OWNERS LAY GROUNDWORK FOR TAPWRIT AT STUD

When Tapwrit, the 2017 Belmont Stakes presented by NYRA Bets (G1) winner, enters stud at Gainesway Farm next year, he will have the benefit of a group of mares handpicked by his prominent ownership group.

During the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, a select group of mares has been purchased under the name Gainesway/Bridlewood/Tapwrit for the express purpose of supporting the stallion in his first season.

Represented at Keeneland by Gainesway's Neil Howard and Michael Hernon and Bridlewood's George Isaacs, the partnership had purchased 17 mares for \$1,437,000 midway through the Nov. 10 sixth session. The most expensive mare bought by the group was Pocket of Aces (Hip 938), a daughter of Harlan's Holiday acquired from ELiTE for \$160,000.

Hernon said the strategy, with some 40 mares as the goal, is part of a commitment from Bridlewood's John Malone, Gainesway's Antony Beck, and prominent horse owner-breeder Mandy Pope, who is part of the Tapwrit ownership group.

"We just want to get the horse off to the best possible start, so he's getting a ton of support from some key individuals," Hernon said. "The Keeneland buying effort is just to put a group of quality mares under the stallion in order to maximize his initial success at stud."

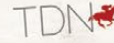
"He is the first grade 1 winner that we (Bridlewood) were partners in and had a lot of fun with," Isaacs said. "He has a great pedigree. We are trying to show we believe in our product and are more than happy to support him."

A \$1.2 million yearling purchase by Bridlewood, Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners, and Robert LaPenta from Denali Stud's consignment to the 2015 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Sale, Tapwrit is out of 2006 Spinaway Stakes (G1) winner and multiple graded stakes producer Appealing Zophie, who is also the dam of 2018 Del Mar Derby (G2T) winner Ride a Comet.

Trained by Todd Pletcher, Tapwrit was a stakes winner at 2, then set a stakes record in the 1 1/16-mile Lambholm South Tampa Bay Derby (G2), when he won by 4 1/2 lengths in 1:42.36. He then followed a troubled sixth-place finish in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (G1) with a two-length score in the Belmont.

Tapwrit enters stud next year alongside his sire, three-time leading sire Tapit, for a \$12,500 fee.

In selecting mares that match up best with Tapwrit, the buyers are looking for speedy, young fillies and mares.

"He's 16.2 hands—a rangy horse," Herson said. "We're looking to add a little bit of speed to his pedigree, and we like young fillies and mares that raced with some success and showed precocity."

Herson said there is a lot of flexibility with the bloodlines of possible Tapwrit mares, since he is a son

of Tapit and Gainesway can draw from its successful experiences with Tapizar, who is off to a quick start at stud, with his sophomore daughter Monomoy Girl a divisional leader this year.

"We know what works with Tapit, which is basically everything," Herson said. "What stands out

are the Mr. Propsector- and Storm Cat-line sires. Tapizar has gone to the top of his class. Of course he is the sire of Monomoy Girl, whose dam is by Henny Hughes, so we have seen this cross produce successful runners before."

Herson said Tapwrit has all the qualities desired by breeders in a stallion, and that the 4-year-old colt

bred in Kentucky by My Meadowview has been well received so far.

"Everybody who has seen him at the farm has wanted to jump on the train," Herson said. "We anticipate he will breed to 175 to 200 mares. He has gained good weight, and I really like his temperament. He has grown into his big frame. He is a knockout physical." BH

EXERCISE RIDER DIES IN TRAINING ACCIDENT AT CHURCHILL

Exercise rider Odanis Acuna died after a training accident in the early hours of Nov. 10 at Churchill Downs. The long-time member of trainer Kenny McPeek's team sustained fatal injuries to his head and neck when the horse he was working broke down.

"I can't even comprehend it," McPeek said.

For more than a decade, Acuna worked for McPeek, in addition to holding down a second job at a local feed store. McPeek said in all his time as a trainer, he has never witnessed an accident of this severity during training.

"He's worked for me for ten years—never been late, loved his work, worked a second job," McPeek said of Acuna. "He was a family man. He has three children—three boys, two are twins—he's married and a native of Cuba. He was so great to have on the team, and we're all just sick."

According to a news release from Churchill Downs, the accident occurred around 5:45 a.m. ET, when the horse Odanis was breezing suddenly fell about a sixteenth of a mile before the finish line. The horse has since been identified as New York Harbor, an unraced 2-year-old Verrazano colt out of the Crafty Friend mare Friend of a Friend.

The horse was euthanized shortly after and training was cancelled for the rest of the morning.

"We had two 2-year-olds working in a set," McPeek said. "(New York Harbor) was supposed to make his first start next weekend and evidently broke either one or both sesamoids in the workout. Sadly Odanis went down with the horse.

"As long as I've been at it, I've had a rider hurt an arm or a leg—never anything major. We're just all really sad and trying to work through it."

