FASIG-TIPTON

FASIG-TIPTON'S RACEHORSE SALE PROVIDES OPPORTUNITY

The modus operandi for Kenny Troutt's WinStar operation is well known—race well-bred horses at the highest level with potential to return to the Versailles, Ky., farm as stallions.

For those not fitting that criteria, WinStar has succeeded in finding new homes for them, primarily offering those racehorses to the public at Keeneland's November breeding stock sale.

In a new twist, WinStar has its first consignment to the Fasig-Tipton horses of racing age sale that will be held July 10 at the Newtown Paddocks in Lexington. The sale begins at 5 p.m. ET and will take place one day before the Fasig-Tipton July selected yearling sale.

Established in 2013, the auction has proven to be viable market for horse trading among owners at a time of year in which there is a paucity of opportunities for buying and selling racehorses, other than the private market, which can be limited.

The sale's graduates include 2015 TwinSpires Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (G1) winner Wavell Avenue, as well as graded stakes winners Squadron A, Fear the Cowboy, Fioretti, Point Piper, Bullards Alley, and Dramedy.

"This is our fifth year conducting the horses of racing age sale, and we feel that this is our strongest catalog to date," said Fasig-Tipton president Boyd Browning. "The sale has attracted entries from several of the most prominent racing stables in the country, and buyers will find a number of turn-key, quality offerings no matter their budget.

"Since this sale was first held in 2013, sale graduates have made more than 3,500 starts for their new owners, earning more than \$19 million," Browning continued. "The sale has also produced 25% stakes horses and more than 40 stakes wins."

Topped by Stormy Lucy, sold in a private, out-of-the-ring transaction for \$575,000, last year's sale saw 72 horses gross \$5,048,500, for an average price

of \$70,118 and a median price of \$42,000. Those numbers represented gross and average gains of 26.3% and 14.1%, respectively, as the median was down 12.5%.

"We found it to be (a) useful (sale) for horses that have lots of conditions, but might not be stakes horses, or are just a cut below what we keep as stallions but are extremely useful horses for other outfits," said Sean Tugel, WinStar's director of bloodstock services and assistant racing manager. "(New owners) can go on and have fun with them and race at the highest level as we do."

Tugel said WinStar decided to enter a half-dozen horses in the Fasig-Tipton sale because there are so many additional racing opportunities between now and when the farm presents its other racehorses to the public in November.

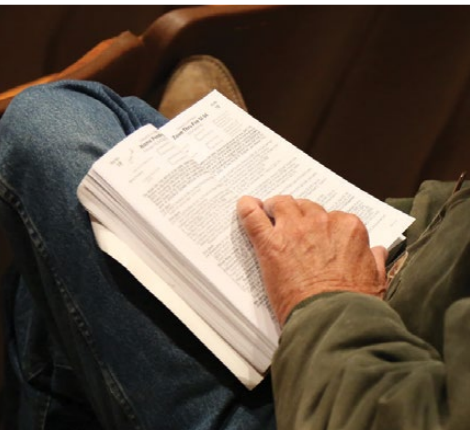
"You have horses that are in form and racing, and it is just before the big summer meets at Saratoga and

Del Mar," Tugel explained. "With the increased purses at Ellis Park and Kentucky Downs, we also have a lot of horses that fit that mold. With the amount of racing that goes on in the summertime rather than winter, we felt like it was a good time to test the waters of a new marketplace."

The WinStar consignment is being handled by Tugel and James Keogh, a veteran consignor whose Grovendale Sales offerings at the auction include stakes winner Zulu. The Bernardini colt showed potential early in 2016, when he finished second in the Xpressbet.com Fountain of Youth Stakes (G2) before an unplaced effort as the favorite in the Toyota Blue Grass Stakes (G1). Following an eight-month layoff, Zulu won the Dec. 18 Tamarac Stakes.

With the addition of recent stakes winner Dreamin, the horses of racing age sale catalog now numbers 126 and includes more than 15 stakes winners. A 4-year-old filly, Dreamin has won or placed in 13 of her 22 starts, including a victory in the July 6 Saylorville Stakes at Prairie Meadows, in which she defeated graded stakes winner I'm a Looker in a final time of 1:08.8. She is offered by Darby Dan Farm.

