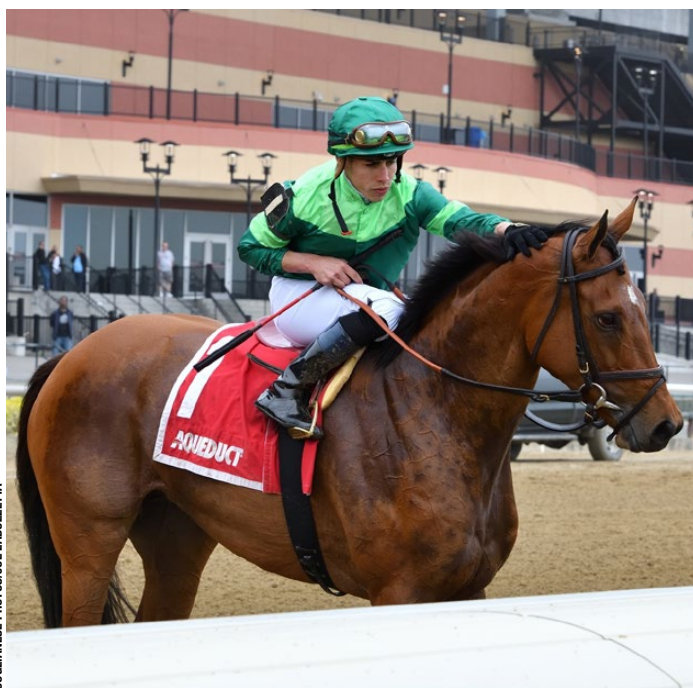

# MIDNIGHT BISOU DUELS TO THE WIRE TO WIN APPLE BLOSSOM

Midnight Bisou is the kind of runner that forces her competition to elevate their game.

A multimillionaire who has hit the board in all 14 of her starts, the 4-year-old daughter of Midnight Lute has proven to be a formidable filly who gives it her all every time she leaves the gate.

April 14 was no exception.

In a knock-down, drag-out fight to the wire, Midnight Bisou defeated Escape Clause in a photo finish to take the \$750,000 Apple Blossom Handicap (G1) at Oaklawn Park.

"She's one of the great ones," said Hall of Fame jockey Mike Smith. "It's an honor to come back here and be

blessed to do as well as we've done."

In a short field of only six older fillies and mares, Midnight Bisou drew the outside post in the 1 1/16-mile test. The last to load in the gate Sunday, the 4-5 favorite patiently awaited her turn behind the gate as attendants scrambled

to cajole longshot Viva Forever to load, delaying the start.

Escape Clause was away first, followed by Canadian champion filly Wonder Gadot, who shot to the front up the outside under jockey David Cohen and pulled away to lead by three lengths.

Setting the pace on the rail, Wonder Gadot led through fractions of :23.07 and :47.08 for the half-mile. Escape Clause tracked the pace and slowly gained ground under Tyler Baze, who pushed the filly to maintain a two-length advantage over Viva Forever in third.

Advancing to the far turn, Escape Clause came on even terms with Wonder Gadot before passing the filly at the quarter pole to take command. Midnight Bisou, who was patiently handled by Smith, shifted out four wide to challenge the leaders and gave chase.

Escape Clause refused to yield and drove hard from her spot on the rail in midstretch. The two dueling fillies pulled away from the rest of the field and battled to the wire. When the photo finish was reviewed, victory fell the way of Midnight Bisou by a nose.

"Man, that was great," Smith said. "Escape Clause ran huge, but, you know, the great ones seem to pull it off no matter what. I'm really happy with the way she ran today, but she had to run. Sometimes you have to do that. I sat back with Elate and waited to make my move. She ran huge, she had to fight for it, but she ran big. Escape Clause ran really well."

It was another 2 3/4 lengths back to third-place Elate, who finished nine lengths ahead of Viva Forever in fourth. Chocolate Martini, who made brief contact with Elate at the start, never fired and took fifth, followed by Wonder Gadot. The final time was 1:43.88.

"She's really and truly probably one of the best horses I've ever been on in my life," said Baze of Escape Clause. A competitor of serious caliber, the 5-year-old Going Commando mare has continued to impress for owner/trainer Don Schnell, becoming the first Manitoba-bred horse to win a graded stakes at Santa Anita Park when she took the Jan. 12 La Canada Stakes (G3).

"She gives it her all," Baze continued. "She got beat a nose, and I got slammed pretty hard going into the first turn. I knew I got beat at the wire. It was a head-and-head battle all the way down the lane. She gave me everything. We were a little unfortunate we didn't get the bob."

The win was especially poignant for Smith, who earned his seventh Apple Blossom score. His previous wins came aboard Zenyatta (2008 and 2010), Azeri (2002-04), and Nine Keys (1994).

"I had a great meet here for only being here a few days," Smith said.

Campaigned through her first six starts by Allen Racing, Bloom Racing Stable, and trainer Bill Spawr, Midnight Bisou broke her maiden on third asking in the Santa Ynez Stakes (G2) at Santa Anita at 3. She followed that performance with back-to-back wins in the Santa Ysabel Stakes (G3) and Santa Anita Oaks (G1) at the Southern California track.

She placed third in the Longines Kentucky Oaks (G1) at Churchill Downs behind Wonder Gadot and eventual 3-year-old champion filly Monomoy Girl. Transferred to the barn of Steve Asmussen, she bounced back one start later in the Mother Goose Stakes (G2) at Belmont Park.