Sherry Stanley, executive director of the Backside Learning Center at Churchill Downs, described Acuna in the Churchill release as "the happiest, most joyful

person," dedicated to bringing his family in Cuba over to join him in the U.S. McPeek said prior to the accident, Acuna was in the process of trying to buy a house.

"He was the hardest worker," Stanley said. "I know everyone always says that about people on the backside, but this guy was unbelievable. He worked as an exercise rider and went running out the gates after training every day to get on the feed trucks. He would work every day until 6 or 7 at night and always had a smile on his face. No one ever saw him angry or sad. This is just an unbelievable tragedy."

Plans to create a GoFundMe page to help offer aid to Acuna's family are already in place, and McPeek said he hoped the crowd-funding page would be live by the end of the day. In the meantime the trainer is working with Churchill Downs to help contact Acuna's family in Cuba to make the necessary arrangements going forward.

"He was a good man—a very good man," McPeek said. "It's not an easy day. Just a really bad day. Our heart was swallowed."

Churchill Downs observed a moment of silence for Acuna at 12:30 p.m. ET Saturday, prior to the start of the first race at the track. **BH**

GRADYS TAKE HOME MARES TO BREED TO GIRVIN

All week, Brad and Misty Grady and their team had been scouring the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, picking up mares to breed to their grade 1 winner Girvin, who enters stud next year at Ocala Stud near Ocala, Fla.

While they had already acquired nearly a dozen mares entering the Nov. 10 sixth session of the sale in Lexington, the Gradys waited until Saturday to make their most expensive purchase, taking home K J Warrior, a daughter of Tapit, for \$235,000, topping the day's action.

Keeneland reported 223 horses sold Saturday for a total of \$7,236,400 for an average of \$32,450 and a median of \$20,000. There are no comparable figures from 2017 as a result of a format change this year. The 103 horses that did not sell represented an RNA rate of 31.6%.

Cumulatively, Keeneland has sold 1,317 horses for \$165,159,900 for an average of \$125,406 and a median of \$67,000, with an RNA rate of 26.8%.

The session topper was consigned as Hip 2123 by Francis and Barbara Vanlangendonck's Summerfield, as agent for Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings. The winning 4-year-old mare was produced from the multiple stakes-winning Harlan's Holiday mare J Z Warrior and is believed to be in foal to Kantharos on a last cover date of Feb. 26. J Z Warrior is a half sister to grade 1 winner A Z Warrior, grade 2 winner Jojo Warrior, and grade 3 winner E Z Warrior.

"We liked her, she's got a fast family. We think she'll fit well with Girvin," Brad Grady said.

Through the end of Saturday's session, the Gradys had purchased 12 horses for total receipts of \$1,214,800, at an average price of \$101,167.

"We're trying to find some speed and obviously (mares) as pretty and correct as we can buy," Grady

said of their strategy. "We're putting some classic pedigrees to him too. We don't know what's going to work, so we're trying a little variety."

Girvin will stand the 2019 season for \$7,500 under a partnership of the Gradys' Grand Oaks Farm, Airdrie Stud, and Ocala Stud in a deal structured by West Bloodstock. A son of Tale of Ekati, Girvin was bred in Kentucky by Bob Austin and John Witte out of the Malibu Moon mare Catch the Moon and is a half brother to 2015 Iroquois Stakes (G3) winner Cocked and Loaded. He was a \$130,000 purchase from Legacy Bloodstock's consignment to Fasig-Tipton's The October Sale in 2015.

Girvin retired with a record of four wins and three seconds from 10 starts and earnings of \$1,624,392. Trained by Joe Sharp, he scored back-to-back stakes victories in the Risen Star Stakes (G2) and the Twinspires.com Louisiana Derby (G2), and he went postward in the 2017 Kentucky Derby Presented by

Yum! Brands (G1) as the top points earner on the Kentucky Derby leaderboard. Following a troubled 13th-place finish in the Derby, Girvin finished a close second in the Ohio Derby (G3) before capturing the Betfair.com Haskell Invitational Stakes (G1). Girvin was runner-up to Bee Jersey in the Steve Sexton Mile Stakes (G3) at Lone Star Park in his lone 2018 start.

Jacob West, who along with Bobby Dodd of Grand Oaks are assisting the Gradys in their quest for mares at Keeneland, said the couple is committed to providing the horse that took them on a great ride along the Triple Crown trail with every opportunity to succeed in his new career.

"They are getting behind this horse to give him every chance to succeed because he took them on a trip of a lifetime," West said. "They are making a financial commitment. They are making an emotional commitment. They said they want to do what's best for the horse so we came up with a game plan of what that would look like. They own some mares, but the majority they own are fillies that were bought as yearlings."

West said a diverse group of mares will fit with Girvin's pedigree.

"He's a little bit of an outcross for a lot of mares," West said. "Brad and Misty are going to breed a lot of mares with speed, which is kind of ideal. Unbridled's Song was very precocious and seems like a lot of his sons are too, as well as being beautiful horses and are passing that along."

