

#### ACCELERATE DOMINATES PACIFIC CLASSIC BY RECORD MARGIN

A ccelerate made one thing certain in the \$1 million TVG Pacific Classic (G1) Aug. 18 at Del Mar.

On the West Coast, he's the top handicap horse, and it's not close. Accolades beyond that will be decided soon enough.

Hronis Racing's 5-year-old son of Lookin At Lucky made a powerful move around the far turn, blew by pacesetter Roman Rosso, and drew off to win by 12 1/2 lengths—a record margin in the 1 1/4-mile event. The final time was 2:01.83.

Stephen Foster Handicap (G1)

winner Pavel made a run, after a stalking trip behind a three-wide wall of leaders in the backstretch—Roman Rosso, Prime Attraction, and the eventual winner—but came nowhere near Accelerate and had to settle for second, as the John Sadler trainee picked up his third grade 1 of the season.

Accelerate joined Lava Man (2006) and Game On Dude (2013) as the only horses to sweep the Santa Anita Handicap (G1), Gold Cup (G1), and Pacific Classic in one season.

"I've been training in Southern California my whole career, so to win this race down here (means a lot)," Sadler said of his first Pacific Classic score. "We've been second and third a lot of times, so it was fun to get the win today."

Joel Rosario rode Accelerate for the first time Saturday, with Victor Espinoza on the sideline. After some asking out of the gate, Rosario got his mount into a stalking position, although three wide, outside of Roman Rosso and Prime Attraction. Roman Rosso set fractions of :23.05, :46.69, and 1:11.25 through six furlongs, but took pressure in the backstretch. Accelerate was four lengths clear at the quarter pole and was under no threat the rest of the way.

"He's a very nice horse," Rosario said. "He put me in a good place, and took me to the outside, and we went from there."

Pavel finished 3 3/4 lengths clear of third-place finisher Prime Attraction, who was followed by Roman Rosso, Dr. Dorr, The Lieutenant, and Two Thirty Five, to complete the order of finish.

Accelerate now has an 8-5-5 record from 20 starts and more than \$2.3 million in earnings.

Kosta and Pete Hronis, who only started their venture into horse ownership in 2010, relished the moment of their 13th grade 1 score.

"I'm so happy for John Sadler (to get) his first Pacific Classic win," Kosta Hronis said. "For Hronis family to be a part of it—it's an honor. ... It's such an honor to be in the conversation (with Lava Man and Game On Dude). Those are all Hall of Fame horses. To be in that conversation is such an honor."

Kosta Hronis said he expects Accelerate to run in the Sept. 29 Awesome Again Stakes (G1) at Santa Anita Park to prep for the Breeders' Cup Classic (G1) at Churchill Downs in November. The Pacific Classic is a Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win and You're In" event, and guarantees Accelerate an automatic berth in the Classic starting gate.

Kosta Hronis was asked about Accelerate's potential for Horse of the Year honors, should the chestnut win the rest of his races in 2018.

"With all due respect to (Triple Crown winner) Justify, who was a brilliant horse and did something no one has ever done ... but that's 3-year-olds only,

restricted, two turns on dirt," Kosta Hronis said. "It's kind of a narrow lane compared to what this level of racing is. I guess I consider the Breeders' Cup the Super Bowl, not the 3-year-old races. ... Being in the same conversation with him is wonderful, but we'll see how it plays out."

Racing fans across the country established a one-day betting record at Del Mar Saturday, when they wagered \$25,969,128 on the 11-race card. The previous one-day record was \$25,126,232 set Aug. 20, 2016, also a Pacific Classic Day. BH



## GRADE 1 WINNER UNIQUE BELLA RETIRED

On Alberto Stable's three-time grade 1 winner and champion Unique Bella has been retired from racing after an ankle injury was discovered following her workout Aug. 18 at Del Mar.

Don Alberto executive director Fabricio Buffolo said a chip in her sesamoid was discovered after her fivefurlong drill in 1:01 flat over the Del Mar main track Saturday morning.

The 4-year-old Tapit filly was training toward a start in the Sept. 30 Zenyatta Stakes (G1) at Santa Anita Park. An eight-time graded winner, three of her last four victories were at the grade 1 level—the Dec. 26 La Brea Stakes, June 2 Beholder Mile Stakes, and the July 29 Clement L. Hirsch Stakes.

Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer was unavailable for comment Saturday afternoon.

"Unique Bella has a very special place in our hearts and has brought so much joy to myself, my mother Liliana and the whole Don Alberto family," Don Alberto owner Carlos Heller said in a statement. "She blessed us with our first grade 1 win in the U.S. and we will be forever grateful for her and her time on the track. We are disappointed to announce her retirement, however her health and well being come first for us at Don Alberto.

"That's what we are here for, to do what's in the best interest of the horse. I want to congratulate Jerry Hollendorfer and (jockey) Mike Smith, who together guided her to a stellar campaign, culminating in becoming an Eclipse champion (for female sprinter). I think it's a remarkable achievement to have won (grade 1 races) over (seven furlongs), a mile, and a mile and sixteenth. We look forward to having her at our farm in Lexington, where she will enjoy her new career as a broodmare."

The large gray was a physical specimen as soon as she showed up to train in Southern California, and although she finished second in her debut in 2016, she went on a five-race tear from late 2016 into the fall of 2017. The run included graded scores in the Santa Ynez Stakes (G2), Las Virgenes Stakes (G2), Santa Ysabel Stakes (G3), and L.A. Woman Stakes (G3).

She finished seventh as the favorite in the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint (G1), then bounced back to win the La Brea to cap her 2017 season, which clinched her title as champion female sprinter. The only defeat of her 2018 campaign was a second-place run in the Apple Blossom Handicap (G1) at Oaklawn Park, her only start outside of California, in which she missed the break, rushed to the front, and was passed late by Unbridled Mo.

She returned with authority to win the Beholder

Mile by 2 1/4 lengths after a duel with fellow grade 1 winner Paradise Woods, then held off a late run by La Force to take the Clement L. Hirsch by a half-length in her final

She had a 9-2-0 record from 12 starts and earned more than \$1.2 million. Bred in Pennsylvania by Brushwood Stable out of the grade 1-winning Unbridled's Song mare Unrivaled Belle, she was a \$400,000 purchase by Don Alberto from Eaton Sales' consignment to the 2015 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. BH

#### WINX SCORES 26TH STRAIGHT VICTORY

xpect the unexpected in horse racing, but when Winx is concerned, you can make a rare exception.

The darling of Australian racing seized Black Caviar's record for consecutive wins Aug. 18 by extending her unbeaten run to 26 races, recording a third successive triumph in what is now the Winx Stakes (G1), a Royal Randwick contest renamed from the Warwick Stakes in honor of the wondermare.

There were cheers for Winx, who retained her position as the world's best racehorse in the latest Longines rankings last week, when she entered the paddock. Rapturous applause greeted her return to the winner's enclosure.

mark, with Winx in mid-division and with significant ground to make up. But, in her customary fashion, the 7-year-old powered home on the outside to defeat Invictus Prince by two lengths under regular rider Hugh Bowman.

"It's a while since she's run over this distance, and it's not as comfortable riding her, as it's a bit short of her best trip," Bowman said. "She was struggling at the pace over this distance, but when she balanced up and saw the winning post, she took off.

"She's just incredible. There are lots of parents with their children here, and that's what I love the most—all generations are coming here to see a horse of a caliber that we may never see again. These horses come along only once in a lifetime, and she's such a special athlete. I'm so proud of her."

All eyes were on Winx, as she tracked her perceived main danger Kementari for most of the race, and as the pacesetters started to come back to the principals, it was the star mare who hit top gear to win with plenty in hand.

"I've been looking for signs of her losing her dominance since her last win," said trainer Chris Waller, wiping away tears of joy and pride. "She hasn't lost one ounce of it. If anything I've seen improvement, and that's quite staggering.

"This is not about me—it's about the amazing Winx. What she's done for the sport in Australia is incredible. She never looks like she's dominant in her races, but when it comes to the pressure point, she just breaks their hearts, as they can't live with her.



#### MARTINE BELLOCQ ACCEPTS PINCAY AWARD AT DEL MAR

It was a surprise, but it also wasn't.
Trainer Martine Bellocq did something
Aug. 18 that would have been unthinkable
months ago, after severe burns from the
Lilac Fire scarred her body and forced the
amputation of her left leg.

