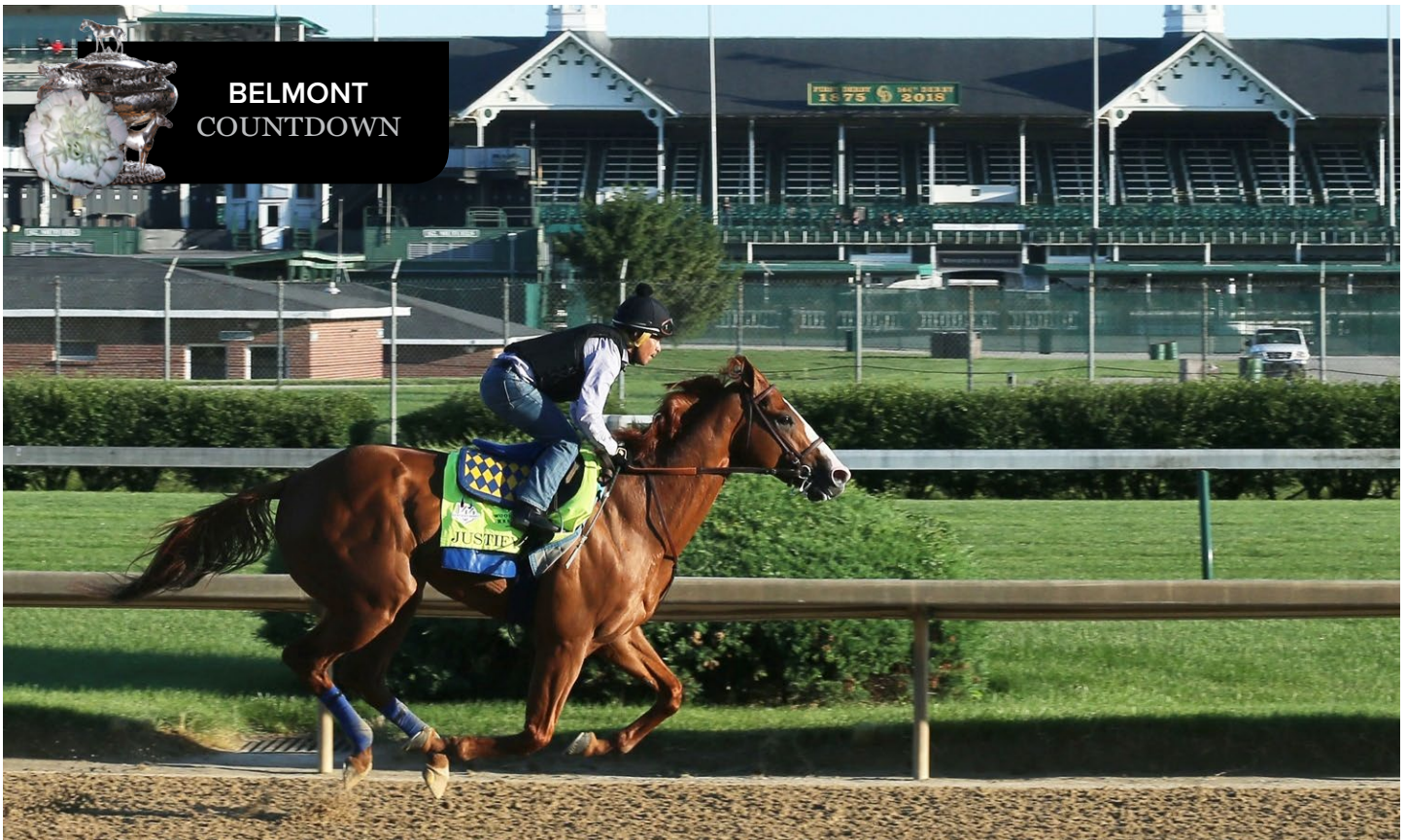

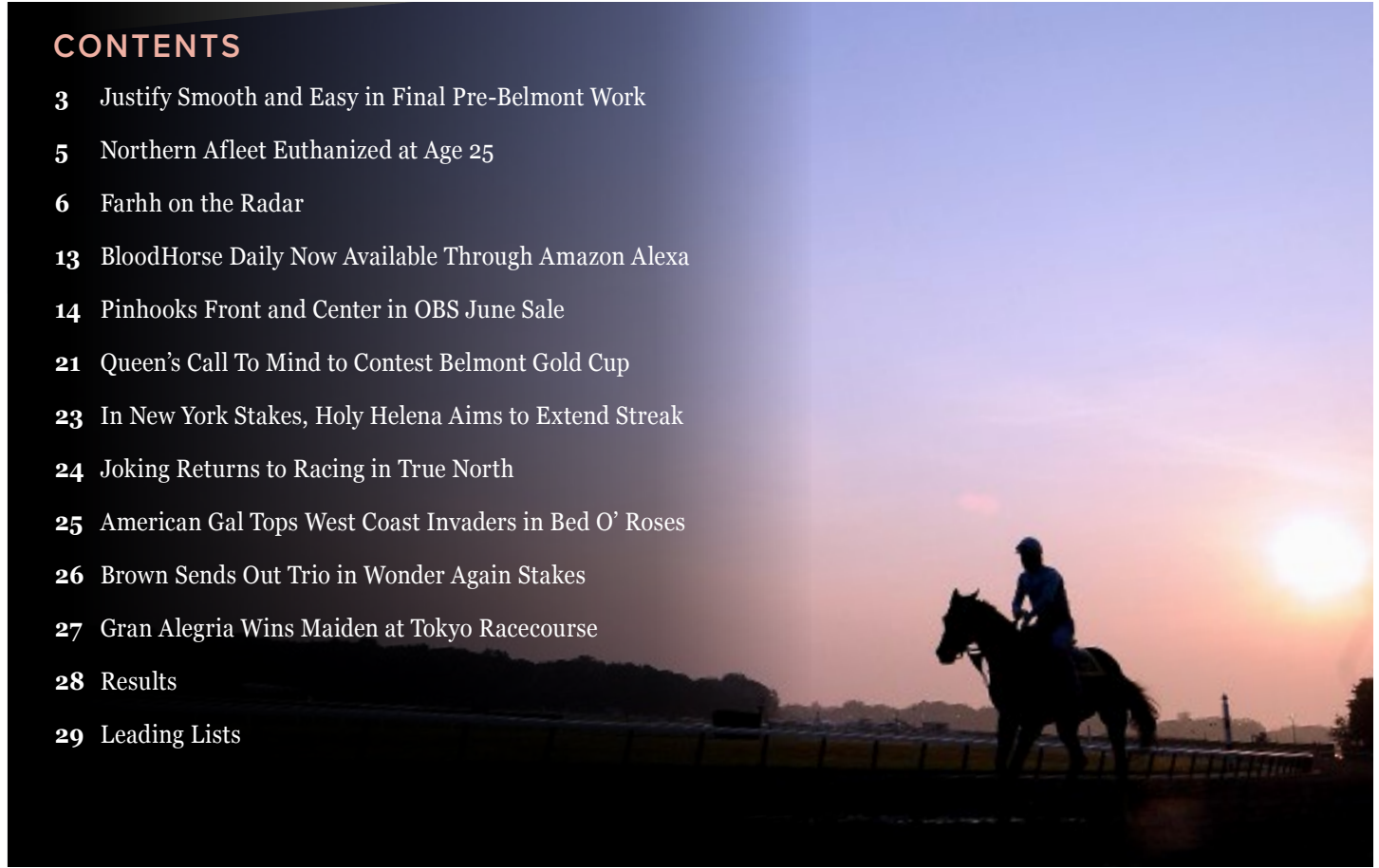

JUSTIFY SMOOTH AND EASY IN FINAL PRE-BELMONT WORK

Bob Baffert has reached a point in this five-week journey through the American classics where he's out of new material as far as Justify is concerned.

The Hall of Fame trainer has stated in every way possible what an exceptional animal the chestnut son of Scat Daddy is. And each time the conditioner finds the right adjectives to describe what the unbeaten dual classic winner has accomplished in his meteoric five-race career, the big chestnut runner backs him up by behaving every bit like the wondrous athlete he has been deemed.

As Justify stepped onto the Churchill Downs oval June 4 for his last major piece of work in advance of his Triple Crown try in the June 9 Belmont Stakes (G1), it was more of the same from him and his camp. After watching the colt cruise through a five-furlong breeze in 1:01 2/5 that was as easy as he pleased, Baffert reiterated how spoiled he was to have a horse whose actions could deliver the most definitive statements.

"(Jockey) Martin (Garcia) said he didn't even take a deep breath," Baffert said of the work. "All seems good."

After dropping jaws with his sizzling four-furlong work in :46 4/5 at Churchill May 29, Justify put in a steadier effort June 4, but one that still featured his trademark ease. After breaking off

solo at the half-mile pole, Justify was well in hand while registering splits of :12 4/5, :24 4/5, :37, and :48 4/5 and put in a big gallop out to six furlongs in 1:13 3/5 and seven furlongs in 1:27 1/5.

"He went a little quick last time so I wanted to go three quarters with him," said Baffert, who arrived in Louisville the evening before to oversee Justify's final pre-Belmont work. "Just kept him in hand the whole way and let him gallop out seven-eighths. He went smooth and he relaxed nice. Last time he was a little bit fresh, I think, and really wanted to do a little bit more. But Martin was happy with him."

Keeping Justify happy has been the modus operandi for Baffert and his team as the colt attempts

to become just the 13th horse to sweep the American classics. As has been the case in many of his exploits, the well-built specimen has made life easy in that respect, thanks to his good mind and exceptional recovery time.

Where Baffert said the colt was still a tad soft physically earlier in the season, he sees nothing but firm muscle now over every bit of his 16.3-hand frame. The light bulb has come on mentally as well, according to Baffert—yet another scary prospect for those aiming to derail Justify in the 1 1/2-miles test that looms June 9.