Her next graded score came three months later when she was declared the winner following the

disqualification of Monomoy Girl in the Cotillion Stakes (G1) at Parx Racing. She closed her impressive sophomore year with a third—again to Monomoy Girl—in the Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff (G1) at Churchill.

Midnight Bisou kicked off 2019 with wins in the Jan. 27 Houston Ladies Classic (G3) at Sam Houston and March 16 Azeri Stakes (G2) at Oaklawn. Her Apple Blossom win improved her record to 8-3-3, with more than \$2.4 million in earnings.

"What an unbelievable filly," Asmussen said. "We were talking about what a special filly she is, how much confidence she has this year. She really seems to be enjoying her job. We're just blessed to have her."

Owned by Bloom Racing Stable, Madaket Stables, and Allen Racing, Midnight Bisou was purchased by Jeffrey Bloom, agent, for \$80,000 from the consignment of Woodford Thoroughbreds to the 2017 Ocala Breeders' Sales Spring Sale of 2-Year-Olds in Training. Bred in Kentucky by Woodford Thoroughbreds out of the Repent mare Diva Delite, the filly is a half sister to stakes-placed Stage Left.

Diva Delite has a Warrior's Reward 2-year-old colt and Wicked Strong yearling filly. She was bred to Pioneerof the Nile for 2019. **BH**

### DEMAND STEADY IN EARLY APRIL SALES

The Keeneland April Sale returned April 8 as a combined 2-year-olds in training plus horses of racing age sale, and it grossed \$6,083,500 at an average of \$90,799 for 67 head sold, which was 39.6% of the 169 cataloged.

Two-thirds of those sold (45) were horses of racing age, which averaged \$59,911 with a \$500,000 sale topper in 3-year-old filly Sweet Diane. Just 22 juveniles sold at an average of \$153,977, including a \$1.3 million full sister to Bourbon War, by Tapit, out of grade 1 winner My Conquestadory. Even without the filly, the other 21 juveniles averaged \$99,404, so Keeneland

seemed satisfied that a \$6 million day was worth the effort, and it certainly showed again that horses of racing age fit in well with auctions of 2-year-olds, especially when there aren't many 2-year-olds.

There are 1,221 cataloged to the upcoming four-day Ocala Breeders' Sales Spring Sale of 2-Year-Olds in Training, scheduled for April 23-26, more than have been cataloged in all the North American 2-year-old sales up until now. Thus far, there have been 852 2-year-olds cataloged, of which 469 have sold (55.0%) for an average of \$168,385. This is 15% more cataloged than the corresponding time last year (739), 21% more sold (388 last year), a 17% higher gross (\$67.37 million), but a 3% lower average (\$173,364 last year).

In fact, this year's figures are more in line with 2017, when at this point 839 2-year-olds had been cataloged, of which 444 had sold (52.9%) for \$83,615,900, and a 12% higher average (in 2017) of \$188,324. At OBS April last year, 698 2-year-olds sold of 1,222 cataloged (57.1%), grossing \$68,735,500, an average of \$98,474.

However, the most important bloodstock sale in the world last week was the Inglis Australian Easter Yearling Sale, which took place April 9-10 at the new Riverside Sale Complex at Warwick Farm in the Sydney suburbs. The sale was a touch stronger than last year's edition: from 450—the same number cataloged—346 were listed as sold (a splendid 76.9% of the catalog), which was 3% more than the 337 sold in Book 1 last year (there was a small Book 2 last year, which has been dispensed with).

The sale gross was AU\$122,795,500, a 5% gain over 2018's Book 1 total of AU\$116,847,500, and the average this year was AU\$354,900, up 2% over last year's Book 1 average of AU\$346,728. Two years ago, there were 10% fewer cataloged (404) and sold (308) in Book 1, which grossed AU\$109.32 million and averaged AU\$354,935.

The Easter Sale has held steady and grown slightly, which is good news as even though the two most important sales—Magic Millions in January and Sydney Easter—have been up in single digits, most of the other sales have been down at least some and a few by nearly 20%. Though there are a few minor yearling sales still to come, the vast majority of the Australasian yearling market has now come under hammer.

To this point, from the count of Brianne Stanley from The Bill Oppenheim Group, with help from Andrew Reichard and his team at Bluebloods, a total of 5,329 yearlings have been cataloged at Australasian yearling sales, an increase of 2% from the 5,203

cataloged in the same sales last year.

A total of 3,906 yearlings have been sold, which is 73.3% of those cataloged but a drop of 3% from corresponding 2018 sales, when 4,045 yearlings (77.7% of those cataloged) sold; in other words, 126 more yearlings were cataloged, but 139 fewer yearlings sold. The combined gross is down 4%, or about AU\$19.3 million, from AU\$521,517,750 in 2018 to AU\$502,195,500 this year. The overall average is almost dead level: AU\$128,545 this year, a three-tenths of 1% decline from the AU\$128,929 average to this point in 2018.

A total of 18 sires have averaged over AU\$150,000, of which four averaged over AU\$400,000. Redoute's Choice, who died in March, topped the table with 33 yearlings averaging AU\$487,504, while Snitzel (67/AU\$404,307), I Am Invincible (107/AU\$403,318), and Fastnet Rock (51/AU\$400,159) finished in a virtual three-way tie for second. Those three top living sires—representing Arrowfield, Yarraman Park, and Coolmore, respectively—have had a combined 225 yearlings sell in 2019 for an aggregate of US\$64,762,700 and an average of US\$287,834. That's a very strong showing by any international standard.