Saturday's second-highest seller was I'm Pretty Strong, a 3-year-old daughter of Street Cry out of Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (G1T) winner Shared Account, by Pleasantly Perfect. The filly sold to Boomer Bloodstock on behalf of Australian clients for \$220,000. Consigned by Upson Downs Farm, agent, I'm Pretty Strong is from the family of grade 2 winners Sapphire n' Silk and Shaniko, grade 3 winner Golden Itiz, and stakes winner Colonial Flag.

En Fuego Stables bought the session's top-priced weanling, paying \$145,000 for a filly by Kitten's Joy. Perrone Sales, agent, consigned the filly (Hip 2268) out of the winning Honour and Glory mare Sunday Sport and from the family of grade 1 winner Contredance.

The sale continues through Nov. 16, with daily sessions beginning at 10 a.m. EST. **BH**

"She's been purchased for clients in Australia," Rounsefell said of the \$220,000 purchase. "We think that the residual value as a broodmare prospect is good. She's very exciting."

Bred in Pennsylvania by Sagamore Farm, the stakes-placed filly has won two of her seven career starts, with earnings of \$60,994. Consigned as Hip 2099 by Upton Downs Farm, she is out of the Pleasantly Perfect mare Shared Account, a grade 1 winner on the turf who took the 2010 Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (G1T) for trainer

"Street Cry is a proven stallion all over the world, particularly in Australia," Rounsefell said. "And she's out of a turf mare."

While I'm Pretty Strong was purchased predominantly as a broodmare prospect for Rounsefell's clients, the bloodstock agent said the 3-year-old filly could continue to race should she show progress in Australia.

On the track this filly has shown a lot of ability in seven starts to date," he said. "We think physically she's still quite immature and we think she'll really develop, but we've got time until the breeding season next year so we'll put her in training."

Earlier in the sale Rounsefell purchased Hip 385—the More Than Ready mare Ginger N Rye, also consigned by Upson Downs—for \$350,000. Bred in Maryland by Sagamore Farm out of the Mr. Greely mare La Milanesa, the 6-year-old is a black-type stakes winner from the family of grade 1 winner Hometown Queen.

With several Australian buyers on the scene during this year's renewal of the marathon sale, Rounsefell said the strength of the market around the world and breeders' desire to infuse established bloodlines with new pedigrees has inspired them to make a trip to the Northern Hemisphere.

"I think if you look at the statistics, American mares have done well in Australia," Rounsefell said. "They've overachieved percentage-wise. There is a small number of them in Australia and they've really

done well. They produce top quality horses and any stallions at stud in Australia are out of American mares.

"I think the gene pool in Australia is getting very condensed down the Danehill line. There are Australian buyers here trying to expand their bloodlines and also bring in the American speed and continue that down rather than do it the European way. There's a lot here. The market has been very strong in Australia too, so I think people are trying to replenish their broodmare bands and this is the best place to do it." **BH**

When Sabrina Moore watched Knicks Go storm home to win the Oct. 6 Claiborne Breeder's Futurity (G1) at Keeneland by a commanding 5 1/2 lengths, the sweetness of having bred her first grade 1 winner was overwhelming.

But watching that same horse chase down the leader a month later in the Nov. 2 Sentient Jet Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) to place second, only 2 1/4 lengths behind the victor, was nothing short of surreal.

"Honestly, I blacked out," Moore said laughing. "I remember it happening but it all happened in about three seconds. It was great because the owners, I'd met them maybe a minute before the race, and I'm screaming for them, holding onto them, and jumping. I was celebrating even before the results were official."

And there was definitely reason to celebrate. After having won the Claiborne Futurity at odds of 40-1, the longest odds for any winner in the history of the race, the colt was sent out at the same odds in the Juvenile.

"I was really shocked to see that he was still 40-1 but he had a lot of local people who gave him support," Moore said. "I have a local handicapper friend who said, 'I'm betting

the farm!' and I think he made out well. I'm glad that I wasn't the only one to bet on him. It was really fun and cool, because he's a Maryland-bred, to see all of the Maryland people who were involved, betting on him and cheering him on."

But after the high of the races comes the brass tacks of commercial breeding. Shipping down to Kentucky for the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, Moore has returned to the sales scene with a half brother to her surprise winner. Moore has high hopes for colt's younger brother, consigned as Hip 2521 by Bill Reightler.

Bred in Maryland at Moore's Greenmount Farm, the grey or roan colt by Broken Vow is out of the Outflanker mare Kosmo's Buddy. Moore sold the dam privately earlier in the summer.

"This one, he is so strong, and he has so much more body to him than of lot of the mare's foals," Moore said. "If you go up to him you can see he has the big, cresty, strong neck, and his chest is wide and he's a nice strong horse. He's pretty. He has a pretty head and I like him a lot. He looks like a classy horse and he's tough."