During the ceremony for the Laffit Pincay Jr. Award, the wheelchair-bound Bellocq stood up on her right leg to wave to the Del Mar crowd. She had told her daughter, Natacha, she was planning on standing, but didn't tell her husband, Pierre Bellocq Jr.

"It was a surprise, but to a point," Pierre said. "I know her well."

Considering what she's been through since the devastating fire swept through San Luis Rey Training Center in Southern California Dec. 7, standing up for a quick wave was no comparison. This is a woman who went into an inferno in an attempt to rescue a prized horse named Wild Bill Hickory—an act of bravery that was the signature, albeit horrifying, moment of the tragedy.

In her first trip back to any racetrack since the fire that killed nearly 50 horses, Martine accepted the Pincay Award from the Hall of Fame rider himself in the Del Mar winner's circle, after a video montage looking back at the tremendous challenges of the fire. The Pincay Award is given to those who have served the sport "with integrity, extraordinary dedication, determination, and distinction."

"It was very emotional, to say the least," Pierre said.
"It was a moment of pride for Martine and she really handled herself beautifully. This whole thing—she's gone so far physically. But like usual, her spirit is at the top all the time. I'm very happy for her."

After the emotional ceremony Pierre emphasized the larger message of love for the horses from those who care for them on the backstretches of the world. Martine was one of many brave track workers who risked their lives to help save the horses at San Luis Rey.

"She's been recognized for her actions and this is a prestigious award, but this is her family—her racetrack family," Pierre said. "She told me, 'Why am I getting this?" Bob Baffert won two Triple Crowns and I'm getting this?'

"She's really honored, but she's very sincere about getting this award for all the people at the racetrack—here and everywhere else in the world. In a way this is for them. All the people who work on the backstretch—they do love the horses. Otherwise they wouldn't be there. They all would have done the same thing." BH

#### NEEPAWA COMPLETES A CASSE CANADIAN TRIPLE CROWN

B ob Baffert isn't the only Triple Crown-winning trainer this year.

Trainer Mark Casse completed a personal Triple Crown Aug. 18 when Chiefswood Stable homebred Neepawa delivered a front-running win in the \$400,000 Breeders' Stakes on the Woodbine lawn.

Neepawa's 3 1/2-length victory in Saturday's 1 1/2-mile turf test for 3-year-olds foaled in Canada followed victories by the Casse-trained filly Wonder Gadot in the first two legs of Canada's Triple Crown: the Queen's Plate Stakes at Woodbine and the Prince of Wales Stakes at Fort Erie Racetrack. Casse opted to have Wonder Gadot skip the Breeders' Stakes in favor of an Aug. 25 start in the \$1.25 million Runhappy Travers Stakes (G1) at Saratoga Race Course.

Casse watched the race on television from his house in Saratoga Springs, N.Y.

"So much was written about us not going to the Breeders' Stakes with Wonder Gadot, so it was nice to complete the sweep with Neepawa," Casse said. "It was special."

While Wonder Gadot again will take on the boys in the Travers, Neepawa carried the Casse baton Saturday under jockey Jerome Lermyte. The colt found the yielding turf to his liking, looking comfortable as he opened a clear lead through a half-mile in :49.98. Coming off the far turn, Neepawa added to his advantage—opening up five lengths in

early stretch—and he carried that momentum to the wire, completing the race in 2:31.18.

Neepawa returned \$6.80 to win, \$3.60 to place, and \$3.10 to show. Runner-up Say the Word paid \$4.50 to place and \$3.40 to show while longshot Flight Deck paid \$7.90 to show.

"The plan was to keep him comfortable," Lermyte said.
"He went to the lead. He actually jumped somewhere
around there, he jumped whatever he saw on the
(ground), but then he relaxed quite a bit even though he
was going a little bit faster than what I was planning on
going. The main thing is I wanted him to be comfortable
so he could produce the best effort at the end."

Like U.S. Triple Crown winner Justify, Neepawa is a son of Scat Daddy. Neepawa is the second Breeders' Stakes winner trained by Casse, following Marchfield in 2007.

After an off-the-board finish in the Queen's Plate, contested June 30 on the all-weather track at Woodbine, Neepawa entered off a third-place finish in the July 28 Toronto Cup Stakes on the Woodbine turf, where he started slow and rallied. Neepawa secured his first stakes win in Saturday's Breeders' Stakes.