"He's a seasoned horse now," Baffert said. "He's had those five races and I can just tell he's more professional. He's been shipped around, been in these races, been in some tough fights. He handles it well. He's basically just run himself into shape here.

"Before he was lightly raced, and people were saying he couldn't win the Derby because he was lightly raced. Now he can't win the Belmont because he's raced too much—it's always something. But he's seasoned now. He should be up for it."

Owned by WinStar Farm, China Horse Club, Starlight Racing, and Head of Plains Partners, Justify is slated to have a walk day June 5

before shipping to Belmont Park the following day.

Among those joining him on the New York flight will be fellow Belmont hopeful Restoring Hope, who followed his heralded stablemate onto the Churchill track Monday and put in his own solid workout in preparation for Big Sandy. With jockey Florent Geroux up, the son of Giant's Causeway covered six furlongs in 1:13 with splits of :12 3/5, :24 2/5, :36 1/5, :48 2/5, and 1:00 1/5 with a gallop out of seven furlongs in 1:26 2/5.

"He worked really well, he always works really well," Baffert said of Restoring Hope. "He's a one-paced kind of horse and he went a little bit faster, but I wanted to do a little more with him

because he hasn't run in a while (12th in the grade 3 Pat Day Mile Stakes Presented by LG and E and KU May 5). We let him work a little harder."

Restoring Hope's best stakes effort came when he was third in the April 7 Wood Memorial Presented by NYRA Bets (G2).

Trainer Dale Romans reported Monday that expected Belmont Stakes contender and grade 1 winner Free Drop Billy was in good order following his June 3 five-furlong work in :59 1/5 at Churchill. The son of Belmont winner Union Rags is also set to be part of the Kentucky-based contingent shipping to New York Wednesday. **BH**

NORTHERN AFLEET EUTHANIZED AT AGE 25

Taylor Made Stallions has reported that Northern Afleet, a longtime stallion at the Nicholasville, Ky., farm, was euthanized June 1. The accomplished son of Afleet—Nuryette, by Nureyev, known for his versatility and consistency as a sire, was 25 years old.

Dr. Charles Scoggin issued the following statement: *Northern Afleet had experienced an episode of acute abdominal pain on Friday evening. He had been clinically normal and actively breeding up until this time. Veterinary attention and treatment on the farm failed to resolve the pain. He was referred to Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital, where a team of specialists diagnosed him with severe gastrointestinal disease. He was given a poor-to-grave prognosis for survival and was subsequently euthanized.*

"Northern Afleet was like part of the family at Taylor Made, and he was truly a unique stallion within the industry," said Ben Taylor. "Not too many stallions have sired a classic winner and a Breeders' Cup winner, not to mention numerous grade 1 winners over varying surfaces and distances of ground. Northern Afleet was the definition of versatility and was always considered one of the best value stallions around. He provided every breeder the opportunity to produce a top-class racehorse, regardless of the quality of their mare."

The sire of 14 grade 1 winners and seven champions, including 2017 Eclipse champion turf horse and Breeders' Cup Mile (G1T) winner World Approval, Northern Afleet sired 75 stakes winners and 137 black-type horses to date with worldwide progeny earnings of more than \$75 million.

In addition to World Approval, Northern Afleet sired dual classic winner Afleet Alex, champion 3-year-old colt and winner of the Preakness (G1) and Belmont (G1) stakes; Amazombie, champion sprinter and Xpressbet Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) winner; and Canadian champion and grade 1 winner Negligee. Northern Afleet also made his presence felt in the Southern Hemisphere where he shuttled to Stud TNT in Brazil and sired 2015 Brazilian Horse of the Year Barolo.

Additional standout runners sired by Northern Afleet include 2017 grade 1 winner Denman's Call, winner of the Triple Bend Stakes (G1), millionaires War Story—who captured last year's Brooklyn Invitational Stakes (G2)—Big City Man, Teaks North, Evening Jewel, and Kaigun, among them.

Northern Afleet is one of the rare stallions to both sire a Breeders' Cup winner and have a son sire a Breeders' Cup winner, as Afleet Alex sired 2014 Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) winner Texas Red.

On the racetrack, Northern Afleet won the San Fernando Breeders' Cup Stakes (G2), San Carlos Handicap (G2), and the San Diego Handicap (G3) and earned multiple other graded stakes placings for trainer David Hofmans en route to career earnings of \$626,671. He was bred in Kentucky by Hermitage Farm and was campaigned by Gregg Anderson and Ronald Waranch.

Northern Afleet entered stud in 1999 at Double Diamond Farm near Ocala, Fla., and was relocated to Taylor Made Stallions after Afleet Alex captured the 2004 Hopeful Stakes (G1). **BH**

FARHH ON THE RADAR

For European sires who went to stud between 2012-14 with first foals that are 5-, 4-, and 3-year-olds of 2018, their proximity to Frankel on the racetrack figured to be an important gauge to their prospects as sires, and so it has proved true.