And if there is one person Moore trusts to sell Hip 2521, it's Bill Reightler. Described by Moore as a mentor who has "taught her everything" she knows about the horse industry, Reightler began working closely with Moore when she kick-started her operation back in 2012.

"Sabrina had a background in barrel horses and she wanted to get into the industry and it just went from there," Reightler said. "She started helping me at the sales."

"As far as the matings and building my broodmare band, Mr. Bill really helped get all our horses together," Moore said. "He recommended what we should do, who we should breed them to, and all of that."

It was Reightler that consigned one of Moore's first mares, Mystic Love, who was purchased by Moore's mother Angie as a Christmas present in 2013.

"It's really been great," Reightler said.

In addition to Hip 2521, Reightler and Moore will also offer another registered Maryland-bred, Hip 2542, a Constitution filly out of Moore's Carson City mare Littlebitabing. The filly's dam was a stakes-placed runner and has already produced two winners from four foals to race.

As to whether Moore will be buying in addition to selling, much of her decision depends on how Hip 2521 performs in the ring on Sunday.

"We'll see what he brings and then we'll go from there," Moore said. **BH**

WITT PICKS UP SKILLS FOR FUTURE AT GROVENDALE

Julie Witt is a senior at the University of Kentucky, where she is a double major in animal and equine science. She has successfully learned to balance her passion with pursuing her college education, and is working her fourth sale season with James Keogh at Grovendale, where she helped prepare nine mares for this Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Dedicated and passionate about her work, Witt stresses the importance of the learning experiences that sales offer young people.

BloodHorse: What do you do to prepare for the Keeneland November Sale?

Julie Witt: I started out with James prepping mares, so this year I've prepped mares for him in the afternoons. In the fall of 2016 and 2017 I prepped weanlings in the mornings in addition to the mares. This year, since I'm on the breaking team at WinStar, I unfortunately did not prep babies this fall, which was kind of tough for me because the weanlings are my favorite age group so far.

James takes his mare prep probably more seriously than anyone I know. This year we had nine mares to prep at the farm. It's me and a group of college girls. Without them this whole process does not run—they're fantastic. I'm there about four to six nights a week and we prep seven days a week. We started Aug. 1 this year so the mares we sent to the Keeneland sale have a little over 90 days of prep on them.

James is very old-school. He's from Ireland and feeds his mares incredibly well. They get sweet feed and a mash that we prepare the previous night. We start it in a big industrial cooker. When we're grooming the mares, we curry comb them really, really well, until they stop giving up hair. We stiff brush and soft brush them, and even vacuum them if they need it. After that we rub on them with a burlap rag. They also get mane

and tail conditioner and hoof oil.

The week of the sale they get their final touches—they get their manes pulled and shoes put on for the sale. Then we ship them to the sale. One of our biggest compliments is when people point at our horses and say "James Keogh prepped that horse." You can pick them out and they look fantastic.

BH: Is there a horse you're proud to help put through the sale this year?

JW: My favorite mare I prepped for the November sale was Castellani. She was the biggest mare we had in the barn, an easy 17 hands. She's a daughter of Quality Road and just his spitting image. A big and beautiful bay mare who was an absolute gem to be around. She never put a foot wrong throughout prep and when she walked onto the sales ground she knew her job the moment she went out. She was an absolute superstar who ended up bringing \$350,000 from Greenlantern Farm in Book 2. She was also in foal to Gun Runner.

BH: Who is your favorite horse you have shown or taken care of?

JW: It's a tie. My favorite horse I prepped for James was in 2016 for the Keeneland November Sale. Her name was the Theworldweknow. James and I agree she was probably the best prep mare to ever

come out of the farm. She was an absolute doll. I'd let a small child show her. I was at the ring when she sold and she brought \$560,000 from Perry Martin and partners. Last February, we sold a mare at Fasig-Tipton named Sweet Posse and she was the first mare I've co-owned. We claimed her out of Remington Park, I prepped her almost every night leading up to February, and I got to bring her up (to the ring) myself. She brought more than four times the claim price. Being there from picking her out and claiming her to putting in the work and seeing it succeed, it was fantastic.

BH: Are there any "Do's" and "Don'ts" of the sale you've learned?

JW: A "Do" would definitely be to take advantage of everything, especially if you're a young person. The sales are a great place to learn and network. You get

to get your name and your face out there and that can help down the line as a young person. I also have the privilege of working with the best horseman I know that I'm constantly learning from, James' head guy,

Fernando. He's always giving me feedback and critiquing how I show.