"I was a little worried when I saw him on the lead so early, but the pace was slow and the track was heavy and he can run all day so it was good," said owner Robert Krembil of Chiefswood Stable.

Casse noted that the barn had confidence in Neepawa, who is the first winner for stakes-winning Niigon mare Niigon's Touch

"He has terrific breeding and he's always been talented," Casse said. "It was just a matter of putting it all together. It was a nice win." BH

#### ESKIMO KISSES UPSETS ALABAMA STAKES

Eskimo Kisses was last of all early but full of run when it counted Aug. 18 in the \$600,000 Alabama Stakes (G1) at Saratoga Race Course.

The To Honor and Serve filly spotted pacesetter Talk Veuve to Me 15 1/2 lengths up the backside, but picked up steam headed into the final turn under Jose Ortiz and shifted out to run down the leader.

Off at odds of 9-1 in a field of eight 3-year-old fillies for the 1 1/4-mile test, Eskimo Kisses drew off to her first graded stakes score by 6 1/2 lengths in a final time of 2:03.22.

Midnight Bisou, favored at 6-5, finished third behind runner-up She's a Julie, who pressed the pace early.

"We were hoping they would ignore us a little bit, and they did," trainer Kenny McPeek said. "The pace of the race was going to be a big deal for her, even the setup. She's had some races where it really didn't set up all that well for her."

Indiana Oaks (G3) winner Talk Veuve to Me set a quick tempo in the Alabama, giving Eskimo Kisses plenty of pace to close into. After fractions of 22.52, 46.90, and 1:11.86, the spotlight shifted to the dirt-splattered filly who was no longer bringing up the rear.

"She's a big, late-running type. She's a filly that likes a little heavier going, and I think it was that today and she went a mile and a quarter," McPeek said. "I told Jose to sit on her a certain way and we couldn't control what fractions they gave us, we just had to hope it unfolded for us. ... I felt like I was a winner at the half-mile pole the way they were already backing up to her when he hadn't moved. I'd given him instructions not to move until they straightened up, and when she split horses and he still hadn't moved, I was counting, just get to the wire."

Ortiz said the plan came together.

"I just followed instructions and did what Kenny told me to do: Take her back, let her take me to the half-mile pole, and then let her do the rest," Ortiz said. "I tried to stay inside as long as I could. She was there for me every time I asked her to move up and I'm just very happy with the way she ran today."

Eskimo Kisses hit the front as a mile went in 1:37.90, and drew off down the lane. Grade 1 winner Midnight Bisou, off a July 22 second to Monomoy Girl in the 1 1/8-mile Coaching Club American Oaks (G1), made a four-wide move but never threatened the winner and could not get past She's a Julie, who re-rallied after getting passed to earn second by a neck.

Hall of Fame jockey Mike Smith said Midnight Bisou does not get over the Saratoga surface well.

"A mile and a quarter might be a bit too far, and this is probably not her favorite racetrack," Smith said. "She moves over Belmont better than she moves over this track. I said it the first time (after

the Coaching Club American Oaks) and I say it even more this time. You watch her head at Belmont and she holds her head up as pretty as can be. She really struggles with it (at Saratoga)."

Eskimo Kisses, who came off a fourth in the Coaching Club American Oaks, landed her third win and her first since February, when she broke her maiden and picked up an allowance score, both at Oaklawn Park. After running second in March in the Twinspires.com Fair Grounds Oaks (G2), she earned a grade 1 placing in April with a runner-up finish in the Central Bank Ashland Stakes (G1) at Keeneland, her first of three straight meetings with Monomoy Girl. She was fourth to that rival in the May 4 Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) before a brief rest set her up for her summer campaign.

Eskimo Kisses, owned by Gainesway Stable, Harold Lerner, Andrew Rosen, Nehoc Stables, and Magdalena Racing, improved her earnings to \$698,935. She was bred in Kentucky by Gainesway Thoroughbreds out of the Mr. Greeley mare Silver Colors, a daughter of Hall of Famer Winning Colors. Silver Colors foaled a Union Rags filly this year, and has an Empire Maker colt consigned by Gainesway as Hip 406 to the Keeneland September Yearling Sale. Eskimo Kisses is her first grade 1 winner.