Another recent stakes winner cataloged is Happy Mesa, a daughter of Sky Mesa who won the Hilltop Stakes at Pimlico Race Course in near course-record time of 1:33.61 for a mile on the turf. The 3-year-old filly, who also won the Selima Stakes at age 2, is out of stakes-placed Happy Choice and from the family of grade 1 Test Stakes winner Missed the Storm, as well as

champion Hall of Famer Chris Evert.

Happy Mesa is among a large group from the recently formed Elite Sales of Bradley Weisbord and Liz Crow.

Taylor Made Sales Agency's consignment includes multiple graded winner Made You Look, a 3-year-old son of More Than Ready who annexed this year's Dania Beach Stakes (G3T) on the turf at Gulfstream Park and took last year's With Anticipation Stakes (G2T) at Saratoga Race Course.

Another Saratoga graded winner from Taylor Made is Bitumen, who closed with a powerful rally to win the 2016 Sanford Stakes (G3). The 3-year-old Mineshaft colt is a half brother to a stakes winner Meshell and is out of an unraced half sister to four-time grade 1 winner and sire Quality Road.

Taylor Made's Mark Taylor said the Fasig-Tipton sale's placement on the auction calendar has appeal for a lot of buyers and sellers.

"Everybody is looking for a live, sound racehorse," Taylor said. "And liquidity is a big thing for the owners. You used to only have a few racehorse sales throughout the year and the private marketplace is somewhat inefficient. We've sold a lot of good horses at all levels here that people have had success with."

Other stakes winners in the catalog include the 5-year-old mare Distinta, winner of this year's Inside Information Stakes (G2), from the family of grade 1 winner Purim; Closing Bell, a son of Tapit who won the Dueling Grounds Derby and finished second in the Secretariat Stakes (G1T); Lori's Store, a multiple stakes-winning daughter of El Prado; Bronson, a stakes winner this year at age 3 and a half brother to two grade 2 winners; Rose to Fame; and Adorable Miss. **BH**

FIRST-CROP SUMMER YEARLING SIRES, PART 2

The 12 stallion profiles in today's edition of *Blood-Horse Daily* are the second part in a series of statistical snapshots for first-crop and second-crop yearling sires represented at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky July or Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sales. Part 1 ran in the July 9 edition.

Each profile includes the sire's pedigree and lists the yearlings cataloged in both the Kentucky and New York sales. Sponsored profiles offer more information, including 2016 weanling averages and medians for first-crop stallions and 2016 yearling averages and medians for second-year sires, stud fee histories, and

the Comparable Index and Class Performance Index for the dams of the sires' 2017 yearlings.

The commercial leaders in today's selection of stallions are Three Chimneys Farm's Will Take Charge and Lane's End's Noble Mission.

Will Take Charge, a 7-year-old son of Unbridled's Song, had the highest entering-year fee of his sire class at \$30,000. He has 110 foals in his first crop, second only to Ashford Stud's Verrazano with 141 foals. Will Take Charge had 18 weanlings sell at auction in 2016, which generated a \$128,444 average and a \$105,000 median.

Noble Mission, an 8-year-old son of Galileo, had 11 weanlings sell last year for an average of \$76,182 and a median of \$60,000. **BH**

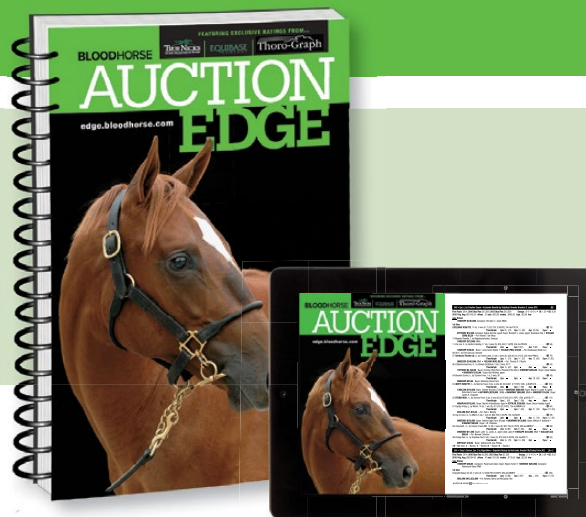

THUNDER SNOW LEADS ALL THE WAY IN PRIX JEAN PRAT

Thunder Snow led all the way to win the Prix Jean Prat (G1) for 3-year-old colts and fillies July 9 at Chantilly.

