

FLETCHER KICK-STARTS OBS SALE WITH \$800,000 FILLY

A Quality Road filly from the family of top sire and dual Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) winner Tiznow set the bar at \$800,000 during the opening session April 24 of the four-day Ocala Breeders' Sales April 2-year-olds in training sale.

Owner/breeder Frank Fletcher bought the filly (Hip 95), offered by Eddie Woods as agent. She was bred in Kentucky by John Gunther, Eurowest Bloodstock, and Celebre Investments, and is out of the Medgalia d'Oro daughter Betty Brite, whose dam is Balboa Betty—a sister to Tiznow, Budroyale, Tizdubai, and Tizbud.

"She's a beautiful filly, a big, tall, elegant, good-moving thing," Woods said of the session-topper that Gunther's Glennwood Farm offered at the 2017 Keeneland September yearling sale and bought back on a final bid of \$190,000. "She worked in the worst of it last Monday when it was the windiest and coldest. She worked OK, but she galloped out really, really good."

Woods said the filly still has some growing to do and suspects she may be at her best at 3.

"She is plenty tall and will get taller. She is going to need to fill out more, though she has filled out considerably from when she was with us," he said.

The April 24 session was the first time in several years that Fletcher, who lives in North Little Rock, Ark., has been in the OBS pavilion to bid on a horse.

"I have been buying colts down here for years and decided this year I needed to buy some ladies," Fletcher said.

The filly came highly recommended by Woods, who is breaking and training some other horses Fletcher acquired as yearlings. Bloodstock agent Donato Lanni and trainer Al Stall Jr., who were attending the sale with Fletcher, also gave their support.

"I was hoping for \$400,000-\$500,000, and I don't know who was sitting behind us, but they were bidding pretty hard," Fletcher said. "We are excited. It is always a gamble, but it is a fun business. I travel all over the country going to races. This is what I do for fun."

The sale began solidly, with OBS reporting 151 horses

sold for a total of \$15,083,000 compared with 185 sold during the comparable session of 2017 for a total of \$15,675,700. The opening session average price was \$99,887, up 17.9% compared to \$84,734 in 2017 while the median price was \$55,000, up 14.6% compared with \$48,000 a year ago. The buy-back rate was 28.1%, while the rate was 16.7% last year.

Consignors on opening day sold 22 horses for \$200,000 or more compared with the same session of 2017 when 26 horses sold in this price range.


- Hip 144, a son of Strong Mandate consigned by Randy Miles, agent, went to owners Alex and JoAnn Lieblong for \$550,000 (see page 7).
- Hip 23, a daughter of Arch consigned by Off the Hook, agent, was sold to Steve Young, agent, for \$475,000. The dark bay or brown filly, that breezed an eighth at the under tack show in :10 2/5, is a half sister to graded stakes winner Zivo out of American Skipper, by Quiet American (see page 13).
- Hip 245, a bay colt by Big Drama, also brought \$475,000 from Klaravich Stable out of the Eisaman Equine consignment. He's a half brother to stakes winner Surplus Singer out of black type winner Daisy Dukes, by Ghazi.
- Hip 199, a daughter of Bernardini consigned by Niall Brennan Stables as agent, was bought by agent Mike Ryan for \$410,000. The gray or roan filly that worked an eighth in :10 2/5, is a half sister to stakes placed C J's Awesome (Awesome Again) out of graded stakes-placed winner C J's Leelee, by Mizzen Mast.

The sale continues April 25-27, starting at 10:30 a.m. EDT daily. BH




onsignor Randy Miles could not have more surprised when Hip 144, a colt by Strong Mandate he offered during the April 24 opening session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales April 2-year-olds in training sale, became the day's top-selling colt at \$550,000.

But it wasn't the price that surprised him, it was the buyer.

Owner Alex Lieblong, a client of Miles', acquired the strapping dark bay or brown colt but had not offered so much as a hint that he was interested. Miles breaks about seven to 10 horses for Lieblong annually.