"She got about a 30 or 40-day break at my farm at Lexington, and there's a lot of people that put a lot of work in to get us here," McPeek said of the filly's journey to the top. "My farm staff, my team at Keeneland, and of course up here. But she's a really good filly, and things fell our way today." BH

#### RUSHING FALL RETURNS TO WINNING WAYS IN LAKE PLACID

In her first race in more than three months, 2017 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf (G1T) winner Rushing Fall delivered an eye-catching win in the \$300,000 Lake Placid Stakes (G2T) Aug. 18 at Saratoga Race Course.

Moving on her own in the far turn of the 1 1/8-mile test for 3-year-old fillies, the More Than Ready filly took command after tracking early leader Go Noni Go. Rushing Fall and jockey Javier Castellano opened a clear lead into the stretch and were never seriously challenged en route to posting a 2 3/4-length win over grade 1 winner Capla Temptress, who rallied for second but never threatened the winner.


In her previous start, Rushing Fall finished second by a neck to Toinette in the Edgewood Stakes presented by Forcht Bank (G3T) May 4 at Churchill Downs. That narrow defeat on Kentucky Oaks Day marked her first loss, but in her sixth start Saturday the Chad Brown trainee bounced back.

Campaigned by Bob Edwards' e Five Racing Thoroughbreds and trained by Chad Brown, Rushing Fall completed Saturday's 1 1/8-mile race for 3-year-old fillies in 1:51.86 on a Mellon Turf Course rated as yielding.

"I like the way she ran on the yielding turf. I think we took advantage of it," Castellano said. "All the credit goes to Chad Brown. He was patient with the filly. Skipping the (Lake George) paid off today. She's a nice filly and she did excellent."

The race marked the longest start to date for Rushing Fall.

"She ran great. She obviously handled the soft going well. We expected her to," Brown said. "Javier really rode a great race and adapted to the slow pace. He let her lay really close and a mile-and-an-eighth may be a little far for her, but he really waited to push the button on her and when he did, she really responded. I'm so proud of her. She got beat at Churchill a day before the (Kentucky) Derby, her first defeat, (then) shipped back home and wasn't quite right. I really wanted to run her in the (grade 1) Belmont Oaks, but she couldn't make it. Bob Edwards was patient and it certainly paid off today."

Brown said he's not sure of Rushing Fall's next target, but he will consider the Queen Elizabeth Challenge Cup Stakes Presented by Lane's End (G1T) on the turf at Keeneland, where Rushing Fall has already won a pair of graded stakes. He could train her up to that Keeneland start in October or race first in the Sept. 15 Sands Point Stakes (G2T) at Belmont Park.

Sent off the favorite, Rushing Fall paid \$4.70, \$3.40, and \$2.70 across the board while Capla Temptress returned \$8.20 and \$4.70 to place and show. Daddy Is a Legend finished third and paid \$3.40.

Rushing Fall was bred in Kentucky by Fred Hertrich III and John Fielding. She is out of the placed Forestry mare Autumnal, who has produced five winners from as many starters including stakes winner Milam and stakes-placed Autumn Song. Mike Ryan bought Rushing Fall for \$320,000 from Taylor Made Sales Agency's consignment to The Saratoga Sale in 2016, and the Lake Placid victory pushed her earnings to \$1,008,000.

Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott was pleased with the runner-up finish by Capla Temptress.

"She ran really well. I guess the winner is a very good filly," Mott said. "We had a good trip. He tipped out and she made a good run. Maybe next time we won't run into that one." BH

## FASHION BUSINESS MAKES EARLY MOVE TO TAKE DEL MAR 'CAP

The second time through the backstretch of the \$250,000 Del Mar Handicap Presented by The Japan Racing Association (G2T), jockey Flavien Prat had seen enough.

Aboard Little Red Feather Racing and Marsha Naify's Fashion Business, Prat felt the pace was too slow, so he made his move.

It was a gamble, because he was several paths from the rail, but the 4-year-old Frankel gelding unleashed a turn of foot in the last of three turns that made ground loss inconsequential. Four wide in the final Del Mar bend, Fashion Business blew by the leaders in the 1 3/8-mile test and rolled to the wire 5 1/4 lengths ahead of his nearest competitor and finished off the distance in 2:13.84.