Trais Flours, the narrow favorite, tracked the moderate pace and was left with a bit too much to do in the final furlong. He chased valiantly to finish second, 1 1/4 lengths back. Gold Luck and Turf Laurel came in third and fourth, respectively. Lightupthenight dwelt badly and was never in contention in the five-horse race.

Thunder Snow, with jockey Christophe Soumillon up, completed the one mile over good turf in 1:38.78, without much need to hurry things along. He picked up his second group 1 win, following the Criterium International at Saint-Cloud, which completed his 2-year-old campaign.

The Darley-bred, Godolphin-owned colt by Helmet opened his 2017 campaign in Dubai, where he won the UAE Two Thousand Guineas Sponsored By District One Mohammed Bin Rashid Al Maktoum City (G3) and the UAE Derby Sponsored By The Saeed & Mohammed Al Naboodah Group (G2) at Meydan. From that effort,

he was regarded widely as Godolphin's best-ever chance to win the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (G1), but reared and bucked at the start of that race and was pulled up by Soumillon.

Neither Soumillon nor trainer Saeed bin Suroor has been able to explain the colt's behavior in Louisville and he subsequently behaved well enough to finish second to Churchill in the Tattersalls Irish Two Thousand Guineas (G1) at the Curragh in May and third behind Barney Roy and Lancaster Bomber in the St James's Palace Stakes (G1) at Royal Ascot.

In the day's co-feature at Chantilly, Ibiza stepped way up in class to upset the Morocco Cup Prix Chloe (G3) for 3-year-old fillies. With jockey Stephane Pasquier up, Ibiza took over the lead from Monroe Bay in the final furlong and won by three-quarters of a length over her, with Dallas Affair another half-length back in third. Favored Wajnah finished last of seven.

Ibiza, a daughter of Redoute's Choice out of the Kingmambo mare Olga Prekasa, made her fourth start in two months and entered the Morocco Cup Prix Chloe off a second-place finish in a listed event at Compiègne. Trainer Nicolas Clement said Ibiza will be ticketed for a group 2 at Deauville in August. **BH**

AMERICAN GAL IMPRESSES IN VICTORY RIDE

After favored runs in two grade 1 races on her home soil in Southern California resulted in placings, Kaleem Shah's homebred American Gal broke through for her first graded win on the opposite coast July 9 with a determined victory in the \$150,000 Victory Ride Stakes (G3) at Belmont Park.

In her 3-year-old debut and her first start for trainer Simon Callaghan, the Concord Point filly overcame a less-than-ideal trip to win the 6 1/2-furlong sprint by 4 3/4 lengths.

Under jockey Flavien Prat, American Gal stumbled and was bumped by Noble Freud at the start but still found her way to the front of the field. She was far from comfortable, however, in between horses as a part of a four-way contest for the lead.

She maintained a head advantage through a quarter-mile in :22.48 and a half in :45.84, and pulled

clear in the stretch. With a furlong to go, she held a two-length advantage and extended it to hit the wire in 1:17.38. Grade 3 winner Vertical Oak finished second, a neck ahead of Noble Freud.

"Simon did a great job and she was ready to run today," Prat said. "She stumbled a bit from the gate, then after that when she was on the lead around the turn. She was ready."

"It was a really big performance today," Callaghan said. "The fact that she stumbled, ran those fractions, took pressure on both sides, and drew off—that's the sign of a really good filly."

Following two sprint wins to start her career for trainer Bob Baffert, American Gal went off as the 4-1 favorite in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies (G1), where she finished third despite a wide trip throughout. She closed the year with a second-place finish behind eventual Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner Abel Tasman in the Starlet Stakes (G1) as the 4-5 favorite.

"I think we're going to keep her sprinting for the time being," Callaghan said. "The immediate goal would be the Test. We're going to bring her back home and we'll see how she's training."

Bred in Kentucky, out of the Ghostzapper mare

American Story, American Gal now has three wins from five starts with \$407,700 in earnings.

"She had worked brilliantly coming into this race, so we expected a big effort," Shah said. "I would have been surprised if she had lost. I'm so pleased with the race and hopefully we go on to bigger and better things." **BH**

CHERRY LODGE GETS ADVANTAGE OVER RUBILINDA AT BELMONT

Don Alberto homebred Rubilinda and Spinaway Stakes (G1) third place finisher Cherry Lodge dominated a field of nine at the betting window July 9, and the two finished 1-2 in a \$77,000 allowance race on Belmont Park's turf, but not in the order expected.

