Nations Pride prevails in the Arlington Million at Colonial Downs

NATIONS PRIDE RALLIES TO WIN ARLINGTON MILLION

Nations Pride, under a confident ride by William Buick, rallied to a 1 3/4-length victory Aug. 11 in the Arlington Million (G1T) at Colonial Downs, seeing off a small but talented cast of rivals.

The 5-year-old son of Teofilo, a Godolphin homebred, scored his fourth North American victory with the trophy to go alongside those from the 2022 Saratoga Derby Invitational (G1T) and Jockey Club Invitational Derby (G3T) and the 2023 Canadian International (G1T) at Woodbine.

He also is a group 1 winner in Germany and scored at the group 3 level in Dubai.

Coming into the Million off a third in the Man o' War Stakes (G2T) at Aqueduct Racetrack and a second in the Manhattan (G1T) at Saratoga Race Course, Buick settled Nations Pride in third while charging down the Colonial Downs backstretch. Long shot Sugoï and jockey Julien Leparoux shot out to a huge lead as they approached the far turn but quickly faded when the stretch run loomed.

Nations Pride willingly took the lead when asked for his run and the only threat was Integration, winner of

last year's Virginia Derby (G3T) and the July 13 local prep for the Million. The Quality Road colt couldn't dent the winner's margin but relegated Ancient Rome and Talk of the Nation to third and fourth.

"Look, he was the best horse in the race and we knew that," Buick said of Nations Pride. "Actually, at Saratoga last Friday I got to ride him for a breeze on the Oklahoma track so I knew he was coming here in great form and he really impressed me.

"He's an exciting horse and he's won four grade 1's now. The leader was getting a lot of rope and he was getting it cheap, so I just wanted to have everything covered as well as I could."

Kendrick Carmouche, aboard Integration, agreed the pace and shape of the race influenced the outcome.

"With turf racing, when you see one horse loose on the lead like that you've got to re-adjust," Carmouche said. "I just had to sit and make my run and I thought he did everything to win the race. I think if it was a bigger field, we would've had a different scenario. He gave me everything. I thought he gave his best effort."

The Million's storied history started in 1981 at then Arlington Park Racecourse in suburban

Chicago and offered the first seven-figure Thoroughbred purse.

John Henry put the event on the map with a dramatic, last-stride victory over The Bart—a finish that was commemorated in a life-size bronze statue that stood on the balcony overlooking the paddock until Arlington was closed after the 2021 season and later demolished.

With the addition of two other grade 1 turf events into the "International Festival of Racing," the Million also helped boost American racing on the international scene. While foreign competition was down for the past two runnings, half of this year's six-horse field had international experience and one, Ancient Rome, shipped from overseas for the event.

"When we came into Virginia (with the purchase of Colonial Downs) it was all about how do we make it world class," Bill Carstanjen, CEO of Churchill Downs Inc., said before calling "Riders Up" for the Million.

Buick gave Carstanjen a vote of confidence in that regard.

"It's a beautiful turf course. This track is world class. The ground is beautiful. It's a very fair track from what I could gather," Buick said. "Obviously there are some very big races here now." **BH**

CARL SPACKLER ACES FIRST GRADE 1 TEST IN FOURSTARDAVE

The New York Racing Association was crafty in pushing back the Fourstardave Handicap (G1T) by a day due to the prospect of a soggy turf course on Aug. 10.

But you can't fool Mother Nature.

So, about five minutes before the Aug. 11 post time for the \$500,000 turf stakes, it... started to rain.

It was basically a quick shower that did not change anything, but it did serve as a reminder of the weather that has been wreaking havoc on racing at Saratoga Race Course, highlighted by the cancelation of the Aug. 9 card and the shifting of the Aug. 3 Saratoga Derby Invitational Stakes (G1T) to Sunday.

The passing shower was gone before the field broke from the gate and the rainbow above the track after the mile stakes neatly summed up what happened when a talented colt finally grabbed the grade 1 laurels that he has seemed destined for since his maiden win.

It also helped put a new twist on a well-known movie line.