"On the backside I could tell they were going slow, and I went a little wide around there," Prat said. "I know it takes a little while to go around. I just kept digging in and he just finished."

Ashleyluvssugar took the lead early and ran the first quarter in :24.64, but was soon overtaken by Kenjisstorm, who opened up a 1 1/2-length advantage through a half-mile in :48.91 and continued on through six furlongs in 1:13.60 and a mile in 1:38.10.

Prat made his move, however, and the race was on only for the minors. Trained by Phil D'Amato, Fashion

Business had a four-length lead with a furlong to go and extended the margin to the wire. D'Amato's second entry, 45-1 longshot Ya Gotta Wanna, overcame traffic trouble in the final turn to close for second, 1 1/4 lengths ahead of Multiplier in third.

Fashion Business came into the race winless in four starts over the Del Mar turf course, but D'Amato was confident he would turn in a top performance Saturday.

"I think Flavien just sense they were going so slow, it was a now or never-type move," the trainer said.

"His race at Belmont (a fifth in the grade 1 Manhattan) was better than it looked ... (and his eighth-place finish in the grade 1 Eddie Read)—the mile and an eighth—we used that as a prep for this race and it just worked out."

Behind Multiplier came Colonist, Flamboyant, Ashleyluvssugar, Itsinthepost, Cashman, Unapologetic, and Kenjisstorm, to complete the order of finish. Whoop Whoop was eased and vanned off.

Bred in England by Andrew Rosen, out of the Empire Maker mare Icon Project, Fashion Business now has a 3-3-1 record from 12 starts and \$283,885 in earnings. He is the first graded winner for Frankel in the United States. BH

## FATALE BERE EDGES OLLIE'S CANDY IN DEL MAR OAKS

Patale Bere had one filly to beat in the stretch to earn her first grade 1 win Aug. 18 at Del Mar, and she found just enough.

With the clear target of Ollie's Candy ahead in the \$300,000 Del Mar Oaks Presented by The Jockey Club (G1T), the Pedro the Great filly and jockey Kent Desormeaux accelerated in the final furlong and caught their rival by a neck at the wire in a final time of 1:48.14 for 1 1/8 miles over firm turf.

The victory was also the first grade 1 score for trainer Leonard Powell. Fatale Bere, who opened the year with a win in the April 7 Providencia Stakes (G3T), is owned by Benowitz Family Trust, Head of Plains Partners, Mark Mathiesen, and Mathilde Powell.

"To win a grade 1 is of great value and this filly that I scouted a year ago in France and purchased privately for owners that have been very loyal to the stable," Powell said.

The complexion of the race changed as the field approached the final turn in the Oaks, as frontrunner Animosity—who set fractions of :23.26 and :47.01 through a half-mile—ducked in and hit the rail at about the three-eighths pole and dropped back through the field.

"I don't know what happened to her," said Animosity's jockey, Tyler Gaffalione. "She was going along fine and all of the sudden she changed leads and shifted over and hit the fence. She lost her action. I had to get her back running again. I don't know what it was."

That put Ollie's Candy and Ms Bad Behavior, who were in a stalking position, into a duel to the wire. Ollie's Candy put away Ms Bad Behavior, who

eventually came in fourth, but just came up short at the finish.

"It was the trip," Desormeaux said. "Today I got the trip. ... This time I got to let her go when I was ready. (It) felt good. She was really running. There were playing ping pong by the three-eighths, but I avoided all of that and just got to run my race."

It was the second tough beat for Ollie's Candy, who also finished second by a neck last time out in the July 21 San Clemente (G2T) at Del Mar.

"She was on it today—ran a really good race " said jockey Tyler Baze, who piloted Ollie's Candy for the first time Saturday. "She was push button."

Two lengths behind the top pair came Californiagoldrush, who was followed by Ms Bad Behavior, Colonia, Paved, Movie Moment, Fool's Paradise, Ms Peintour, So Hi Society, Animosity, and Streetwithnoname, to complete the order of finish.

Bred in France by SNC Regnier and San Gabriel Inv. out of the Saumarez mare Mofa Bere, Fatale Bere now has five wins from 10 starts and \$422,964 in earnings. BH

#### AMERICAN PHAROAH FILLY SHINES AT AROANA FIRST SESSION

Deauville will welcome a galaxy of Hollywood stars for its American Film Festival at the end of the month, but before then it is the Arqana August Yearling Sale that takes over the town.