Coolmore's Zoffany, a son of Dansili who possibly gave Frankel the biggest scare of his career in the 2011 St. James's Palace Stakes (G1) at Royal Ascot as a 3-year-old, was the first of those who was in relatively close proximity to Frankel to go to stud, and he had his first foals in 2013 (now 5-year-olds). He was comfortably the leading European freshman sire of

2015, and is now a solidly established mid-range sire standing for €25,000 (\$29,250).

Frankel, who retired to Juddmonte Farms' Banstead Manor Stud, had his first foals in 2014, as did old adversaries Nathaniel, at Newsells Park, and Excelebration, at Coolmore.

Frankel's results have been nothing short of sensational. The statistics in the following tables were run after racing June 3. The next day the 4-year-old Mozu Ascot won the Yasuda Kinen (G1) at Tokyo Racecourse to become Frankel's 25th black-type winner from his first two crops, his 18th group winner (that's 8.2% of his named foals in those two crops, about the same percentage as Galileo himself), and

his third group 1 winner—interestingly, his second in Japan.

Though he trails Darley's Helmet (sire of Thunder Snow, winner of \$6 million in the group 1 Dubai World Cup Sponsored By Emirates Airline) and Nathaniel (sire of Enable, winner of €2,857,000 in last year's group 1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe) by cumulative progeny earnings (keeping in mind *BloodHorse* adjusts Japanese earnings to a "par" with North American earnings), the black-type figures tell the story here. Frankel has 25 black-type winners; Nathaniel is second among European third-crop sires with nine. Frankel has 18 group winners; Nathaniel is second with four. And Frankel has three group 1 winners; Helmet, Nathaniel, Rajsaman, and Excelebration have one each.

The one horse who was most under the radar of

Frankel's top-class opponents, all of whom were group 1 winners themselves, was Godolphin's Farhh, who is by Pivotal out of the dual German group 1 winner Gonbarda, by Lando.

Farhh only ran 10 times—once at 2, once late in his 3-year-old season, then six times at 4 in 2012, and two times at 5 in 2013. He won his start at 2 and his start at 3, and his first start at 4—a maiden and two handicaps—then trainer Saeed bin Suroor fired him into group 1 company.

He was third to So You Think in the Prince of Wales's Stakes (G1), then finished second in four consecutive group 1 races: to Nathaniel in the Coral Eclipse Stakes (G1); to Frankel (six lengths) in the QIPCO Sussex Stakes (G1) at a mile; to Frankel again (seven lengths) in the Juddmonte International Stakes (G1); and to the champion race mare Moonlight Cloud in the Qatar Prix du Moulin de Longchamp (G1).

As a 5-year-old in 2013, Farhh finally won his first stakes race—the JLT Lockinge Stakes (G1) over a mile at Newbury in May. He didn't run again until October, when he won the Champion Stakes Sponsored by

QIPCO (G1) on Champions Day at Ascot. Total: 10 starts; five wins, four seconds, one third; all five placings in group 1 races. He ran Racing Post Rating's of 126 or 127 five times.

Farhh was undoubtedly a for-real group 1 horse, but he was still under the radar, with only 33 named foals in his first crop, foals of 2015 that are now 3-year-olds. He maybe surprised a few people by appearing on the freshman sire lists by virtue of siring Wells Farhh Go, a surprise winner of the Tattersalls Acomb Stakes

(G3) at York in August, for Northern trainer Tim Easterby; and Dee Ex Bee, who placed in two listed races at 2 for another Northern trainer, Mark Johnston.

Going into last weekend Farhh ranked just 20th by cumulative progeny earnings for European second-crop sires, but Dee Ex Bee, who had placed in two more black-type races this term, placed in his fifth black-type race June 2. This one just happened to be the Investec Derby (G1) at Epsom, and Dee Ex Bee's second-place effort earned him £322,500 (\$430,538).

That wasn't too far off what all Farhh's runners had earned up until then, and it vaulted the stallion from 20th to sixth among European second-crop sires, now with cumulative progeny earnings totaling \$783,115. Hopefully this is the last of Farhh's time under the radar.

After Farhh moved into sixth, three of the top five European second-crop sires had significant results June 3, which was Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby, G1) day at Chantilly. Intello, who was fifth on the list of European second-crop sires, had the third and fourth in the French Derby, which propelled him into fourth, ahead of Havana Gold.

Dabirsim had the French Derby fifth and solidified his hold on the third spot; and Camelot got his third group winner when his filly Pollara won the Prix de Royaumont (G3), moving him to within \$50,000 of Society Rock for top spot among European second-crop sires. Camelot has 13 black-type horses so far this

year; Society Rock has three. The writing is very much on the wall in that contest.

Among North American third-crop sires (first foals 2014, 4-year-olds of 2018), WinStar's Bodemeister retains the top spot, with cumulative progeny earnings of more than \$8 million. Union Rags edges past Dialed In for second, and fourth-ranked Creative Cause tops the \$7 million mark in cumulative progeny earnings. Creative Cause also edged past Dialed In by 2018 earnings, with Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner Monomoy Girl's sire, Tapizar, third by 2018 earnings, and Bodemeister fourth. The Factor, currently in Japan, is fifth by both 2018 and cumulative progeny earnings.