"He would come to the farm periodically and would see this horse, but he never said a word to us. He never showed any interest, so when he purchased the horse it was a real shock," Miles said. "I saw Alex after he had signed the ticket, and he got a chuckle out of it. He said he likes to fly under the radar, and he definitely did."


Miles bought the Strong Mandate colt for \$60,000 at last fall's Fasig-Tipton October yearling sale under the name Royal Flush Racing out of Jim and Pam Robinson's Brandywine Farm consignment.

"We know what we want at the yearling sales, and they can't be the same ones everyone else is on," Miles said. "We have to find the ones that have redeeming qualities but are just not showing it at that time. We stretched (on the price) for this horse, but we could see what he was. No doubt. He was well put together. He had the look in his eye. He was the horse we wanted."

The colt out of the winning Majestic Warrior mare Callous Effect also was one of the few of Strong Mandate's first yearlings that Miles said just fit within his budget.

"We have been a fan for a while," Miles said of Strong Mandate, who stands at Three Chimneys Farm. "We think he'll make a statement at the racetrack this summer and fall. The ones we had were all very precocious. They were strong, they were quick, and have good minds. This colt accepted everything, did his job, and was happy to do it. That is what we like to see in young horses."

Lieblong said he liked this colt because he worked in :10 despite a brisk headwind during the under tack show.


"Any horse that can work :10 flat in a wind that was at least 10 mph, and they were telling me was higher, is taking a big step up," Lieblong said. "All the Strong Mandates I've seen have been gorgeous, and you just don't expect that big of a robust horse to be that athletic that early. He certainly has been."

Lieblong also said he puts a lot of weight in the recommendations of Bo Hunt, who works with Miles and Miles' wife Dr. Lisa Casinella.

"Bo breaks a lot of my horses. When I am buying off of Bo, I have complete faith," said Lieblong, who added that he is sending the colt to trainer Ron Moquett.

"Hopefully, he'll be a 2-year-old but if he is a 3-year-old, that's OK. If you don't wait on them, they'll make you wait," the owner said. BH

Adark bay filly from the final crop of top sire Arch got the Ocala Breeders' Sales April 2-year-olds in training sale off to a fast start April 24, selling for \$475,000 to bloodstock agent Steve Young on behalf of an undisclosed client.

Joe Appelbaum's Off the Hook consignment sold the filly that is out of the winning Quiet American mare American Skipper. The Arch filly (Hip 23) is a half sister to grade 1-placed, graded stakes winner Zivo.


"She is a beautiful-moving filly that breezed great on the day that had inclement weather, on an inclement track," Young said of the filly's work in :10 2/5. "She is a two-turn filly that worked with a lot of quality. There are no more Arch mares, and he's a sire everyone knows how much I like. I think she can be anything."

HALF BROTHER TO CHAMPION GOOD MAGIC ONE TO WATCH AT OBS

E uropean owner and investment banker Paul Roy had a straightforward plan when he acquired Wicked Wizard, a 2-year-old son of Speightstown out of stakes winner Glinda the Good for \$200,000 at the 2017 Keeneland September yearling sale. He shipped the colt bred by Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings overseas to race in England.

Then the colt's half brother, a son of Curlin named Good Magic, broke his maiden in the Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) and was named the Eclipse champion 2-year-old for 2017. A pedigree update of that magnitude could not be ignored.

"Obviously the brother is a very, very good horse, and the pedigree is live," said Niall Brennan, who has Wicked Wizard in his consignment as Hip 403 in the Ocala Breeders' Sales April 2-year-olds in training sale, which started April 24 and continues through April 27. The colt will be offered in the first half of the sale's second session April 25.

Wicked Wizard arrived at Brennan's training center between Christmas and New Year's Day to begin preparing for the April sale.

"It was the only sale he could make and have a chance. He was only just under tack," said Brennan.
"He's made amazing progress to get here considering all the travel back and forth, but he has knuckled down in his training and done very well. He's growing, he's improved, and he's gotten stronger."