Arrowfield's Not A Single Doubt, like Snitzel a son of Redoute's Choice, ranks fifth by 2019 yearling average (57/\$311,742), followed by Darley's Exceed And Excel (38/AU\$299,079) and New Zealand's top sire, Savabeel(54/AU\$293,202).

Darley's Medaglia d'Oro (no longer shuttles) had 28 yearlings average AU\$288,867 to rank eighth by average, with Widden's Zoustar, the top second-crop sire, averaging AU\$276,084 from 81 yearlings sold. Darley's venerable Lonhro (12/AU\$260,000) rounds out the top 10.

The top freshman sire on average, Brazen Beau (46/AU\$241,989), is another Darley sire, followed by Widden's Sebring (78/AU\$234,481); Victoria's Woodside Park's Written Tycoon (108, AU\$226,866); and Coolmore's Pierro (50/AU\$207,746), the leading third-crop sire. Yarraman Park's Hinchinbrook (54/AU\$196,215); Coolmore's leading first-crop sire Vancouver (71/AU\$187,117); Darley's former shuttler Teofilo (15/AU\$176,490); and Vinery's More Than Ready (55/AU\$159,853), who has just stood his last Australian season, complete the list of Australasian sires to have averaged over AU\$150,000 so far this sales season. Darley stands or stood five of the 18 sires, though Medaglia d'Oro and Teofilo no longer shuttle south. **BH**

# STONE FARM'S HANCOCK BACK IN THE DERBY WITH ROADSTER

Stone Farm owner Arthur Hancock III scanned the list of potential mates for his mare Ghost Dancing prior to the 2015 breeding season and stopped at Quality Road.

The mare, a grand-looking gray daughter of Silver Ghost, was a product of Edward P. "Ned" Evans' prominent breeding program in Virginia. Hancock acquired Ghost Dancing for \$220,000 out of a dispersal of Evans' stock at the 2011 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Evans, the son of prominent owner/breeder Thomas Mellon Evans, died Dec. 31, 2010, from acute myeloid leukemia.

"Ned was very smart, and he really loved breeding, an exceptionally brilliant guy," Hancock said. "I had a lot of faith in what he'd put together, and I wanted to buy something from him because he was a good friend."

Quality Road also was bred and raced by Evans. The son of Elusive Quality won four grade 1 stakes, set two track records, and earned \$2,232,830 for Evans, who thought so highly of the horse he refused to syndicate him and retained full ownership when he retired Quality Road to stud.

"I remember going over the breeding list and thinking, 'Well, Ned bred Quality Road, so this is Ned's breeding through and through,'" Hancock recalled. "I thought I would honor Ned by breeding her to his stallion. I believe Ned would have done the same thing."

Aside from the personal connection, Hancock said the mating had plenty to recommend it. Primarily, the cross of Quality Road with Ghost Dancing's family had already produced Hootenanny, winner of the 2014 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (G1T) and the Windsor Castle Stakes at Royal Ascot earlier that year. Ghost Dancing's second dam and Hootenanny's third dam is top-level winner Dance Teacher, by Smarten. Dance Teacher, an Evans homebred, won the Ladies Handicap (G1) at Aqueduct Racetrack and the Gallorette

Handicap (G3T) at Pimlico Race Course, both in 1989.

Hancock also liked the mating to Quality Road because it provided 4x3 inbreeding to Mr. Prospector and brought together four lines of Native Dancer, an ancestor who figured prominently in Hancock's decision to buy Ghost Dancing.

"I can still remember seeing her out there at the sale. It was one morning and the sun was out, and I was looking at another mare when I saw (Ghost Dancing) standing out there, too. I just thought she was a beautiful mare," Hancock said. "I liked that she was by Silver Ghost, who goes back to Native Dancer through Mr. Prospector, and then his dam, Misty Gallore, goes back through Flight Dancer to Native Dancer. She is gray, so I thought she had the Native Dancer genes. That is probably a fool's conclusion."

Hancock admittedly has an affinity for grays. The first of two Kentucky Derby (G1) winners he's bred, Gato Del Sol in 1982, was gray, as was his dam, Peacefully, a stakes winner raced by Hancock with Leone Peters.

"I have had some good luck with grays. I think there is something to grays, but you get a lot of a crazy theories," he said.

The mating of Quality Road and Ghost Dancing resulted in a handsome gray colt named Roadster, whom Hancock sold for \$525,000 at the 2017 Keeneland September Yearling Sale to Peter Fluor and K.C. Weiner's Speedway Stable. The price reflected not just Roadster's quality as an individual but also the deep quality of the family.

In the summer of that year, Roadster's half brother Ascend won the Woodford Reserve Manhattan Stakes (G1T) at Belmont Park for Stone Farm in partnership with Sol Kumin's Madaket Stables. The gray Candy Ride gelding was the foal Ghost Dancing was carrying when Hancock bought the mare at Keeneland. Ghost

Dancing is expecting a foal by Candy Ride this month and will be bred back to Quality Road.

With trainer Bob Baffert, Roadster broke his maiden by 4 1/4 lengths at first asking at Del Mar in late July of his 2-year-old year. In his second start, he finished third in the Del Mar Futurity (G1), two lengths behind the winner and future champion Game Winner.

