Oaklawn Handicap could serve as City of Light's steppingstone for the June 9 Runhappy Metropolitan Handicap (G1) at Belmont Park, and he reinforced that after the race Saturday.

"We'll enjoy this—certainly for today," McCarthy said.
"Two months from now we've got the Met Mile, which has been in the back of our minds. That might be the next logical step. The Breeders' Cup at the end of the year is our main goal."

After Untrapped came Sonneteer in fourth, followed by Lookin At Lee, Malibu Max, Hawaakom, Colonelsdarktemper, Blueridge Traveler, and Hedge Fund to complete the order of finish. Inside Straight, last year's Oaklawn Handicap winner, refused to leave the gate at the start.

Bred in Kentucky by Ann Marie Farm, out of the Dehere mare Paris Notion, City of Light has four wins and three seconds from seven starts, with \$940,600 in earnings. He was a \$710,000 purchase in 2015 from the Lane's End consignment to the Keeneland September yearling sale. BH

According to OBS, since the

beginning of 2017, graduates of the April sale have won or placed in 341 stakes races and have accounted for 127 stakes victories, including 34 graded stakes wins (data through April 13). BH

# ALIZEE RALLIES TO VICTORY IN COOLMORE LEGACY

Godolphin's Alizee came from last to first in a 17-horse field to win the AU\$1.1 million Coolmore Legacy Stakes (G1) April 14 at Royal Randwick in Australia by two lengths over Prompt Response.

With the win over older fillies and mares going a mile, Alizee earned an automatic berth into the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (G1T) through the International Breeders' Cup Challenge.

Trained by James Cummings and ridden by Glyn Schofield, Alizee earned her second group 1 victory and fifth career win. The bay daughter of Sepoy out of Essaouira by Exceed And Excel won the one-mile Flight Stakes (G1) against 3-year-old fillies Sept. 30.

Alizee, the only 3-year-old filly in Saturday's race, broke from post 8 at odds of 7-1. She settled toward

the rear of the pack and maintained that position approaching the far turn before Schofield angled her wide with 300 meters remaining. Passing runners inside the 100-meter mark, she drew on even terms with Prompt Response and continued her powerful drive through the wire. Alizee finished in 1:34.94.



# GUSTAV KLIMT TAKES IRISH 2,000 GUINEAS TRIAL STAKES

ustav Klimt gave Aidan O'Brien a third consecutive win in the Ballylinch Stud Two Thousand Guineas Trial Stakes at Leopardstown April 14, coming home strongly to beat Imaging by 1 3/4 lengths.

His stablemate and last year's European champion 2-year-old U S Navy Flag disappointed, trailing home last of the four runners.

The winner, sent off as the 6-4 favorite, was held up by jockey Ryan Moore for much of the race before being switched out and asked for effort in mid-stretch. The son of Galileo pulled away inside the final furlong and finished in 1:38.60 for the seven-furlong test on the heavy turf.

Gustav Klimt, racing in the colors of Coolmore-associated owners Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor, and Derrick Smith, made his first start since winning the Bet365 Superlative Stakes (G2) at Newmarket in July. He will likely be aimed toward the May 5 QIPCO Two Thousand Guineas Stakes (G1).

"The ground was far from ideal, but it was nice to

get a run into him ... and Ryan was very happy with him," O'Brien said. "Ryan said he was very impressed with how the horse quickened, especially on that ground, as he's a real quick-ground horse. The plan is to go straight to Newmarket now, all being well."

U S Navy Flag was content to track the pace for much of the race, but the Kentucky-bred War Front colt found very little once jockey Seamie Heffernan asked him to challenge. This was a second consecutive setback for the dual group 1 winner, who finished his 2-year-old campaign with a distant 10th in the Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) on the dirt at Del Mar.

The runner-up, Dermot Weld's Imaging, led for much of the straight but couldn't match the class of the winner in the closing stages. Kenya (also trained by O'Brien) was asked to set the pace before dropping out of contention in the final two furlongs and finishing a well-beaten third.

"U S Navy Flag we knew would hate the ground, but he needed to get him out, and Kenya will stay further," O'Brien said. "I'd say Kenya could go for a Derby trial, and U S Navy Flag might go to the English or French Guineas, and he'll grow another leg between now and then." BH