Good Magic also has done his part to continue improving the pedigree. Co-owned by Bob Edwards' e Five Racing and breeder Stonestreet Stables, the

colt finished third in the Xpressbet Fountain of Youth Stakes (G2) in his 2018 debut and locked up a place in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1) starting gate by winning the Toyota Blue Grass Stakes (G2).

Brennan said Wicked Wizard reminds him of many of the Speightstown progeny he's worked with previously.

"Speightstown speaks for himself as a stallion. He's a great stallion," he said. "I have always liked them because they are very genuine, and this colt is very much like that. They are obviously athletic and come in different shapes and sizes, and he puts the heart and the ability into them. They have speed, but they can stretch out as well. This horse has speed, he's shown that, but he has the pedigree to stretch out. I know this colt has a ton more improvement in him as he goes down the road."

"The colt has handled it all mentally and physically," Brennan continued. "Now we'll see how the market accepts that. Obviously we like the colt a lot. They are happy to race him if the market is not here to buy him." BH



TIZNOW FILLY TOPS OBS DAY 3 PINHOOK PROSPECTS

A Tiznow filly purchased for \$275,000 as a yearling tops the pinhook prospects based on previous purchase price cataloged for April 26 third session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales spring 2-year-olds in training sale.

Consigned by Niall Brennan Stables, agent, as Hip 641, the filly was bought by agent Mike Ryan from the Taylor Made Sales Agency consignment to last year's Keeneland September yearling sale. She previously had been purchased by Blue Sky Thoroughbreds for \$130,000 when offered by Taylor Made as a weanling at the 2016 Keeneland November auction.

The filly bred in Kentucky by George Saufley and Frederick Allor is out of the stakes-placed Distorted Humor mare Mary Rita. Her third dam is Broodmare of the Year Personal Ensign, the undefeated champion whose offspring include grade 1 winners My Flag, Miner's Mark, and Traditionally. Personal Ensign is

the granddam of champion Storm Flag Flying, among other graded stakes winners.

GRONKOWSKI CONNECTIONS TARGET BELMONT STAKES

While an ill-timed illness knocked him out of consideration for the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1), the connections of stakes winner Gronkowski plan to point him to the Belmont Stakes (G1).

Phoenix Thoroughbreds announced April 24 that Gronkowski, a 3-year-old colt who finished atop the European Road to the Kentucky Derby standings, will resume training next week in preparation for his U.S. debut in the final leg of the Triple Crown June 9 at Belmont Park.

The Phoenix team was forced to bypass the May 5 Kentucky Derby after the horse experienced a minor infection, which prevented his travel from Newmarket, England, to Kentucky. The horse is now on antibiotics and is expected back on the track early next week.

"Gronkowski the horse is recovering very well from a small infection," said Tom Ludt, vice president of equine operations for Phoenix Thoroughbreds. "He's extremely strong and we are excited about getting him to the U.S. to compete at the Belmont."

The Phoenix team, which now includes the colt's co-owner, New England Patriots all-pro tight end and two-time Super Bowl champion Rob Gronkowski, expects the horse to make a big impact on American racing. In addition to the Belmont, the Phoenix team has its eyes set on this year's Breeders' Cup Classic

(G1) at Churchill Downs.

Rob Gronkowski recently acquired an interest in his namesake racehorse and was planning to travel to the Derby to meet the colt for the first time.

"This horse is a fighter and a winner," Gronkowski said. "As an athlete, I understand the need for rest and recovery time. I'm glad that he's recovering quickly, and I look forward to meeting him soon and taking some selfies!"

Gronkowski the horse was sired by champion Lonhro, and was bred in Kentucky by Epic Thoroughbreds as the first foal from the Lookin At Lucky mare Four Sugars. Phoenix Thoroughbreds, founded by Dubai-based businessman Amer Abdulaziz, purchased Gronkowski through Lynn Lodge Stud's consignment to the 2017 Tattersalls Craven breeze-up sale, where agent Kerri Radcliffe signed the ticket for the equivalent of US\$404,492. BH



He was in an open gallop to the pole with his ears up and couldn't be going any smoother, reaching out powerfully with head and neck extended and the rider well up in the saddle.