Rubilinda, a 3-year-old daughter of Frankel, went off at odds of 2-5 in the filly and mare allowance after she impressed in her maiden May 27, when she broke last from the gate but steadily made progress throughout the six-furlong turf race for fillies and mares to win by 3 1/4 lengths.

The heavily backed Chad Brown trainee broke better in Sunday's seven-furlong test, but broke inward and bumped Bigkat and Camille. Rubilinda later found herself caught in traffic when she was hemmed in at the rail near the top of the turn for home. Checking abruptly, the filly was shuffled back to fifth.

Gainesway Stable's Cherry Lodge, who broke from the outside post with John Velazquez aboard, had a clear trip after sprinting to the lead, where she set fractions of :22.88, :46.19, and 1:09.44 through six furlongs.

Jockey Jose Ortiz angled Rubilinda off the rail on the turn and finally found running room heading into the stretch on the far outside where they were able to cut Cherry Lodge's lead to 1 1/4 lengths. The final time on the firm turf was 1:21.25.

Trained by Todd Pletcher, Cherry Lodge now has a record of 2-1-1 from four starts. Aside from her third place finish in the Spinaway, the 3-year-old daughter of Bernardini also finished second in the Matron Stakes (G3) at Belmont in her previous start in October.

Gainesway purchased Cherry Lodge from the 2015 Keeneland September yearling sale for \$450,000 from the Valkyre Stud consignment. She is out of the Carson City mare Wilshewed.

Rubilinda is out of the Aga Khan-bred mare Rubina and has earnings of \$60,400 from her first two starts. **BH**

YEARLING CONSIGNORS BY GRADE 1 WINNERS OFFERED

As we roll toward the start of Thoroughbred yearling sale season, *BloodHorse MarketWatch* reviewed consignors that brokered horses that went on to successfully compete at the top of the game.

Seventeen consignors that offered yearlings at a North American auction from 2012-14 have had two or more grade 1 winners pass through their barns. The average price of the yearlings they sold ranged from \$31,549 to \$342,100.

The Cleary family's Clearsky Farm in Central Kentucky rises to the top among these elite sellers when they are ranked by percentage of grade 1 winners from number offered. Clearsky sold three (8.1%) grade 1 winners out of 37 yearlings offered. Among these yearlings were a total of four graded stakes winners, or 10.8% of yearlings offered.

The best news for Clearsky is that they are also the breeder of all three grade 1 winners sold. New Year's Day, winner of the 2013 Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1), sold for \$425,000 to agent Ben Glass at the 2012 Keeneland September sale; three-time grade 1 sprinter Lord Nelson was purchased by Peachtree Stable's John Fort for \$340,000 at the 2013 Keeneland September sale; and 2016 Eclipse champion 3-year-old Arrogate was a \$560,000 Juddmonte Farms purchase at the 2014 Keeneland September sale.

Arrogate's year-to-date earnings of \$17,084,600 pushed the average earnings among all Clearsky runners sold as yearlings during the three-year window to a stratospheric \$694,238.

Hinkle Farms is ranked next by percentage of grade 1 winners from horses offered, represented by two grade 1 winners from 29 offered for an average of 6.9%. Hinkle is also the breeder or co-breeder of

its grade 1 winners Divisidero and Weep No More.

Divisidero sold to Margaux Farm for \$250,000 at the 2013 Keeneland September sale, while Weep No More sold to Michonne Farm for \$90,000 at the 2014 Keeneland September sale.

Hinkle Farms is the sole breeder of Divisidero, who distinguished himself this year by winning his second consecutive edition of the Woodford Reserve Turf Classic Stakes (G1) at Churchill Downs. Weep No More, winner of the 2016 Central Bank Ashland Stakes (G1) at Keeneland, was bred by Hinkle Farms partnership with Robert Kessinger.

Taylor Made Sales Agency, with 1,268 yearlings offered during the three-year period, had the highest number of both grade 1 winners and graded stakes winners offered at six and 28, respectively.

Tied in second by number of grade 1 winners offered with five each are Warrendale Sales (1.9% offered), Denali Stud (1.0% offered), and Gainesway (0.9% offered).

Following Clearsky and Hinkle Farms, Brookdale Sales and Cara Bloodstock had the next-highest percentages of graded stakes winners. Brookdale had 4.5% (nine graded stakes winners from 198 offered) and Cara Bloodstock was at 4.3% (six graded stakes winners from 139 offered). **BH** [Share this story](#)