Roadster debuted this year in a March 1 optional-claiming allowance race at Santa Anita Park that he won by 2 1/2 lengths. On April 6, the colt stamped his ticket to Louisville with a deep stretch drive in the Santa Anita Derby (G1) that delivered a half-length win over Game Winner.

"I thought he was out of it on the far turn. I figured he was done, that something was bothering him," Hancock said, referring to Roadster falling back toward the back of the field as they headed into the final turn. "And then he took off. I mean, he is an inexperienced horse and he's running against Game Winner, the champion 2-year-old. That was a big race, to do something like that."

A veteran of the springtime trek to Churchill Downs' most important race, Hancock knows well the ridges and valleys of the terrain.

He had his first Kentucky Derby starter in 1981 with Tap Shoes, a homebred son of Riva Ridge that Hancock campaigned and co-bred with Leone Peters. The colt was fourth choice in the betting, having won the Futurity Stakes (G1), Hopeful Stakes (G1), and the Sanford Stakes (G2) at 2, and came into the Derby off a win in the Flamingo Stakes (G1) at Hialeah Park. Trainer Horatio Luro used a rubber band to tie the colt's tongue at the Derby and the band broke, forcing him to tie it back with a piece cloth. The horse got mad, slung his head around in aggravation, and ran poorly. Tap Shoes finished 14th out of 21 starters.

"I was despondent, distraught, and depressed after that," Hancock recalled. "The next year, though, Gato Del Sol won it for us."

He won the Derby again as co-owner in 1989 with Sunday Silence, who was raised at Stone Farm, and as breeder in 2000 with Fusaichi Pegasus. Other Derby starters include Skywalker (6th in 1985, the colt was raised at Stone Farm for owner/breeder Tom Tatham and later stood at Stone Farm); Risen Star (3rd in 1988 as co-breeder); Corker (11th in 1996 as breeder and co-owner); Strodes Creek (2nd in 1994 as breeder and co-owner); and Meniffee (2nd in 1999 as breeder and co-owner).

So here is Hancock on the Derby trail again, the owner and breeder of a live contender. After he sold Roadster, Fluor and Weiner offered him the chance to stay in, which he did at 10%.

"I've never felt better about any chances," Hancock said about Roadster's Derby potential May 4. "It is a long way from here to May, but if everything goes right, if he has a good trip, I just think he is one heck of a good horse. He is bred to go a mile and a quarter or a mile and a half. Ascend did it. Quality Road did it.

"Now we just hold our breath and hope," he added. "I honestly could not feel better." **BH**

# OMAHA BEACH EXITS ARKANSAS DERBY IN GOOD ORDER

Among the Oaklawn Park-raced horses with enough points to run in the Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1) are Omaha Beach and Improbable, the top two finishers in the April 13 Arkansas Derby (G1).

Omaha Beach exited his one-length victory in good order, Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella said Sunday morning, adding that the War Front colt, owned by Rick Porter's Fox Hill Farm, will probably be vanned April 16 to Churchill Downs to begin preparations for the May 4 Run for the Roses.

"We've had him out and checked him over," Mandella said. "He looks great."

The Arkansas Derby was the third consecutive victory for the rapidly improving Omaha Beach, who has found a home on dirt after losing his first three starts on turf. Omaha Beach broke his maiden by nine lengths Feb. 2 at Santa Anita Park, then won the second division of the March 16 Rebel Stakes (G2) by a nose over Game Winner, Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert's previously unbeaten 2-year-old champion.

"I've said all along, some day somebody will ask me, 'How did you get this horse beat so many times?'" Mandella said with a laugh. "I started saying that way back because we always thought it was there."

Omaha Beach ranks second with 137.5 points on the Road to the Kentucky Derby leaderboard.

A Tex Sutton flight is scheduled Monday from Little Rock, Ark., to Lexington, Ky., but Mandella said he prefers to van Omaha Beach to Kentucky. Omaha Beach was flown from his Southern California base to Arkansas April 9.

"I don't want to go tomorrow morning," Mandella said. "I just got him here. Let him have an extra day. I'm thinking of just putting him on a van and go straight through. You have to van to Little Rock now. It's not right out of this airport, and the plane's going to Lexington. So by the time you add the hours of shipping there, shipping there and all that, a few more hours you can just van straight there and not get on a plane. I'm thinking that might be a better way."

Mandella is seeking his first Kentucky Derby victory.

His best finish among six starters to date, Soul of the Matter, was fifth in 1994. Conversely, Baffert, Mandella's Santa Anita neighbor, has won the Kentucky Derby five times, the last two with eventual Triple Crown winners American Pharoah (2015) and Justify (2018). Baffert, Mandella kidded, had been giving lessons on how to win the Kentucky Derby—until roughly 10 weeks ago.

"Baffert, he quit helping me when I got a real shot," Mandella said.

Baffert said immediately following the Arkansas Derby that Improbable would point to the Kentucky Derby. After finishing second in the first division of the Rebel—the City Zip colt's first loss—Improbable was antsy in the Arkansas Derby post parade and starting gate, having to be backed out after initially loading into post 1. He still finished a strong second, with 5 3/4 lengths back to third-place finisher Country House.

Improbable ranks 11th on the Kentucky Derby leaderboard with 65 points.

"I thought he had to run first or second to have a chance, so it puts him right there in the mix," Baffert said. "It's a wide-open Derby this year. I just feel thankful. It could have been disastrous. Really had some anxious moments there. I think he ran a great race, and he's going to improve off this. I've been bringing him along, getting him ready by running him, and so he'll move forward off of it."