Another "Do" would be to know your abilities and know your limits. So if you don't feel comfortable taking up a horse or showing a horse, say so, but at the same time trust your abilities. If you start getting nervous, they will as well. You have to really keep your nerves in check. If you're bringing a baby up to the ring,

it's a very scary experience for them, so it's your job to comfort them with your presence and be a leader for them. Don't interrupt another show, and every time a horse leaves the shedrow, make sure it is turned out properly. Take the job seriously because for a lot of people these horses represent their bottom line. It's how they put food on the table and keep the lights on, so every show is important. **BH**

HOT SPRINGS FINDS PATH TO VICTORY IN COMMONWEALTH TURF

Woodford Racing's Hot Springs took an adventurous trip to victory Nov. 10 in the \$100,000 Commonwealth Turf Stakes (G3T), but in the end picked up his first graded stakes win and preserved his unbeaten record on the Churchill Downs turf.

The 3-year-old son of Uncle Mo entered the race off a victory in the Sept. 29 Jefferson Cup Stakes at Churchill for trainer Steve Asmussen, and was sent off as the 9-5 second choice in a field of seven under jockey Ricardo Santana Jr.

Away alertly from the outside post in the 1 1/16-mile test, Hot Springs at first appeared to struggle with the heavy going of a turf course listed as yielding. The bay colt dropped back to second-last behind a :24.81 opening quarter set by longshot Marzo, then brought up the rear as the half went in :49.64.

Santana kept his cool, sought the shortest path to victory, and moved Hot Springs up the rail through three-quarters in 1:14.72. The duo stayed on the rail into the lane as Asmussen-trained stablemate *Re ride* made his bid, then had to shift abruptly to the outside for running room just off that one's heels. Santana sent Hot Springs through as the mile went in 1:40.38, and the colt responded with a fresh kick, which carried him across the line for a 1 1/2-length score. The final time was 1:46.97.

"The track is pretty heavy. We got a lot of rain," Santana said. "I was looking and watching replays with the weather like this, and a lot of the horses sat off it (and won) earlier in the day.

"Turning for home I just waited for the holes, and when I asked him, he took off."

Late-closing 15-1 shot Zero Gravity got up for place honors, while Marzo held for third. Favored March to the Arch faded to fifth. The winner returned \$5.80, \$3.80, and \$3.20 across the board

Hot Springs broke his maiden June 3 beneath the Twin Spires by 4 1/4 lengths and wheeled back to score a 1 1/2-length allowance win June 29. After he finished

second in the Kent Stakes (G3T) and fourth in the Saranac Stakes (G3T), he returned to Louisville and took the Jefferson Cup by a length.

"He's four-for-four on the grass course here, and I thought today was the most impressive (win)," Asmussen said. "He looked good finishing up. Hopefully we can come back here with him in the spring, and obviously there's some very nice races for him then."

Hot Springs was bred in Kentucky by Bo Hirsch, out of the stakes-placed Victory Gallop mare Magical Victory, and was a \$750,000 purchase by Lane's End from Columbiana Farm's consignment to the 2016 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. He improved his record to four wins and a second from seven starts, with earnings of \$248,480. **BH**

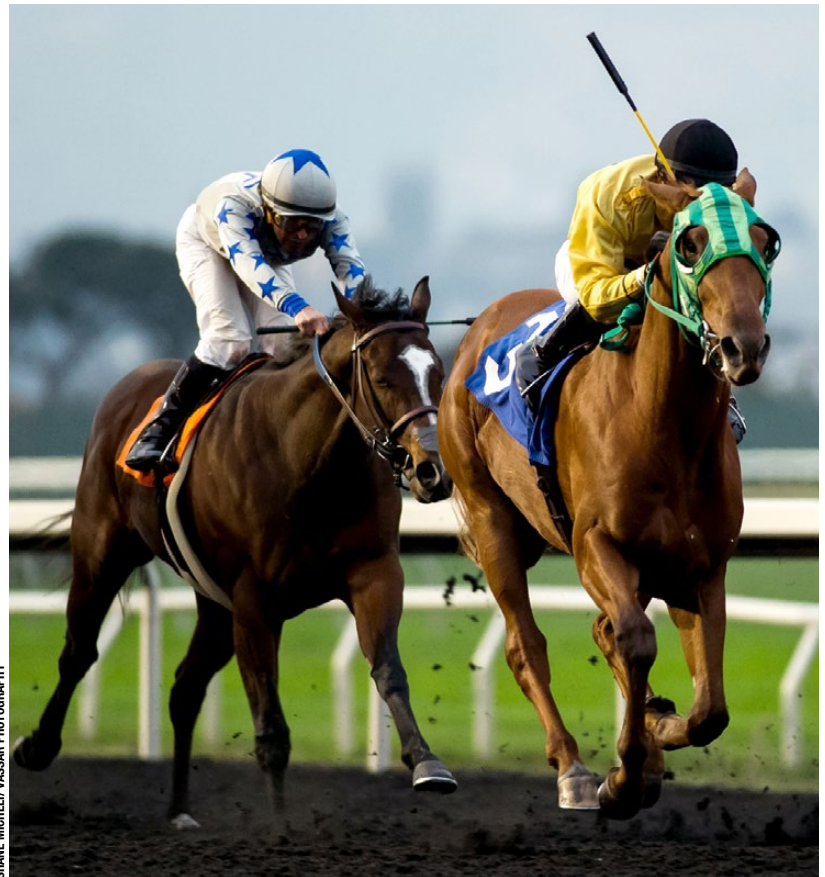

In his seventh start for owner/breeder Stuart Tsujimoto and trainer Ed Moger Jr., Spirited Guy broke out and bumped a rival at the start of the 5 1/2-furlong maiden claimer on Golden Gate's all-weather surface, in which he was entered for a \$25,000 tag. He raced fifth early, as Journey Cake put up fractions of :22.14 and :46.06 through the first half-mile, then ranged up with a four-wide rally and was set down for the drive by jockey Alejandro Gomez.