This year's renewal had its own touch of U.S. glamour Aug. 18, as a filly from the first crop of Triple Crown hero American Pharoah stopped the show in the opening scenes.

The half sister to Darley Yorkshire Oaks (G1) and Qatar Prix Vermeille (G1) winner Shareta, as well as three other stakes performers, was consigned as Lot 34 and presented by Haras d'Etreham on behalf of breeders Barronstown Stud. She was knocked down to Coolmore's M.V. Magnier for €750,000 (US \$857,850).

Barronstown have been rewarded for two bold choices for the mating. They bought the dam, the listed-winning Barathea mare Shawara, for €550,000 (\$741,455) as a 15-year-old from the Aga Khan Studs

draft at the Goffs November Sale in 2013, and they then decided to send her to Kentucky for a tryst with American Pharoah, who wowed the world with his champion juvenile season and victories in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (G1), Preakness Stakes (G1), Belmont Stakes presented by Draftkings (G1), and Breeders' Cup Classic (G1)—but never raced on turf.

Magnier is in agreement that the stallion, who stands at Coolmore's Ashford Stud, will be an effective sire of turf horses, saying after he signed the docket: "I remember Bob Baffert (trainer) saying to me that he always thought American Pharoah would have also made a good grass horse, and this was just a lovely filly who'll probably head to Ballydoyle."

Magnier later added: "It all goes back to the American classic horse. And we strongly believe in American Pharoah. He really could be the next big thing.

"Be it him, or Justify, we think that a horse of that type can once again have a transforming impact on European bloodlines. So that's what we want to do: to get the best American Pharoahs we can, put them in Ballydoyle, and try to make him a new Northern Dancer. Remember Scat Daddy was an all-American hero, too, and look what he has been able to do on turf in Europe."

There is one other chance to buy a yearling by American Pharoah at Arqana this weekend—the filly out of grade 3 winner Marbre Rose who will be offered Sunday by Ecurie des Monceaux as Lot 158.

The session's top lot will head in the opposite direction across the Atlantic, as U.S. agent Justin Casse went to €810,000 (\$926,478) for a Galileo filly out of Tender Morn offered by Haras des Capucines.

The filly is a sibling to four black-type performers, including the group 3 Prix d'Aumale winner Zantenda and last year's Killavullan Stakes scorer Kenya, who is also by Galileo.

"She's from a very good family, has a lot of quality to her and has a lot of substance for a Galileo," said Casse. "She had a tremendous walk and every time I went out to see her she was the same horse; her temperament is great.

"She'll go to America and be trained by my brother (Mark)."

Casse has enjoyed success with previous Arqana purchases, including Zayat Stables' stakes-winning Frankel colt Gidu—a half brother to Marbre Rose, the dam of the other American Pharoah filly—who finished a creditable sixth in the Commonwealth Cup (G1).

Buyers did not have to wait long to get stuck in to the catalog, as Emmanuel de Seroux of Narvick International went to €600,000 (\$686, 280) to land the sale's opening lot, a Galileo filly out of Naissance Royaleoffered by perennial leading vendor Monceaux.

De Seroux, bidding from the restaurant behind Eric Hoyeau's rostrum, said his clients wished to remain anonymous, but explained the well-related filly would be heading abroad to begin her racing career.

"She's been bought to go to Japan," he said. "She's the perfect outcross for the Sunday Silence-line stallions out there. She's a very good-looking filly and obviously her catalog page is perfect."

The February foal is out of Naissance Royale, a daughter of the late, great Giant's Causeway who won three grade 2's while in training with Christophe Clement. Since retiring to the paddocks she has bred four winners, including this filly's group 3-placed full sister Jadhaba, herself a €620,000 (\$830,800) yearling at the 2014 August Sale.

The €600,000 mark was matched for another Monceaux offering later in the session when Oliver St Lawrence struck a winning bid of that sum for a Frankel colt out of the listed-winning Oasis Dream mare Sabratah.

St Lawrence was acting on behalf of longstanding client Fawzi Nass, the Bahraini owner of stars such as Krypton Factor and Jordan Sport, both of whom he also trained.