Improbable raced in blinkers for the first time Saturday after losing a little focus in the Rebel, Baffert said. The equipment change, Baffert said, didn't help.

"I don't think he needs the blinkers," Baffert said. "I

think they got him a little upset. That's probably why he acted up in the gate."

Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott said Sunday morning that he was pleased with Country House's performance after the late-running Lookin At Lucky colt was wheeled back three weeks following a fourth-place finish in the March 23 Twinspires.com Louisiana Derby (G2) at Fair Grounds Race Course & Slots.

"He was where we thought he'd be early," Mott said. "He came with a good run. On the middle of the turn, he was creeping up. I was starting to get a little excited. He made a little run. After he got past the field, apart from the two leaders that were quite a ways in front, I thought he might have started waiting a little bit, and then (Laughing Fox) came up on his inside and kind of pushed him along a little bit."

Mott said Country House came out of the race well, but no decision has been made regarding the Kentucky Derby. The colt, who races for Mrs. J.V. Shields Jr., E.J.M. McFadden Jr., and LNJ Foxwoods (Jamie Roth), has 50 points and ranks 17th.

"I haven't talked to the owners this morning," Mott said. "As far as I know, they were pleased. Initially, it sounded like they were last night. We didn't talk Derby. I think that was one of the goals, to get enough points to go to the Derby. Now we've got to assess the situation and see if it makes sense to enter up." **BH**

## BROODMARE SIRE REVIEW OF TOP KENTUCKY DERBY CONTENDERS

**A**mong the top 12 points leaders heading into this year's Kentucky Derby Presented by Woodford Reserve (G1), their first test at 10 furlongs should cause few concerns for more than half of them as judged by their broodmare sires.

A myriad of obstacles lie ahead for the Derby starters, but the one who will prevail must possess a crucial blend of stamina and speed. Looking at broodmare sires provides one piece toward solving this complex genetic puzzle.

Two of the top contenders by points have the same broodmare sire: Lane's End pensioner A.P. Indy. The 30-year-old son of Seattle Slew has been a steady classic influence as a broodmare sire since 2006, when Bluegrass Cat (by Storm Cat) was second in the Kentucky Derby and second in the Belmont Stakes (G1). Since Bluegrass Cat, A.P. Indy has been represented as a broodmare sire by 2010 Kentucky Derby winner Super Saver (by Maria's Mon) and 2017 Preakness Stakes (G1) winner Cloud Computing (by Maclean's Music). Other classic-placed performers include Dunkirk (2nd in the 2009 Belmont), Revolutionary (3rd in the 2013 Kentucky Derby), and Patch (3rd in the 2017 Belmont).

A.P. Indy is represented this year by Game Winner (by Candy Ride) and Improbable (by

City Zip). Game Winner was honored as last year's champion 2-year-old colt and this year was second in one division of the Rebel Stakes (G2) and second in the Santa Anita Derby (G1). Improbable won the Los Alamitos CashCall Futurity (G1) at 2 and this year was second in the other division of the Rebel Stakes and second in the April 13 Arkansas Derby (G1) to Omaha Beach.

Progeny statistics for A.P. Indy as a broodmare sire further reinforce his positive influence in the classics compared with the other 10 broodmare sires represented by the top points leaders. A.P. Indy has the second-highest average maximum winning distance of 7.95 furlongs behind Sadler's Wells at 10.35. Sadler's Wells is the broodmare sire of War of Will (by War Front), who enters the Derby off a win in the Risen Star Stakes Presented by Lamarque Ford (G2) and an unplaced finish in the Twinspires.com Louisiana Derby (G2).

A.P. Indy also is one of six broodmare sires presented by 5% or more black-type winners to date. The others are Anasheed (13%), the broodmare sire of Maximum Security; Awesome Again (5%, Plus Que Parfait); Sadler's Wells (5%); Seeking the Gold (5%, Omaha Beach); and Silver Ghost (5%, Roadster).

The youngest broodmare sires represented in the top 12 are Anasheed and First Defence, so their progeny statistics aren't derived from nearly the depth of runners as the other broodmare sires.

Anasheed, a 19-year-old son of A.P. Indy, was second in the 2002 Arlington-Washington Futurity (G3) at Arlington International Racecourse, which still had a dirt track at the time. Bred by Darley and raced by Godolphin, he last stood at Dutchess Views Farm in New York for Questroyal and then was exported to Russia.

Represented by 24 foals of racing age as a broodmare sire, Anasheed has 15 starters and 10 winners to date, including three black-type winners.

His runners have indicated some affinity for distance, with an average maximum winning distance of 7.65 furlongs.

Juddmonte Farms homebred First Defence has 61 foals of racing age as a broodmare sire, of which 21 have started and seven are winners. He has two black-type winners so far. His average maximum winning distance of 7.14 furlongs is the seventh-highest among the 11 sires profiled here. First Defence, now standing in Saudi Arabia, is represented by Kentucky Derby contender Tacitus, who is out of champion and multiple grade 1 winner Close Hatches, who won two graded stakes at 1 1/8 miles but won most of her graded stakes at 8.5 furlongs. By Tapit, who has already sired three Belmont Stakes winners, Tacitus heads into the Derby off a win in the Wood Memorial Stakes Presented by NYRA Bets (G2).