"He got the gopher," Bob Edwards said. "He's no longer a Cinderella story."

Edwards' words were a play on the antics of the oddball groundskeeper Carl Spackler in the comedy classic "Caddyshack" but they were also fitting when attached to his homebred 4-year-old colt Carl Spackler.

The four-legged Carl Spackler, who has been chasing a grade 1 win much like the way the movie character futilely tried to stop a gopher from chewing up the golf course, finally bagged his elusive prize as he took down his initial top-level win in his ninth career start.

"We thought early on he could be a grade 1 winner," said Edwards, who owns the Five Racing Thoroughbreds, which campaigns Carl Spackler and Fifth Avenue Bloodstock which bred him. "(Trainer Chad Brown) liked

him early on. He had a nice (maiden) win at Gulfstream and a series of little things that happened to him. He's a resilient horse. He came back from colic surgery to win at Churchill Downs (in May). He looked like a million dollars today and he ran like it."

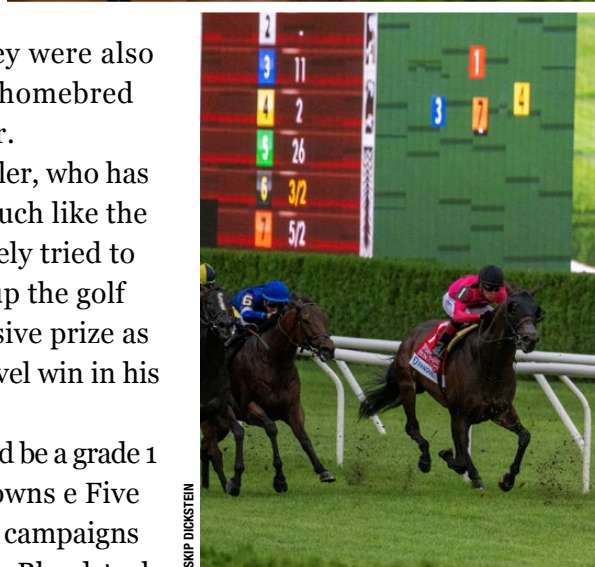
The win also secured an expenses-paid spot in the Nov. 2 Breeders' Cup Mile (G1T) at Del Mar for the son of Lope de Vega as the Fourstardave is part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge "Win and You're In" series.

"I love the Breeders' Cup. My stats are pretty good there," said Edwards, who has a trio of wins at the World Championships.

For Brown, North America's premier turf trainer, it was his first victory in the Fourstardave and leaves him a win in the Belmont Derby Invitational Stakes (G1T) shy of owning wins in all of the New York turf stakes that are now grade 1 status. The four-time Eclipse Award winner captured the Jaipur Stakes (G1T) prior to it becoming a grade 1 stakes.

"It felt good. It's a perfect time for everything. My family and my parents are here, who brought me to the track growing up. We bet on this horse (Fourstardave)," Brown said. "I was telling Acacia (Clement, NYRA broadcaster) 'There's only a couple sure bets when I was a kid growing up here, Bill Mott's birthday, and

Fourstardave winning at the meet.' To win this race, it is really special to have everybody here. I haven't won it because it is a hard race to win, so that makes it even more special. It is a very challenging race to win."

It was a 8 3/4-length maiden win Feb. 25 of last year that put Carl Spackler on the radar for a top-level win. The setbacks kept him from running in a grade 1 stakes but he did notch three grade 2 and 3 wins, including the July 13 Kelso Stakes (G3T) at Saratoga, where he has won four of five starts.

"This sure looked like the horse that was sitting on a big number," said Brown, who indicated Carl Spackler would likely get one more start before the Breeders' Cup. "He was capable of it. He had flirted with running a monster number before. I had a feeling today, and then with just a little bit of cut in the ground, I think he's even just a little bit better. I really felt today would be his day and it was."

In a field of six Strong Quality set the early fractions of :24.76 and :49.24 over good turf with Carl Spackler comfortably chasing in second.