Journey Cake could not hold off the eventual winner and settled for second by a half-length. Sir Laughalot completed the trifecta, 1 1/4 lengths back in third. The final time was 1:05.23.

Bred in California out of the Concerto mare Glad's Gals, Spirited Guy improved his record to 1-1-2 from seven starts, with earnings of \$15,840.

He Be Fire N Ice, a son of the late Unusual Heat out of the Deputy Commander mare Deputy Tombe,



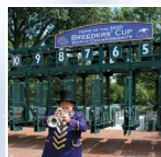

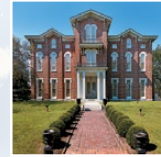

TRAP FOR FOOLS EDGES LATROBE IN MACKINNON STAKES

Joseph O'Brien won last year's Emirates Melbourne Cup (G1) and he very nearly landed this year's group 1 Seppelt Mackinnon Stakes Nov. 10 as his Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby (G1) winner Latrobe only just failed to run down long-time leader Trap For Fools.

Latrobe was dropped out and challenged widest up the Flemington straight under Mark Zahra, but he was never quite getting to the 25-1 outsider, trained by Jarrod McLean and expertly ridden by former Irish jumps jockey John Allen.

Coming to Australia, Latrobe had a very similar profile to last year's Melbourne Cup winner Rekindling, and to many it was a surprise when owners Lloyd and Nick Williams decided to skip the race they love to target more than any other to aim at Saturday's Mackinnon. It very nearly paid off, with a head in it at the line.

"Mark gave the horse a fantastic ride and he's run a gallant race," said O'Brien. "The winner got it a little bit soft up front for us to come from where we did but I couldn't ask for any more from the horse and I'm delighted with the run.

"He's only a 3-year-old and he's carrying a lot of weight, but we have something to dream about going forward."

Latrobe does have the option of the Japan Cup (G1) in a fortnight on Sunday and connections will think about whether to send him to Tokyo.

Winning jockey Allen, who produced a beauty from the front to get the better of Latrobe and Extra Brut—the horse he rode to win last week's Aami Victoria Derby (G1)—said: "I took a chance a few years ago and it's paid off. Thanks to Darren Weir and all of his team, and Jarrod, who does a lot of work with Darren's team. It's great to pay them back.

"A big thank you to Jarrod for giving me this ride. The horse, he's just so tough. I was rolling along at a good tempo and then I picked it up. Latrobe got to me at the furlong pole, I thought he had me for toast. This guy put his head down and fought.

"I was waiting for my old mate Extra Brut to come after me late but I was too strong today."

Allen also partnered the Weir-trained Kenedna to victory in the 7News Matriarch Stakes (G2).

Charlie Appleby's Blair House had every chance in the Mackinnon but faded to finish seventh.

The trainer said: "It was a bit disappointing but he's one of those horses, Will (Buick) rode him cold—which is the way to ride him—and he picked up, but at the end of the day he's just flattened out. Whether he's just had enough for this carnival I don't know, I've not spoken to Will yet."

He added: "It's been a great carnival, the Victoria Racing Club have looked after us fantastically well and we're just pleased to be going home with the Melbourne Cup."

As for Buick, his wait to add Australia to the list of eight countries in which he has ridden a group 1 winner goes on as he dead-headed for third aboard

Jungle Cat in the day's other top-level contest, the VRC Sprint Classic (G1).

The race, won by Santa Ana Lane under Latrobe's jockey Mark Zahra, turned into something of a dash which did not suit Appleby's retiring 6-year-old and he said: "I'm delighted. That was the last run of his career and as per usual he's not let us down.

"He's run a fantastic and courageous race and I couldn't be more thrilled with the horse. He's a winner of the Al Quoz and the Keno Sir Rupert Clarke Invitation at group 1 level, he's multiple group 1-placed and I'm sure he'll have a great retirement. I'm sure we'll see plenty of his progeny in future."

Aidan O'Brien saddled four, with Spirit of Valor once again placing best as U S Navy Flag, Intelligence Cross, and Fleet Review failed to get competitive.


O'Brien's travelling head lad TJ Comerford said of sixth-placed Spirit of Valor: "He travelled like the winner and he's run well. I think they could have gone quicker for him really."