Now we wait to see which of Tacitus' pedigree influences predominates in the last furlong of the Derby May 4. **BH**

# CAMPAIGN EARNS FIRST STAKES VICTORY IN TOKYO CITY CUP

John Sadler is starting to show a knack for turning East Coast horses into West Coast graded stakes winners. His latest example came with Woodford Racing's Campaign, who overcame a slow pace to rally to his first stakes win in the \$100,000 Tokyo City Cup (G3) April 14 at Santa Anita Park.

Sadler also won the Dec. 26 San Antonio Stakes (G2) and the April 6 Santa Anita Handicap Presented by San Manuel Indian Bingo and Casino (G1) with formerly New York-based Gift Box, whom Hronis Racing purchased from William Farish.

Campaign began his career with Chad Brown and made one start at 2. He was away 10 months before reappearing with Steve Asmussen and broke his maiden third time out once switched to the turf at Kentucky Downs. The Curlin colt won an allowance there before finishing 10th in the Sycamore Stakes (G3T) at Keeneland.

Campaign's West Coast and 4-year-old debut came Feb. 3 in allowance optional-claiming race, and he rallied to win by a neck going 1 1/16 miles. He then stretched out to 1 1/4 miles in the Santa Anita Handicap to finish fourth.

"The race set up perfectly, and coming back on short rest, you have to be really careful with that," Sadler said. "I don't do it very often, but I thought this was a case where I could do it. Turning for home, I felt pretty good because he'll run all day. He's a true stayer."

Against lighter competition in the Tokyo City Cup, Campaign broke from the rail under jockey Rafael Bejarano and dropped back to last in the five-horse field. Stablemate Acker led through fractions of :26.01, :51.57, 1:18.18, and 1:43.66. Campaign was 7 1/2 lengths behind him through the first half-mile of the marathon race.

Bejarano guided Campaign four wide into the stretch, and the pair drew off by 3 1/4 lengths, wrapping up the 1 1/2-mile feature in 2:34.73. Beach

View was up for second ahead of Acker and Arch Prince. Full of Luck was pulled up in the stretch.

"I had a lot of confidence in this horse today because I've ridden him in his last two races," Bejarano said. "In the Big 'Cap, he didn't have any pace to run at. Today, he was very relaxed and he was full of run going into the far turn. I didn't want to try and go inside because I know this horse likes to make a run on the outside."

"At the top of the stretch, I was about two or three lengths behind Beach View, and I was very confident. John's done a great job with this horse, and I want to thank him for the opportunity."

Expectations have been high for Campaign, who was bred in Kentucky by Alexander-Groves Thoroughbreds. Lane's End went to \$675,000 for him at the 2016 Keeneland September Yearling Sale, where he was consigned by Gainesway. Sunday's race improved his record to 4-1-0 in eight starts and bumped his earnings to \$310,753.

Campaign is the second foal out of the unraced Dynaformer mare Arania, who has two winners from three starters. His unnamed 2-year-old half brother by Speightstown sold at Keeneland September for \$360,000, and Arania foaled a Speightstown filly in 2018. Campaign's second dam, Aurora, produced Juddmonte Spinster Stakes (G1) winner Acoma and Super Derby (G1) winner Arch, a Claiborne Farm stallion who sired three champions and an English heavyweight. **BH**

## AMERICAN PHAROAH'S FIRST U.S. STARTERS TO RACE APRIL 17

The April 17 opening race at Aqueduct Racetrack will feature the debuts of 2015 Triple Crown winner American Pharoah's first two North American starters: Lady Delaware and Tesorina.

American Pharoah, standing at Coolmore's Ashford Stud for a private fee, saw his first starter win on debut when the Aidan O'Brien-trained Monarch of Egypt won at Naas Racecourse in Ireland April 13.

Both runners in Wednesday's \$100,000 opener—the first 2-year-old maiden race at the Big A this year—are fillies conditioned by Wesley Ward, who is well regarded for developing young horses. The former rider said he has high hopes for the Triple Crown champion's two daughters.

"I'm excited," Ward said. "Coolmore has always been good to me. American Pharoah was a tremendous racehorse and, hopefully, a tremendous sire as well. They both are very precocious in their breezes, and there was no reason to not move early with them. They both are very smart and show a lot of talent. To get to Royal Ascot with them would be fantastic—not just for me, but the team as well. American Pharoah was a great 2-year-old himself, and they both look like they'll run early."

Purchased for \$100,000 from the 2018 Keeneland September Yearling Sale, Hat Creek Racing's Lady Delaware is out of the Hennessy broodmare More Hennessy and is a half sister to grade 1 winner Hootenanny.

Hootenanny, a debut winner on the Keeneland synthetic, captured three of his five juvenile starts in 2014, including the Windsor Castle Stakes at Ascot and the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (G1T).

"She seems a little quicker than Hootenanny," Ward said. "He didn't show too much affinity for the dirt. He ran once on the main track, and it was in the slop on Preakness Day at Pimlico. In his Keeneland debut, it was on the synthetic back when they had it. She has really shown that she likes the dirt, and she's

quick coming out of the gate."

Lady Delaware will be piloted by Eric Cancel from post 7.

Tesorina, who will be guided by Joe Bravo, will break just to the outside of Lady Delaware. Owned by Ice Wine Stable, she is out of Nonsuch Bay, winner of the 2002 Mother Goose Stakes (G1).