Tyler Gaffalione, Edwards' son-in-law and the husband of his daughter Cassidy, kept Carl Spackler (\$6.10) in second before moving to the front turning for home. In front by 1 1/2 lengths at the eighth pole, he crossed the wire 3 1/2 lengths ahead in 1:36.63 for the mile.

Victory Racing Partners' More Than Looks, making his first start since finishing sixth in the BC Mile, was second. The son of More Than Ready trained by Cherie DeVaux was a length-and-a-half ahead of Godolphin's Ottoman Fleet, a Sea the Stars gelding who was the 3-2 favorite.

For Edwards, there was special satisfaction in winning the grade 1 stakes with a homebred out of the More Than Ready mare Zindaya.

"Zindaya was my first winner and she's been part of the family since we bought her," Edwards said. "She has an Uncle Mo on the ground and a Justify in her belly, and we are looking for great things from her." **BH**

LATE KICK BY CARSON'S RUN DELIVERS SARATOGA DERBY WIN

West Point Thoroughbreds and Steve Bouchey's Carson's Run captured his second grade 1 stakes in the Aug. 11 Saratoga Derby Invitational (G1T) at Saratoga Race Course with an artful last-to-first ride by Dylan Davis.

The 3-year-old son of Cupid tracked in last place for much of the 1 3/16-mile race on the turf course labeled good. But Davis was content to let the chestnut colt bide his time along the rail, while pacesetter Izzy d'Oro set moderate fractions of :23.83, :48.30, and 1:12.98.

The real running commenced as Izzy d'Oro rounded into the second turn with Godolphin's even-money favorite Legend of Time closing in on him after tracking in midpack through the early going. Closely packed exiting the turn, the field fanned out across the top of the stretch and Davis took the opportunity to angle Carson's Run into the middle of the track.

Legend of Time was in full stride and driving with an eighth of a mile to go, fighting off a serious bid along the rail from Besilu Stables' Royal Majesty. Flavien Prat and Legend of Time had just put away Royal Majesty with a sixteenth of a mile to go when Carson's Run came flying to his outside and rocketed to a three-quarters of a length victory. The win was Davis' second for the day.

"Great race, very good ride from Dylan," said trainer Christophe Clement, who also saddled third-place finisher Deterministic. "He knows the horse very well, he has been working him many, many times the last two months. (Carson's Run) is a little bit peculiar. He had a very funny start at Aqueduct in the spring, so we have been working on it. Obviously, he loved the ground. When he is right, he has a spectacular turn of foot like he showed today."

West Point and Bouchey acquired Carson's Run through L.E.B. agent David Ingordo, who bought the colt for \$170,000 from Randy Miles at the 2023 Ocala Breeders' Spring 2-Year-Olds in Training Sale.

"I guess that's the beautiful thing about the partners and in particular David Ingordo our bloodstock agent," said West Point CEO Terry Finley. "We go to the sales and we have the freedom to take shots and to buy horses that other people don't buy. Often times they

don't work out, but when they work out like this, there's a sweetness to this business that you can't match in anything else in life that you do."

For Davis who grew up in Saratoga, this race was especially sweet as his first grade 1 win in the United States and most importantly in New York. The rider could now get the chance to land a group 1 win in Australia because the race offers the winner a free berth to the Oct. 26 AU\$5 million Cox Plate (G1) at Moonee Valley Race Course.

"I'll go anywhere he goes. He's an incredible horse and I know him very well, and he's capable of anything," Davis said.

Clement was reserved about a potential start in the Cox Plate, noting that both Carson's Run and Deterministic will be nominated to the \$2.5 million Nashville Derby Aug. 31 at Kentucky Downs.

"It's a little quick back, only three weeks, so we will see how they come out of this one first," he said. **BH**

MOIRA VICTORIOUS AS CANADIAN CHAMPS DUEL IN BEVERLY D.

Virginia racing fans at Colonial Downs Aug. 11 were treated to a duel of Canadian Horse of the Years as the sixth meeting between 2022 winner Moira and 2023 winner Fev Rover came down to the final jumps of the \$500,000 Beverly D. Stakes (G2T), with Moira emerging victorious.