3 | JUSTIFY 🙈

There isn't much to say about his 1:13 1/5 six-furlong work in company April 21 other than it was pretty much like his previous works. He is one of the most consistent workers you'll see. As usual, he broke off a couple of lengths behind his workmate, collared him just before the wire, and left him far behind on the gallop-out.

Audible, not known as a big worker, broke off on the inside and was doing everything easily, while 4-year-old Patch, on his wrong lead, was being urged on and had the whip shaken at him and still could barely keep up. Let's call it a big work for Audible.

5 | MAGNUM MOON 🙈

Todd Pletcher/Lawana and Robert E. Low Malibu Moon—Dazzling Song, by Unbridled's Song Ramona S. Bass (KY)

This colt is a pure athlete. He has beautiful action, intelligence, does everything asked of him, and has a "puppy dog" disposition, according to Jacob West, who picked him out as a yearling. No wonder Pletcher's father, J.J., who broke him and gave him his early training, told his son this was one of the best horses he's ever had at the farm.

6 BOLT D'ORO

Mick Ruis/Ruis Racing Medaglia d'Oro—Globe Trot, by A.P. Indy WinStar Farm (KY)

So much for his two races this year possibly taking too much out of him. He certainly quashed that theory April 22 with his rapid-fire seven-furlong work in 1:24 1/5, with fractions of :35, :46 3/5, :58 4/5, and 1:11 2/5. I'm just not sure I want to see that much early speed, with each eighth slower than the one before. I prefer to see that reversed.

7 MENDELSSOHN 🛧

Aidan O'Brien/Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier, and Michael Tabor Scat Daddy—Leslie's Lady, by Tricky Creek Clarkland Farm (KY)

As the baby of the bunch, born May 17, he was still very immature early on and didn't really find himself until O'Brien added blinkers. Now he is a "very cool character and takes everything in stride," according to O'Brien. He has excelled on grass, synthetic, and dirt, and his UAE Derby Sponsored by Saeed & Mohammed Al Naboodah Group (G2) was the jaw-dropper of the year. Who knows what we're dealing with?

8 | FREE DROP BILLY 🙈

Dale Romans/Albaugh Family Stables Union Rags—Trensa, by Giant's Causeway Helen K, Groves Revocable Trust (KY)

He has been ranked as high as No. 5, and between his bullet work in :59 breezing April 21 at Churchill Downs, the trip he had in the Toyota Blue



Free Drop Billy checks in at No. 8 on this week's Derby Dozen

Grass Stakes (G2), where he ran 67 feet farther than runner-up Flameaway and was bothered badly by Sporting Chance, and running his career best Thoro-Graph number, I feel he is live at a big price.

9 | MY BOY JACK 🖟

Keith Desormeaux/Don't Tell My Wife Stables, Monomoy Stables, and West Point Thoroughbreds Creative Cause—Gold N Shaft, by Mineshaft Brereton C. Jones (KY)

After his third-place finish in the Sham Stakes (G₃), his Thoro-Graph number jumped a whopping six points in his Southwest Stakes (G₃) score. He has now run the exact same number three races in a row. While that number might not be quite good enough to win the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G₁), he likely will not regress and could easily improve going 1 1/4 miles.

10 | FLAMEAWAY 🙈

Mark Casse/John C. Oxley Scat Daddy—Vulcan Rose, by Fusaichi Pegasus Phoenix Rising Farms (ON)

He turned in a five-furlong work April 21 in a sharp 1:00 2/5 at Churchill Downs. This was an important work for him, considering his only truly bad effort has been at Churchill. But we do know he runs well on fast, sloppy, and muddy

dirt tracks and grass, so we'll put a line through his Iroquois Stakes (G3) performance from last September. He is as consistent and versatile as they come.

11 | NOBLE INDY

Todd Pletcher/WinStar Farm and Repole Stable Take Charge Indy—Noble Maz, by Storm Boot WinStar Farm (KY)

Pletcher normally doesn't work horses six furlongs, but his three-quarter breeze April 20 in 1:15 no doubt is the result of the six-week layoff since the TwinSpires.com Louisiana Derby (G2). While he did it easily enough, his workmate was totally overmatched and couldn't keep up with him, despite feeling the whip at the head of the stretch.