"She is quick as well," said Ward of Tesorina. "I trained a Scat Daddy that also is out of Nonsuch Bay (Brittas Bay). Body-wise, she appears to be more a sprint-type of filly. It really is hard to separate the two as far as which one is better." **BH**

## SATURNALIA TAKES SATSUKI SHO AT NAKAYAMA RACECOURSE

**S**aturnalia won a three-way sprint to the finish in the first leg of the Japanese Triple Crown, the grade 1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese Two Thousand Guineas) April 14 at Nakayama Racecourse, remaining undefeated in four starts.

The Lord Kanaloa colt, out of the grade 1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) and American Oaks Invitational Stakes (G1T) winner Cesario, was the overwhelming favorite in his first start of 2019 after closing his 2-year-old season with a win in the Hopeful Stakes (G1).

With Christophe Lemaire in the irons, Saturnalia was away alertly from post 12, raced well off the pace, and swung wide turning for home. With a couple of taps from Lemaire, he put a head in front of Velox at the wire, with Danon Kingly a nose farther behind. Admire Mars, the 2018 Japanese juvenile champion, was two lengths back in fourth.

Saturnalia finished the 2,000 meters (about 1 1/4 miles) in 1:58.1 over firm turf.

"I rode him for the first time in the race, but I had confidence in him," Lemaire said. "He seemed a bit nervous and drifted towards the inside when we took command before the crowd."

The victory will make Saturnalia an equally heavy favorite for the second leg of the Triple Crown, the grade 1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby), run May 26 at 2,400 meters (about 1 1/2 miles) at Tokyo Racecourse. The final leg of the series is the grade 1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St Leger) at 3,000 meters.

The Satsuki Sho has been a springboard for such future stars as Deep Impact, Victoire Pisa, Gold Ship, and Orfevre.

Lemaire said going into the Satsuki Sho, Saturnalia "was not 100% as it was his first start this year. But he should be in top condition going into the Japanese Derby."

Saturnalia won at first asking June 10 at Hanshin, followed with a victory in the Hagi Stakes at Kyoto, and went on to win the Dec. 28 Hopeful Stakes before being put away for the season.

Bred by Northern Farm, he is trained by Katsuhiko Sumii for U Carrot Farm.

The colt's sire is quickly making a name for himself in Japan. His progeny include the likes of Almond Eye, winner of last year's Triple Tiara, the Japan Cup (G1), and this year's Dubai Turf Sponsored by DP World (G1T).

Saturnalia's namesake is the ancient Roman festival of the god Saturn, celebrated in December with general merrymaking. **BH**

### JOHN EGAN LOOKS TO SCALE SALES PYRAMID AT TATTERSALLS

With more than 1,000 winners on his CV, jockey John Egan is well accustomed to dealing with pressure. But at next week's Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale, the elder statesman of the weighing room will face a different sort of challenge altogether.

Egan, 50, is behind Alliance Bloodstock, which will consign a blue-chip draft of juveniles to Tattersalls' flagship 2-year-old auction, including colts by American Pharoah and War Front, as well as a daughter of Speightstown.

With the turf season about to hit top gear, most jockeys are out riding work each morning, hoping to build connections that will sustain a fruitful campaign for the year ahead. Egan, however, has dedicated much of the last six months to fine-tuning his breeze-up squad from his base up Newmarket's Hamilton Road.

"It's a bad time of year for me because I shut down everything and just concentrate on these horses," he said. "If somebody wants me, I'll go and race, but at the moment I'd rather be here in the yard with the horses."

Egan is aboard the American Pharoah as the colt floats up the Hamilton Hill polytrack, his mount's raking, effortless stride belying the brute force of his considerable chestnut frame. The pair are tailed by the War Front colt, the very image of his pedigree being by the son of Danzig and out of a daughter of Sadler's Wells.

"He's an amazing horse. I ride him out every day and he's got it all,"

said enthusiastically after dismounting from the American Pharoah, whose stock can only have risen after his first runner, Monarch of Egypt, recorded a striking debut success at Naas April 13.

"I've spoken to a good few people who have American Pharoahs, and they've all said they have great minds. They're both really nice horses who've done everything right to this point," he added, gesturing toward the rangy War Front colt. "I think the two of them are going to be serious racehorses. Fingers crossed, they'll go on and prove that Alliance is doing a good job."

All three of the Alliance-consigned lots are by sires who stand among the upper echelons of the Kentucky stallion ranks, though Egan thinks it would be wrong to say his draft boasts strictly U.S. pedigrees.

The American Pharoah colt, a stunning example of his sire's progeny, is a half brother to group 3 winner and Queen Mary Stakes (G2) runner-up Shumoos pinhooked for \$375,000. The War Front colt, a \$420,000 Keeneland purchase, is out of Moyglare Stud Stakes winner Quarter Moon, making him a sibling to four black-type performers, notably Sea the Stars Pretty Polly Stakes (G1) heroine Diamondsandrubies.

The sole filly in the trio is by WinStar Farm's Speightstown, though the March-born youngster is out of a listed-placed Kodiak mare and was picked up at last year's Book 2 for 100,000 guineas.

"I like to see some European element in the pedigree of these horses in America. It's a great mix, and I think we're getting back to how things have been before, with U.S. stallions proving influential in Europe," Egan said.

"There's a big mixing of bloodlines out there, and the world is getting very small now."

Panning for gold from the vast Keeneland September Yearling Sale catalog is a strategy that has served Egan well down the years. Previous incarnations of his breeze-up business saw him sell classy types such as Hathal and Strategic, sons of Speightstown and More Than Ready who were sold under the Friarstown Bloodstock banner.