No change at all among the top 10 North American second-crop sires by cumulative progeny earnings: Take Charge Indy holds the top spot, ahead of Violence and leading 2017 freshman sire Overanalyze. **BH**

PINHOOKS FRONT AND CENTER IN OBS JUNE SALE

With more than 800 horses slated to pass through the ring in the Ocala Breeders' Sales June sale of 2-year-olds and horses of racing age, pinhook horses will once again dominate the catalog's offerings, with just under 200 previously-sold juveniles listed in session 1 alone.

The horse that attracted the most attention in a previous sale is a colt by the late Scat Daddy offered as Hip 211. Consigned by Dynasty Thoroughbreds to the Keeneland September yearling sale, the colt was an RNA at \$385,000. Bred in Florida by Don Ming out of the Gone West mare Satulah, his dam is a half sister to grade 3 winner Boss Lafitte and stakes-placed Sandsarita.

Another interesting \$275,000 RNA is a Medaglia d'Oro colt offered as Hip 133. Bred in Kentucky by Breeders' Cup chairman Fred Hertrich III and his partner John Fielding, the colt is out of the grade 3 stakes placed Distorted Humor mare Poof Too. He is from the female family of Haskell Invitational Stakes (G1) winner Bluegrass Cat and Vosburgh Stakes (G1) winner Girolamo.

The OBS sale takes place June 13-15, with four under tack sessions scheduled for June 7-10. All three sale sessions will begin at 10 a.m. All under tack sessions will begin at 7:30 a.m. (all times EDT).

Over the next three days *BloodHorse* will run a list of pinhook prospects for each session of the OBS sale. **BH**

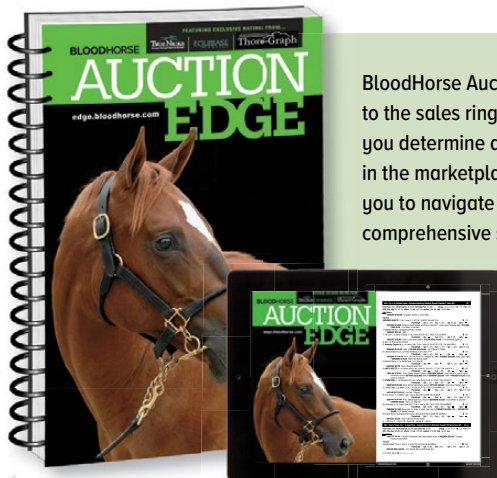

QUEEN'S CALL TO MIND TO CONTEST BELMONT GOLD CUP

When Martin Panza first conceptualized the Belmont Gold Cup Invitational Stakes (G2T) in 2014, his goal was to create a rich marathon turf test that would enhance the lead-up to the Belmont Stakes (G1) while attracting international attention and providing fans an intriguing wagering opportunity.

Four years later, the New York Racing Association's senior vice president of racing operations can check all of those boxes.

A highly competitive field of 10 will travel two miles June 8 on Belmont Park's Widener Turf course in the fifth edition of the \$400,000 Gold Cup, which has quickly risen to grade 2 status, and will feature a trio of strong European challengers. After attracting just one foreign-based horse in its first three runnings, the Gold Cup became an international sensation with six such shippers last year, including the top four finishers, led by victorious Red Cardinal.

"It's a cool race," Panza said. "You don't see two miles on the turf that often. It's fun to watch, and we're very pleased to take a race that didn't exist and bring it to where it is now, moving from a grade 3 race last year to a grade 2 this year."

This year's imports also should have a major say in the outcome and feature Call To Mind, a colt with connections as famous as they come. The homebred Galileo 4-year-old is owned by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

In the span of two days during the Belmont Stakes Racing Festival, the cards will feature a horse owned by the woman who wears the crown of England and

Justify, who will try to become the 13th Triple Crown champion in the following day's Belmont Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets (G1).

"When the race became graded a year ago it opened the door for more Europeans to run and now we're getting great representation from overseas," Panza said. "Does it get any better than having a horse owned by The Queen?"

Call To Mind, who drew the rail and will be ridden by Javier Castellano, enters the Gold Cup with two wins in eight career starts for trainer William Haggas. His most recent win came at a mile-and-three-quarters distance on turf in the Goodwood Revival March Stakes in August and in his previous start he finished third in the Mansionbet Yorkshire Cup (G2), also at 14 furlongs, at York May 18.

While Call To Mind has not raced beyond a mile-and-three-quarters, the other two Europeans are no strangers to two-mile stakes. Funny Kid, a Kentucky-bred Lemon Drop Kid 5-year-old trained by Christophe

Ferland, has raced at both two miles and 2 1/16 miles on a synthetic surface, finishing first and second, respectively, and was third in a handicap last year at Deauville. He enters off a victory in the Prix de Barbeville (G3), going about two miles (1.92 miles) at ParisLongchamp.