12 | ENTICED

He turned in a five-furlong work April 19 in a solid 1:01 1/5, working in company with stakes-winning Take Charge Paula. Breaking off outside the filly, they were on equal terms until Enticed's rider asked him to go nearing the wire and he shot to a length advantage and galloped out well. He does carry his head high and has high knee action.

Rockingham Ranch and David Bernsen's Bobby Abu Dhabi registered a career-best ESF for the third straight race when he posted a clear victory in the Kona Gold Stakes (G2) at Santa Anita Park. The 4-yearold son of Macho Uno completed the 6 1/2-furlong test in 1:15.40 to secure the first graded stakes win of his career under jockey Victor Espinoza.

Abu Dhabi closed out last season with a victory in an allowance-optional claiming race at Santa Anita before opening this year with a runner-up finish to City of Light in the Triple Bend Stakes (G1) ahead of his Kona Gold win Saturday.

OTTBS READY FOR KY THREE-DAY EVENT

While fans near and far will notice a change at the Kentucky Three-Day Event this year with Land Rover taking over the title sponsorship from Rolex, one thing won't change ... off-track Thoroughbreds coming to Kentucky to compete at the event in the heart of Thoroughbred country.

Fifty-two horses of many different breeds will represent nine different countries at this year's event, held April 26—29 in Lexington at the Kentucky Horse Park.

Michael Jung and his wondermare fischerRocana FST, representing Germany, lead the entries and will be trying to win their fourth straight Kentucky Three-Day Event. While fischerRocana FST isn't a full Thoroughbred, she does have a connection to the Kentucky Derby, which will be held the following weekend. Her sire, Ituango, was a stakes winner on the racetrack and her grandsire, Acatenango, is the broodmare sire of 2011 Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (G1) winner Animal Kingdom.

If you're looking for pure Thoroughbreds to root for—especially those who have run a time or two (or 36 in the case of Boyd Martin's Steady Eddie)—don't

despair. As of April 23, 15 Thoroughbreds, including 11 OTTBs, are scheduled to take part in the event.

More Inspiration was the top-placed OTTB last year and looks to build on that 26th-place finish in 2018 after finishing in the top seven in his past two events over the past few months in preparation for this performance.

He leads a group of OTTBs that made a combined 178 starts for 13 wins, 12 seconds, and 15 thirds for \$126,271 in earnings. A warhorse of sorts, More Inspiration raced 28 times in his career with a respectable four wins to earn the distinction of being the highest earning OTTB at the event this year with \$55,560 earned on the track.

Overall, More Inspiration is one of just four

Thoroughbreds returning to Kentucky after showing here last year, although Donner has competed at this event multiple times before and even finished fifth in 2013. Kelecyn Cognac has been entered two previous times but been withdrawn before the event started, even arriving at the Kentucky Horse Park last year before coming down with a fever.

Simply Priceless, who finished eighth here in 2016, holds the honor


of being the oldest OTTB competing at the Kentucky Three-Day event this year at 16 years of age while Johnny Royale will be making his four-star debut (the highest level of eventing) at 9 years of age.

If you want a little extra Kentucky Derby flavoring, Kelecyn Cognac was sired by 2000 Kentucky Derby winner Fusaichi Pegasus while Tactical Maneuver is by the late 1995 Kentucky Derby winner Thunder Gulch with his dam a granddaughter of both 1985 Kentucky Derby winner Spend a Buck and 1978 Triple Crown runner-up Alydar as well as a great-granddaughter of 1973 Triple Crown winner Secretariat.

Other contenders with close Triple Crown connections are AP Prime, who is a grandson of 1992

Belmont Stakes (G1) winner A.P. Indy; Indy 500, who has Triple Crown connections on both sides with her sire by A.P. Indy and her dam by 1985 Kentucky Derby winner Spend a Buck; and the unraced Mettraise, who is a granddaughter of Seattle Slew and was the overall highest-placed Thoroughbred at this event last year.