Egan was also responsible for pinhooking the hugely promising Scat Daddy colt Global Prospector, who sold through Mocklershill to Charlie Gordon-Watson for 800,000gns (US\$1,204,392) at last year's Craven. The colt left a big impression when breaking his maiden at the first time of asking at Wolverhampton last month.

"When I bought the Scat Daddy, the hairs stood up on the back of my neck. I couldn't believe I had him," Egan recalled. "I loved everything about him, and it's still very exciting for me even asking about him, finding out how he's going. The thrill I got seeing him winning at Wolverhampton, I was in good humor for three days!"

This year's breeze-up circuit may see Alliance Bloodstock consign 2-year-olds for the first time, but Egan is by no means a rookie to the sales scene. He first rode at the 2-year-old sales at Ascot in 1983, when Bobby O'Ryan and his old boss, Mick O'Toole, brought a lorry load of horses over from Ireland.

"I've always enjoyed the breeze-ups, and it's something I've developed a real passion for over the years," he said. "I've bought and sold horses all my life. My father was the same, albeit in a different area, so it's something I've grown up with."

And with such a wealth of experience comes the acute understanding of how important the preparation period is for these nascent racehorses.

The juveniles under Egan's care have come in for expert handling during their prep, with his son David and Josephine Gordon routinely putting the horses through their paces.

Egan also highlights how big a part his partner, Eimear Donnelly, and Timeform man Dominic Finn have to play in the Alliance Bloodstock process.

"I put everything into these horses, but I'm lucky that I have so many good people around me because you can't do anything on your own, even if you think you can," he said, before adding with a wry smile:

"When this is going on, I'm sure it's not easy living with me!

"Nothing else really matters apart from getting them to the breeze-up in one piece, mentally and physically. They're going to do this for the rest of their lives, so if you take time and care now, you're not going to have problems later on."

Egan began the gradual process of preparing these horses in October, but with 99% of the groundwork done and the Craven Sale breeze now only hours away, the first finishing line of their careers is now in sight.

"It's a lot of pressure," he said when asked to reflect on the process of preparing such a stellar team of breezers.

"Riding in group 1s, that's easy by comparison. Your heart beats a lot faster doing this because you don't stop thinking about it. I've ridden in Derbys and Arcs and Melbourne Cups, and it doesn't come close."

#### Egan On Time

Timing remains a hot topic at the breeze-up sales, with buyers' scrutiny of sectional times recorded during the breeze often, and understandably to a degree, having a major impact on a horse's value in the ring.

While some have claimed this practice is proving detrimental to the breeze-up sale model, Egan takes a pragmatic—if somewhat skeptical—view of the buying aid.

"I'd never time them at home," he said. "When I'm riding them, I'll get a feel for them and know how they're going, what their actions and their minds are like, and, for me, that's the ultimate."

"Obviously, you want to see a horse doing a reasonable breeze, though he doesn't want to be coming up there in 15 minutes! But this thing of judging horses on split-second differences, it wouldn't do it for me."

"It's not going to go away, though, and I don't find it frustrating. I think the real agents and owners, they can see through it. The ones who can't will soon come unstuck."

### MOHAATHER LIKELY TO CONTEST TWO THOUSAND GUINEAS

Mohaather's connections have said he has earned the right to test his group 1 credentials and stamina in the May 4 QIPCO Two Thousand Guineas (G1) at Newmarket after his April 13 success in the Watership Down Stud Greenham Stakes (G3).

The Marcus Tregoning-trained colt's owner, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, will make the final decision after the classic trials at Newmarket this week, but his racing manager, Angus Gold, was upbeat about the possibility April 14.

"He's earned the right to go for the Guineas," Gold said. "He quickened like a fast horse on Saturday and has won two group 3s.

"I spoke to Gaie Johnson Houghton (Mohaather's breeder), and she thought he would get a mile as he's relaxed. I would say Sheikh Hamdan would like to give it a go depending on what happens next week."

If Mohaather proves short in the stamina

department at Newmarket, the plan would be to drop back to his winning trip of seven furlongs for the Jersey Stakes (G3) at Royal Ascot.

Sheikh Hamdan is unlikely to have a contender in the April 17 bet365 Craven Stakes (G3), which is a traditional Guineas trial, despite Almashriq holding an entry in the group 3 over a mile at Newmarket.

"He's more likely to go for the conditions race over (seven furlongs) on Thursday rather than the Craven, but we'll look at both races," Gold said. "He's always been a nice horse but coughed for a long time last year, which held him up, and he didn't run until the all-weather. He's potentially exciting and might want further."

The John Gosden-trained Almashriq, who is generally 33-1 for the Two Thousand Guineas, comfortably justified odds-on favoritism on his debut in a seven-furlong novice race at Newcastle at the beginning of December.

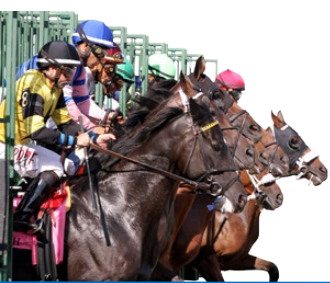

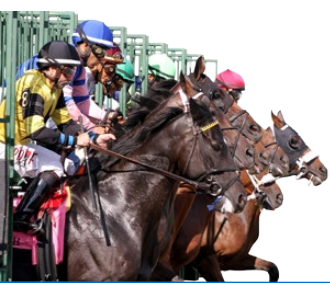