"It's always nerve-wracking when you hook Fev Rover. She's a great horse and (trainer) Mark (Casse) has done a great job with her" said Moira's trainer Kevin Attard. "I think Fev Rover gets the edge over us on softer ground but Moira prefers harder turf."

Despite being down 3-2 in their head-to-head matchup, Moira exited the starting gate as the favorite while settling off the pace in third. Fev Rover aimed to repeat her frontrunning victory in the 2023 Beverly D. but was pestered by Libban through fractions of :23.56, :49.22, and 1:12.69.

Moira jumped on even terms with her rival around the far turn but suddenly again fell a length behind as they straightened into the stretch. Digging in gamely for jockey Jose Ortiz, Moira pulled alongside with a sixteenth to go and cleared her rival by a head at the wire, equaling their rivalry at three apiece. Neece Marie finished third.

Moira stopped the clock in 1:54.80 for the 1 3/16 miles and paid \$3.40 to win.

"She's always been a special horse to us," said Attard. "It's nice to see her reel off consecutive races of consistency against top-quality horses.

Picking up the second graded victory of her career, Moira improved her record to 6-5-2 from 15 starts for earnings of \$1,823,999. At the 2023 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Mixed Sale, Moira sold for \$3 million and now races for Lanni Bloodstock, Madaket Stables, and SF Racing.

Bred by Adena Springs, Moira becomes the fifth individual graded winner for sire Ghostzapper this season, who stood the 2024 season for a fee of \$75,000 at Hill 'n' Dale Farms near Paris, Ky.

As part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge Series, Moira now holds an automatic berth and free entry to the \$2 million Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf (G1T) at Del Mar Nov. 2, a race she finished third in last year.

"That's where we're heading," Attard said before adding that her final prep will likely take place in the \$750,000

E.P. Taylor Stakes (G1T) at her home track of Woodbine Sept. 14.

Trikari Finds His Game
in Secretariat

Following a nail-biting victory at 1 3/16 miles in the July 6 Belmont Derby (G1T) at Aqueduct Racetrack, Trikari's return to a shorter one-mile distance provided his most visually impressive win yet, cruising to a 2 1/4-length victory in the \$500,000 Secretariat Stakes (G2T) at Colonial Downs.

"I think as he matures now and has to run against older horses...I think this (one mile) is really going to be his game," said Graham Motion, trainer of Trikari.

The one-mile distance had previously caused the colt's lone loss in stakes company when third by a neck in the May 31 Penn Mile (G3T), but jockey John Velazquez settled him comfortably in the middle of the six-horse field.

Following easy fractions of :24.24, :48.26, and 1:11.98, Trikari pounced on the pacesetters on the far turn, getting a jump on favored Brilliant Berti who chased Trikari home but could put no dent in the space between them. In a Jam was four lengths further back in third.

Trikari stopped the clock in 1:34.92 while paying \$5 to win.

"Down the backside, he was so relaxed. When (Velazquez) asked him, he just took off," Motion said. "Johnny was super impressed with his turn of foot."

Motion said he has been trying not to think about the Breeders' Cup with Trikari, as the colt is just 3 years old, but a start at Keeneland against older rivals is likely in the cards.

A five-time winner in eight starts, Trikari broke millionaire status with his third graded victory Sunday, increasing his total to \$1,303,530 for Amerman Racing.

Bred in Kentucky by Michael Slezak and Amy Boll, Trikari picked up a sixth graded victory this season for the offspring of Oscar Performance, who stood for a fee of \$25,000 at Mill Ridge Farm near Lexington in 2024. **BH**

GETAWAY CAR ELUDES THE FIELD IN BEST PAL STAKES

Perhaps Taylor Swift was wrong. Her song "Getaway Car" opens with the declaration, "No, nothin' good starts in a getaway car." But the colt named after the song might change her opinion. And with more starts like the Aug. 11 Best Pal Stakes (G3) at Del Mar, maybe Getaway Car will have throngs of admirers singing his praises down the road.

Living up to his name, the 2-year-old son of Curlin bolted out of the starting gate and made easy work of the other three runners lined up with him, winning by 5 1/2 lengths.