If an OTTB can win the Kentucky Three-Day this year, they'll end a drought that has lasted since 2012 when Parklane Hawk and William Fox-Pitt won. An even longer drought will be ended if the event is won by one of the 12 U.S. riders with a Thoroughbred (or any of the Americans on other breeds) as the last U.S. rider to win the Kentucky Three-Day Event was racehorse owner and OTTB friend Phillip Dutton who won in 2008. Dutton has two horses entered for the event, though neither is a Thoroughbred.

PEDIGREE ANALYSIS: PRIMAL FORCE'S IMPACT EXTENDS

all of Famer Bill Mott once described Primal Force as "the fastest mare he'd ever trained." It was that comment, made to Andy Stronach, that prompted Frank Stronach to purchase the daughter of Blushing Groom—Prime Prospect by Mr. Prospector for \$95,000 from the Firestone dispersal at the 1992 Keeneland January horses of all ages sale.

Although Primal Force never earned black type, her race record did show four wins in six starts at three, all between February and July. She went to the sideline after taking a Belmont Park allowance on the last of those outings, and wasn't seen again in public until 16 months later, but the spark was seemingly gone, as two starts brought nothing better than a third and a fourth in allowance events.

If Primal Force's race-record was one of unfilled promise, she certainly made up for that as a broodmare. For Stronach's Adena Springs, she produced not only Awesome Again, who took the 1998 Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) over one of the strongest fields assembled for this event, but also 2000 Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) victor and champion 2-year-old colt Macho Uno.

The most recent weekend saw the progeny of Awesome Again and Macho Uno capture two of the

three most valuable contests run in that period, with the \$1,150,000 Charles Town Classic Stakes (G2) going to the 7-year-old Awesome Again gelding Something Awesome, and the Kona Gold Stakes (G2) being claimed by Macho Uno's 4-year-old son Bobby Abu Dhabi.

Something Awesome's victory placed him just under \$100,000 shy of becoming the 11th of Awesome Again's offspring to earn millionaire status. That list also includes Horse of the Year Ghostzapper, one of the most talented performers to race in the U.S. in the 21st

century; champion older mare Ginger Punch; eighttime grade 1 scorer Game On Dude; Preakness Stakes (G1) victor Oxbow; Paynter, successful in the Haskell Invitational Stakes (G1); Bessemer Trust Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) captor Wilko; and Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1) heroine Round Pond.

Something Awesome's dam, Somethingaboutlaura (by the Star de Naskra horse Dance Floor), won 18 of 34 starts including 14 black-type events, among them back-to-back wins in the A Gleam Invitational Handicap (G2). With career earnings of \$1,129,365, Somethingaboutlaura is the only stakes winner in the first three dams of Something Awesome, but she does have an interesting pedigree as her dam is inbred 3x4 to Somethingaboutlaura's fifth dam, Nato II, through the similarly-bred half sisters Articana (dam of Somethingaboutlaura's broodmare sire, It's Freezing) and We Try Harder (fourth dam of Somethingaboutlaura).

Whereas Something Awesome was making his 24th start Saturday, Bobby Abu Dhabi had just seven previous outings under his belt. The Kona Gold was his first black-type victory, although he'd demonstrated top-class form with a second in the Triple Bend Stakes (G1) in his previous outing. Bobby Abu Dhabi is the 34th stakes winner, and 14th graded winner for Macho Uno. His best also include the Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) winner Mucho Macho Man, multiple grade 1 winner Private Zone, and other grade 1 winners Macho Again and Wicked Style.

Bobby Abu Dhabi's dam, Wadena, is by Saint Ballado out of Ammy Hils, a graded stakes-winning half sister to Silver Wizard—a multiple listed winner in England and a grade 2 scorer in the U.S. He owns an interesting pedigree pattern as he's linebred 5x4 to French champion 2-year-old Grey Dawn II, a horse bred on the Herbager/Mahmoud cross, like Ballade, the dam of Saint Ballado.