On U S Navy Flag, who finished 13th, he added: "I think they went steady enough early; at Newmarket (when he won the Darley July Cup) they went flat out."

Intelligence Cross and Fleet Review finished 11th and last in the 14-runner group 1, in which Everest winner and favourite Redzel was fifth.

HARBOUR LAW TO JOIN BATSFORD STUD ROSTER

Leadbrokes St Leger (G1) hero Harbour Law has found himself a berth at Batsford Stud in Gloucestershire, where he will be offered to breeders on a dual-purpose basis at a £4,000 fee, in a deal organized by Nicola Naylor on behalf of owner Nick Cornwell.

Harbour Law sprung a 22-1 surprise in the Doncaster feature when winning the race for trainer Laura Mongan, and added his name to a roll of honor that includes successful jumps sires such as Milan, Millenary, Scorpion, and Shantou.

Bred by Hascombe and Valiant Studs, Harbour Law is a 5-year-old son of Lawman out of the talented sprinter and Pivotal mare Abunai, whose dam, Ingozi, also produced the EP Taylor Stakes Presented by Fly Emirates (G1) scorer Miss Keller.

"He will be offered on a dual-purpose basis and is looking particularly like a good National Hunt

prospect," said Naylor. "He's absolutely beautiful, 16.1 hands, very correct and you couldn't fault him.

"He's been a hardy horse, coming from nowhere in the St Leger when he flew past everything. He has a wonderful temperament and you'd hope his progeny will be like that."

Trained out of Mongan's Epsom base, Harbour Law first ran as a 3-year-old, winning three of his six races that season, a run that culminated with success in the last Classic of the British Flat season.

Harbour Law only made two appearances at 4, including when he finished third to Big Orange in the 2017 Gold Cup (G1) on what turned out to be his swansong.

Harbour Law will stand alongside two winners of the Two Thousand Guineas (G1) in Haafhd (2004) and Cockney Rebel (2007), whose return from France was announced by the stud in September.

Haafhd's fee has been trimmed to £2,000, while Cockney Rebel has been priced £2,500, the same fee as when he last stood in Britain at the National Stud.

Completing the roster are Passing Glance at a £3,000 fee and Native Ruler who will stand for £1,500.

Batsford has a fine reputation among jumps breeders, with both Haafhd and Passing Glance having supplied Cheltenham Festival winners. Haafhd sired JCB Triumph Hurdle hero Countrywide Flame and Coral Cup Hurdle Handicap scorer Carlito Brigante, while Passing Glance is the sire of John Smiths Daily Mirror Punters Club Handicap Hurdle victor Attaglance.

MR. JORDAN STILL UNDEFEATED AT GULFSTREAM PARK WEST

Had the \$75,000 Millions Preview Classic been run at a racetrack other than Gulfstream Park West, multiple stakes winner Mr. Jordan may have come up short in a bid to win the 1 1/16-mile stakes that headlined nine stakes for Florida-breds Nov. 10.

But a heads-up ride by Paco Lopez and a preferred racing surface resulted in a gutsy victory by a nose that extended the Eddie Plesa Jr.-trained gelding's perfect record at the Florida racetrack.

Now undefeated in five starts at Gulfstream Park West, the 6-year-old gelding who has earned more than \$800,000 recovered from a slow break to get inside stalking position behind pacesetter Jay's Way around the first turn and along the backstretch, through fractions of :24.31 and :48.20 for the first half-mile. The son of Kantharos lacked room on the turn into the homestretch, as Deland, the even-money favorite ridden by Emisael Jaramillo, got the jump on him and took the lead at the top of the lane. Lopez found room to the outside, and Mr. Jordan dug into his favorite racing surface and caught Deland at the wire.

"He's a little on the slow side breaking, but Paco got him up there, and on the turn he had him in good position. (Jay's Way) dictated the pace, and it looked like Paco was in a little tight around the three-eighths pole," said Plesa, who trains the gray gelding for David Melin, Leon Ellman, and Laurie Plesa. "When he had

no place to go, he swung him to the outside and he ran the horse down. It was a great effort on the second horse's part. It was a greater effort on our part. He loves this racetrack."

Mr. Jordan, the 6-5 second choice, finished the distance in 1:45.21 to record his 10th victory and seventh stakes score. Deland finished 1 1/4 lengths clear of Noble Drama.

Lopez, who captured the TwinSpires Breeders' Cup Sprint (G1) with Roy H at Churchill Downs a week ago, rode Mr. Jordan for the first time since he won an allowance aboard the gelding at Parx Racing in July of 2017. Lopez also rode Mr. Jordan in the 2015 Pegasus Stakes (G3) at Monmouth Park and the 2016 Millions Preview Classic.

"I'm so happy for the horse. He's a difficult horse to ride. He got a perfect trip for him," said Lopez, who won five stakes Saturday.