Group 3-placed Prince of Arran, a British-bred 5-year-old Shirocco gelding,

has raced two miles or more on eight occasions but has struggled lately. In his past two starts, he was sixth in a 2 5/16th-mile handicap on turf May 11 and eighth in the Dubai Gold Cup Sponsored by Al Tayer Motors (G2) at Meydan before that.

The U.S. contingent is topped by Nessy, a 5-year-old Flower Alley gelding coming off a length victory in the

mile-and-three-quarters San Juan Capistrano (G3T) at Santa Anita Park April 22.

"This horse will love the distance. The longer he goes, the better he gets," said trainer Ian Wilkes. "It's hard to get that much distance. It's a unique race, but he's a unique horse."

Though Nussy is based in the East, Wilkes said he couldn't resist an opportunity to run in the San Juan Capistrano because of its distance, the improvement he's seen in the homebred gelding, and owner Ed Hudon's fondness for the race.

"He's just starting to mature," Wilkes said of Nussy, who will be ridden by Hall of Famer Mike Smith, his jockey in the San Juan Capistrano. "I think this is going to be his best year, and he'll get better next year. He's a late bloomer and winning the Capistrano was important. It was for the owner. It's a race he always wanted to win. The race is a grade 3 and worth \$100,000 now, but that was a race he has always admired. When the owner puts the money into the game like Ed, you try to come through for him."

A win for Ed and Sharon Hudon in the Gold Cup would also delight the connections, especially if they can beat a horse owned by The Queen.

"It's no problem running against The Queen, if I beat her," said Wilkes, who was born in Australia. "But if she kicks my butt, I won't feel too good about it. I know the Europeans are not going to be easy to beat."

Bloom Racing Stable and Allen Racing's Run Time won the two-mile H. Allen Jerkens Stakes on the turf Dec. 30 at Gulfstream Park, but was then 10th in the Mac Diarmida (G2T) at Gulfstream Park and 13th in the Dubai Gold Cup.

Runnymede Racing's Postulation won the 1 11/16-mile American St. Leger (G3T) last year at Arlington International Racecourse and was sixth in the 1 3/8-mile Man o'War Stakes (G1T) at Belmont in his most recent start.

"When you get The Queen of England involved in your race," Panza said, "you know you're moving in the right direction." **BH**

IN NEW YORK STAKES, HOLY HELENA AIMS TO EXTEND STREAK

In line to contest the June 8 New York Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets (G2T) at Belmont Park is a field of nine older fillies and mares who have more than proved their mettle in graded company.

Among those bidding for the 1 1/4-mile turf test Friday is 2017 Canadian champion 3-year-old filly Holy Helena, who is unbeaten in three starts this year. Trained by Jimmy Jerkens, the 4-year-old Ghostzapper filly won her previous race, the Sheepshead Bay Stakes (G2T) May 5 at Belmont, with jockey Manuel Franco, who will have the mount again.

"Her first race on turf was an allowance and it was only a mile, but she was relentless until she got there," Jerkens said. "This is going to be a lot tougher race than her last one ... but she's three-for-three on the turf and each succeeding race has had a little better quality horses in it and she's been able to handle it. I hope she does the same this time."

Holy Helena will be joined by fellow millionaire earner Daddys Lil Darling, who comes to Belmont off a second-place run in the April 27 Bewitch Stakes (G3T) at Keeneland, where she finished 3 1/4 lengths behind fellow New York Stakes entrant, Mom's On Strike. Trained by Ken McPeck, the Normandy Farm homebred has not visited the winner's circle since her top-level victory in the Dec. 30 American Oaks (G1T). Hall of Fame jockey Mike Smith, who will ride Triple Crown contender Justify in Saturday's Belmont Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets (G1), will have the call.

Michael Dubb, Bethlehem Stables, and Gary Aisquith's Fourstar Crook will be

the oldest runner in Friday's field. The 6-year-old mare began her year with a win in the Hillsborough Stakes (G2T) at Tampa Bay Downs, then finished second in her next out in the Coolmore Jenny Wiley Stakes (G1T) at Keeneland to Sistercharlie, who is also entered in the New York Stakes.

Peter Brant's Sistercharlie returned to racing in April following a nine-month layoff when she was sidelined by trainer Chad Brown to address a severe lung infection that derailed the end of her sophomore season. The months of rest and recuperation appeared to pay off for the daughter of Myboycharlie, who won the Jenny Wiley by a comfortable 2 1/4 lengths. The co-highweight with Daddys Lil Darling, Sistercharlie will break from post 5 under regular rider John Velazquez.

Florida-bred Mom's On Strike returns to Belmont for the first time since her 2016 second-place run in the Pebbles Stakes. Her win in the Bewitch was her first graded victory in a career of 15 starts for the 5-year-old First Dude mare.