"It's a cool name because that's the way he runs," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He just gets away from there. He goes; he has a lot of natural speed. He has a beautiful way of moving. His maiden here was very impressive and today was very impressive.

"He was bred to go distance so he should get better with age."

Owned by SF Racing, Starlight Racing, Madaket Stables Stonestreet Stables, Dianne Bashor, Determined Stables, Robert Masterson, Tom Ryan, Waves Edge Capital, and

Catherine Donovan, the dark brown colt improves to 2-0-0 from two starts. He won his maiden over the same track in a similar gate-to-wire fashion, reaching the wire 3 1/4 lengths ahead of his nearest foe. He's earned \$135,000.

With Juan Hernandez, who entered the day with a comfortable lead as the Del Mar meet's leading rider, Getaway Car posted fractional times of :22.20, :45.77, and :57.77. He closed out the six furlongs in 1:10.73.

Mischief River, White Sands, and Tiz Happy rounded out the order of finish. Getaway Car paid \$2.60 on a \$2 win ticket.

Baffert said the Sept. 8 \$300,000 Del Mar Futurity (G1) is the nearest target for his pupil with perhaps a return to Del Mar in November for the Breeders' Cup.

"If the Futurity comes up, it'll be the next obvious spot for him if all goes well," said Baffert. "We're looking to get a few more in between now and (Breeders' Cup)."

Bred in Kentucky by Blue Heaven Farm and Curlin Syndicate, Getaway Car has hit the sales ring twice. Most recently he was purchased for \$700,000 by SF Bloodstock, Starlight Racing, and Madaket Stables out of the Gainesway consignment at the 2023 Keeneland September Yearling Sale. The year before, he was a \$300,000 purchase by FMQ Stables at the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale out of the Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency consignment.

Getaway Car is out of the Morning Line mare Surrender Now. Curlin stood the 2024 season for \$250,000 at Hill 'n' Dale Farms near Paris, Ky. BH

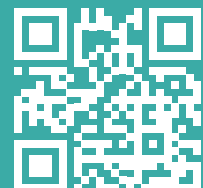

Racing at Colonial Downs

VIRGINIA DERBY JOINS ROAD TO THE KENTUCKY DERBY IN 2025

Edited Press Release

Colonial Downs announced Aug. 11 that the 2025 Virginia Derby has earned the distinction as a qualifying race on the Road to the Kentucky Derby. Virginia governor Glenn Youngkin announced the landmark event for Virginia horse racing from the winner's circle at Colonial Downs alongside Churchill Downs Inc. CEO Bill Carstanjen and Churchill Downs board chairman Alex Rankin.

"Churchill Downs has worked with partners throughout the Commonwealth to reinvigorate Virginia's proud legacy of Thoroughbred racing and secure our place as a world-class destination for racing fans and equine talent from around the world," said Youngkin. "The future for Thoroughbred racing in Virginia has never been brighter and this opportunity will allow us to shine on horseracing's biggest stage."

The Virginia Derby (G3T) has traditionally been a turf race that signified the culmination of the summer racing season. This year's Virginia Derby, along with live entertainment and family-friendly activities, will be held as scheduled Sept. 7.

Next year, as part of the Road to the Kentucky Derby, the Virginia Derby will transition to the dirt track and be held March 15, 2025, anchoring a new four-day spring meet at Colonial Downs. The winning horse will earn 50 qualifying points and likely be guaranteed a post position in the starting gate for the May 3 Kentucky Derby (G1) at Churchill Downs. Based on point allocations for 2024,

second through fifth-place finishers would receive points on a 25-15-10-5 scale.

Virginia Speaker of the House Don Scott shared his enthusiasm for the announcement, saying, "It is exciting that the Road to the Kentucky Derby will now run through Virginia. Churchill Downs has elevated the stature and economic impact of Thoroughbred racing in the Commonwealth while creating jobs, generating significant tax revenue in communities around the state, and offering race fans a memorable experience at the track."