The rider also won the \$75,000 Millions Turf Preview aboard Galleon Mast, the \$75,000 Millions Sprint Preview on Kroy, the \$75,000 Juvenile Fillies Sprint aboard Lovesick, and the \$75,000 Juvenile Fillies Turf on Vow to Recover. Other stakes winners on the card were Shanghai Starlet in the \$75,000 Millions Distaff, Jackson in the \$75,000 Juvenile Sprint, and Picara in the \$75,000 Millions Filly and Mar Turf Preview

Plesa said the \$200,000 Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park June 19 would likely be targeted for Mr. Jordan's next start. **BH**

BACKTOHISROOTS FINDS HIS WINGS IN ATLANTIC BEACH STAKES

An off-the-turf running of the \$100,000 Atlantic Beach Stakes at Aqueduct Racetrack Nov. 10 proved to be a non-issue for Gatsas Stables' Backtohisroots, who sailed home to his first stakes win by 5 3/4 lengths.

Originally scheduled to be run at six furlongs on the outer turf, the race was moved to the main track because of inclement weather.

After a break from the rail under jockey Luis Saez, Backtohisroots settled along the inside and began to press the pace, as Neverland Rock took the lead through an opening quarter in :21.99.

Chasing in tandem with Absentee, Backtohisroots moved up to flank the leader, as the five-horse field entered the turn and emerged at the top of the stretch.

Backtohisroots was in control by a half-length as they reached the half mile in :46.28, drifted out to the center of the field and kept drifting as Absentee moved to the rail. Despite the wayward path, Backtohisroots kicked clear and pulled away from the pack to cross the wire in a final time of 1:13.15. Absentee finished second, 2 3/4 lengths ahead of Wallace in third. Honorable Hero took fourth and was followed by Neverland Rock to complete the order of finish.

"We tried to get the lead, but we missed the break a little," Saez said. "I wasn't worried, because I rode him once before in Saratoga, and I knew he could come from behind. He was very comfortable and when I had a chance to make a move, he took off. He took a little while to switch leads, and he was drifting out a little, but he was running well, so I just tried to keep him straight to the wire.

A 2-year-old son of Mark Valeski, Backtohisroots broke

his maiden in his second start July 30 at Saratoga Race Course going 5 1/2 furlongs on the dirt. He made his next start on dirt in the Sept. 3 Hopeful Stakes (G1) at Saratoga, where he finished seventh, before he made the switch to turf for the Oct. 7 Futurity Stakes at Belmont Park, where he came in second.

"He's doing so well right now," said the colt's trainer, John Terranova. "He's really excelled since the Futurity and continued to improve every day. Coming into this race, we were so ready. It was just unfortunate about the weather, but nothing we can do. Luckily he's got some dirt form and he trains well over it, so he was able to handle this group nicely.

"He wasn't running over his preferred surface, because he moved up big time on turf last out. And that's going to be in his future, because he's really taken it to the next level now."

Bred in Kentucky by Brereton Jones out of the Harlan's Holiday mare Great Family, Backtohisroots improved his record to 2-2-0 from five starts with \$122,380 in earnings. He is the first black-type winner for his sire, whose first runners are 2-year-olds of 2018.

Two races later on the Aqueduct card, Exulting won an off-the-turf renewal of the \$150,000 Artie Schiller Stakes going one mile on the main track.

Black Tide took control at the break and put 2 1/2 lengths between himself and his the field, as Exulting settled on the outside. The frontrunner ticked off fractions of :23.59 and :47.09 through the first half

mile, and continued to lead along the backstretch, as Exulting and Profiteer ran head-to-head vying for second.

On even terms with Black Tide as they rounded the bend and entered the stretch, Exulting edged past Black Tide to take the lead before being guided to the rail by jockey Rajiv Maragh.

Backsideofthemoon moved from up last to get up for second but was not able to catch Exulting, who completed the race 2 1/2 lengths ahead in 1:37.97.

"Everything went smooth," Maragh said. "We got a great post on the outside, which we wanted, to get into a good rhythm. Down the backstretch I was just trying to be a good passenger and get him into a good flow, which he did. He just traveled well all the way."

Backsideofthemoon finished second and was followed by Black Tide in third and Profiteer in fourth to complete the order of finish. Eight horses who were entered in the Artie Schiller were scratched when the race was moved to the main track. Owned by Godolphin Racing, the Artie Schiller marked the first stakes victory for Exulting, a 5-year-old gelded son of Tapit.

"It's nice to pick up a stakes win with him, and he'll most likely stay for the winter," said winning trainer Kieran McLaughlin. "We'll look at the Queens County

(Dec. 22) as a good option for him from here."

Bred in Kentucky by Peter E. Blum Thoroughbreds, Exulting is the first foal out of the graded stakes-winning Empire Maker mare Magical Feeling. Exulting was purchased as a yearling for \$500,000 by John Ferguson from Dromoland's consignment to the Keeneland September Yearling Sale. The gelding holds of record of 4-1-1 in 12 starts with earnings of \$267,822. **BH**