Breaking from the rail will be Pennsylvania-bred Fahan Mura, who is undefeated in four starts this year, all at Santa Anita Park. The English Channel filly was claimed by Bram Jam Stables in August and was transferred at the start of the season to the barn of Vladimir Cerin. The New York Stakes will be her first graded test. **BH**

JOKING RETURNS TO RACING IN TRUE NORTH

It's been more than 20 months since Joking was seen racing to victory in the 2016 Vosburgh Stakes (G1), which punched his ticket to the 2016 Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) for owner and trainer Charlton Baker.

But Joking never got a chance to run in the Breeders' Cup. The now 9-year-old son of Distorted Humor developed life-threatening pneumonia soon after he arrived in California, but has fully recovered and is ready for a comeback in the \$250,000 True North Stakes (G2) June 8 at Belmont Park, a race he won in 2016.

"I'm excited to get him back to racing," Baker said from his base at Finger Lakes. "He looks like he's ready to compete."

A field of eight was entered for the True North, a 6 1/2-furlong dirt race for 4-year-olds and older. Also entered are last-out graded stakes winners Bobby Abu Dhabi and Limousine Liberal; multiple graded winners Whitmore and Imperial Hint; grade 3 victor Always Sunshine; and stakes winners Westwood and Recruiting Ready.

Joking is the best horse Baker's ever saddled. He was claimed as a 5-year-old in 2014 for \$20,000. He broke his maiden in 2012 in his third start, and had one win from 11 starts when he came to Baker's barn.

"He was my first graded stakes winner and first grade 1 winner, so when he got sick, I really (wanted) to save his life," said Baker, who has been training horses since 1998. "His presence in the barn is just so nice. He's a special horse."

Jockey Manny Franco, who was aboard Joking for his four-race win streak prior to the illness, has the return call again.

"I'm anxious to ride him. He's really a nice horse," Franco said.

Joking was treated at the Chino Valley Equine Hospital in Chino Hills, Calif., by Dr. Andreas Klohnen for several months after he became ill. Baker said it was "touch and go" for about the first 45 days. Joking

returned east in January of 2017, was cared for by Dr. Patty Hogan in New Jersey, spent time on the farm recovering, and returned to training in October.

Joking's lifetime record stands at 10-8-8, with earnings of \$846,138 from 39 starts.

Rockingham Ranch and David Bernsen's Bobby Abu Dhabi won the April 21 Kona Gold Stakes (G2) in his last start after a runner-up finish in the Triple Bend (G1), his first start of the year.

"He has really matured for us the past few months," trainer Peter Miller said of his 4-year-old chestnut son of Macho Uno. "He's become a bigger, stronger version of the horse we had last year."

Katharine Ball's 6-year-old Limousine Liberal won the Churchill Downs Stakes presented by Twinspires.com (G2) in his last start and has earnings of more than \$1.3 million.

Ron Moquett's Southern Springs Stables, Robert LaPenta, and Head of Plains Partners' Whitmore looks to improve on his third-place finish in last year's True North and a fourth in the Churchill Downs Stakes last time out. Trained by Moquett, the 5-year-old son of Pleasantly Perfect has 10 wins from 19 starts and earnings of more than \$1.5 million.

"I think he's better (than last year). He's smarter, or we're learning little things about him all the time," Moquett said. "He's teaching us how he wants to be trained." **BH**

AMERICAN GAL TOPS WEST COAST INVADERS IN BED O' ROSES

Kaleem Shah's multiple grade 1 winner American Gal tops a trio of West Coast-based contenders and seeks her second straight graded victory as part of a strong eight-horse field in the \$250,000 Bed o' Roses Invitational (G3) June 8 at Belmont Park.

The seven-furlong sprint, for fillies and mares 4-years-old and up, is one of five stakes on the second day of the Belmont Stakes Racing Festival, which offers \$9.4 million in purses through 18 stakes races over the three-day event highlighted by the 150th running of the Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (G1).

American Gal comes into the Bed o' Roses off a two-length score in the May 5 Humana Distaff (G1) at Churchill Downs.

"She's doing really good," trainer Simon Callaghan said. "Were happy with the way she's coming into the race. She ran a good first race at Keeneland, not beaten far there, and then came back and won the grade 1 at Churchill."

Trained by Bob Baffert as a 2-year-old, the daughter of Concord Point placed third in the 2016 14 Hands Winery Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (G1) and ended her juvenile season with a runner-up finish in the Starlet Stakes (G1).

She only raced twice as a 3-year-old, winning the

Victory Ride Stakes (G3) at Belmont in her first start for Callaghan, and the Longines Test Stakes (G1) at Saratoga Race Course.

"We gave her some time off (earlier in the year)," Callaghan said. "It was just a real minor thing. Then we decided to give her more time off and bring her back as a 4-year-old, but it seems she's come back as good as ever."

American Gal will break from post 2 with Jose Ortiz aboard.

Del Mar Debutante Stakes (G1) winner Union Strike returns to action after being away from racing since the Jan. 13 La Canada Stakes at Santa Anita Park in which she placed seventh. The daughter of Union Rags has been working on both dirt and turf at Keeneland since May 12 for trainer Mick Ruis, who owns the 4-year-old filly with his wife, Wendy. Union Strike placed fifth in the 2017 Acorn Stakes (G1) in her only start at Belmont Park.

Lael Stables and trainer Arnaud Delacour entered the third West Coast-based contender in Chalon. The 4-year-old Dialed In filly was runner up in the May 12 Vagrancy Handicap (G3) over the New York track in her most recent effort. Chalon recorded a stakes victory over the Belmont track when she took the 2017 Jersey Girl. She opened her 2018 season with a score in Laurel Park's Primonetta Stakes April 21.

Among the other contenders, Alpha Delta Stables' multiple graded stakes winner Lewis Bay brings her own impressive résumé with her. Still seeking a victory this year, the daughter of Bernardini finished second in the Feb. 19 Royal Delta (G3), and third in both the Madison Stakes (G1) and Humana Distaff.

"She's doing well," trainer Chad Brown said. "She emerged from the Humana Distaff with a quarter crack that we had to repair, so she did miss a little bit of time. She's come back with a couple of easy breezes. She seems to be moving fine."

Trainer Todd Pletcher brings Humana Distaff runner up Ivy Bell, who seems to be turning a corner this year after beginning the season with a score in the March 17 Inside Information Stakes (G2) at Gulfstream Park, which was her first graded win. **BH**

BROWN SENDS OUT TRIO IN WONDER AGAIN STAKES

In an attempt to capture a second consecutive \$200,000 Wonder Again Stakes (G3T), Chad Brown will send out a trio of talented runners in the 1 1/8-mile test for 3-year-old fillies June 7 at Belmont Park.

The two-time Eclipse Award-winning trainer, who won the race last year with New Money Honey, will command the lion's share of the 10-horse field Thursday with stablemates Mighty Scarlett, Altea, and graded stakes winner Significant Form.

Significant Form opened her sophomore season with a win in the Memories Of Silver Stakes at Aqueduct Racetrack. No stranger to Belmont, the daughter of Creative Cause broke her maiden and took home her first graded win in one fell swoop at 2 in the Miss Grillo Stakes (G3T) going 1 1/16 miles on the Belmont inner turf.

A half sister to Commonwealth Turf Stakes (G3T) winner Hay Dakota, Significant Form capped her freshman season with a fourth-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf (G1T) at Del Mar. Irad Ortiz Jr. will have the mount.

Mighty Scarlett was unraced at 2 and broke her maiden at second asking, going 1 3/16 miles on the

turf in an April 27 maiden special weight at Keeneland. The daughter of Scat Daddy will be making her stakes debut in the Wonder Again under jockey Jose Ortiz, who was aboard for her only win in two starts.

Bred in France by Carlos Vazquez Gonzalez, graded stakes-placed Altea will be looking for her first win since relocating to the United States. The daughter of Siyouni placed third in the Florida Oaks (G3) at Tampa Bay Downs in her first North American effort.

Joining the trio in the field will be Jim and Susan Hill's Pennsylvania-bred Daddy Is a Legend. Trained by George Weaver, the second daughter of Scat Daddy in the field has finished off the board twice in six career starts and enters off a third-place finish in the May 4 Edgewood Stakes presented by Forcht Bank (G3T),

part of the Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) undercard at Churchill Downs.

Don Alberto Stable's Andina Del Sur joins Daddy Is a Legend and Significant Form as graded stakes-winning entrants in the Wonder Again. The chestnut daughter of the late Giant's Causeway won the March 10 Florida Oaks

(G3T) before running fourth in the Central Bank Ashland Stakes (G1) behind eventual Kentucky Oaks winner Monomoy Girl. One of three highweights listed at 121 pounds, she partners with jockey John Velazquez and will break from post 6.

GRAN ALEGRIA WINS MAIDEN AT TOKYO RACECOURSE

Five Japan Racing Association races for 2-year-old colts and fillies were organized at both the Tokyo and Hanshin Racecourses over the weekend in Japan. The most impressive of the winners was Gran Alegria, who won her maiden at first asking by two lengths going 1,600 meters (one mile) over the turf June 3 at Tokyo Racecourse.

The Deep Impact filly is the first live foal out of Tapitsfly, who won seven races in North America, including the Longines Just A Game Stakes (G1T) and the First Lady Stakes (G1T) and amassed career earnings of \$1,495,503 for her owner/breeder Frank Jones. Thirty days after Tapitsfly's final career start in 2012, she was offered at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky fall mixed sale, where she was purchased by Northern Farm's Katsumi Yoshida for \$1.85 million.

Her first foal by Deep Impact died soon after birth and she failed to conceive by Orfevre the next year. Gran Alegria, was born on Jan. 24, 2016.

The partnership that owns the filly was organized through Sunday Racing Club for a total value of ¥70,000,000 (US\$633,000), when she was a yearling. She was moved to Kazuo Fujisawa's Miho Training Center after her breaking at Northern Farm.

"She knew what she needed to do today," said jockey Christophe Lemaire, who used his whip only once after she hit the front and started to idle. "She has a bright future." **BH**