"We are thankful for the investment of Churchill Downs in the Virginia horseracing industry. In 2025, Colonial Downs will race 47 days which is up from 27 days in 2022, the last race meet before Churchill Downs acquired Colonial Downs," said Virginia's Secretary of Agriculture Matthew Lohr. "Besides adding prestigious and lucrative races for horsemen, more race days drive significant economic impact throughout Virginia's entire agricultural sector leading to a healthy breeding industry, stronger equine infrastructure, and more employment opportunities across the Commonwealth."

"Today's announcement is not only exciting for tourism in our district," said delegate Amanda Batten, "but also demonstrates a commitment to horseracing that will ensure Colonial Downs is a premier destination for generations to come."

Dates for the Colonial Downs spring meet are contingent on approval of the Virginia Racing Commission.

SANDMAN IMPRESSIVE IN SARATOGA MSW WIN

Enter, Sandman.

The two-year-old colt owned by D J Stable, St. Elias Stable, West Point Thoroughbreds, and CJ Stables has a long way to go before he reaches Mariano Rivera status, but he showed the promise of an elite athlete in winning a maiden special weight at Saratoga Race Course on July 11.

The son of Tapit was consigned by Tom McCrocklin as part of the Lothenbach dispersal of horses of racing age at Fasig-Tipton in February, following the death of Robert Lothenbach the previous November. Though sold at the OBS March Sale of 2-year-olds in training, Sandman did not breeze for potential buyers, galloping instead.

"When Mr. Lothenbach died," said McCrocklin, "there was a last-minute decision to put virtually all the horses in the 2-year-old sales. The mandate that I got from the estate that they would not breeze. They would only gallop. He was already broken and in training, so potential buyers got to see him over the racetrack."

Though the lack of a speed drill didn't exactly deter buyers from bidding the colt up to \$1.2 million, McCrocklin suspects that a breeze might have pushed the price even higher.

"Call me crazy," said the consignor, "but I think if we had breezed him, I'm very confident that he would have brought even more, maybe double."

The partnership that bought him was obviously impressed enough by what they saw, even without the breeze, to go to seven figures for Sandman.

"He was just so athletic-looking," said Tom Bellhouse, executive vice president of West Point Thoroughbreds. "Plus his pedigree and conformation, and you've got to just take a swing once in a while."

"The horses were sold without reserves, and the Lothenbachs weren't bidding," said McCrocklin. "So it was a true market value situation, and he sold very, very well. He was on everybody's radar as a really nice colt with a huge pedigree."

Sandman breaks his maiden at Saratoga Race Course

Bred by Lothenbach Stables, Sandman is out of the Distorted Humor mare Distorted Music and a half brother to She Can't Sing (Bernardini), the winner of the 2022 Chilukki Stakes (G3) who earned \$883,558.

The gray/roan colt went directly from the sale to trainer Mark Casse's Ocala, Fla., farm, where he quickly made up for any lost training time.

"I'd say within 10 days, I breezed him," said Casse. "He's an athlete. When I breezed him three-eighths, he worked so good that I went to a half-mile, and he was just boom, boom, boom. That's what good horses do."

"I think he got a little frazzled," said Casse. "Everyone he worked with, he ran away from. I don't put a whole lot of emphasis on the first race. What happens in training is different from what happens on the racetrack. Every horse reacts differently to kickback."

He pointed out that another of his 2-year-olds, And One More Time (Omaha Beach), finished seventh in her first start, also at Churchill, also as the favorite, then came back to win by 4 3/4 lengths at Saratoga Aug. 8.

In the Saratoga race, Sandman broke from post 2 under Dylan Davis and sat a perfect trip along the rail, coming around the final turn straight into open running room, and cruised to the wire in 1:23.62 for seven furlongs.

"Just a perfect effort," said Bellhouse. "He stayed inside and took some dirt, and he was so professional."

"He's a big, classy, long-striding horse, and I love what he did (at Saratoga)," said McCrocklin. "They let him find an early position and save ground, and he got into his stride and his rhythm, and he was very composed and measured at the end. He's a proper horse with a bright, bright future." **BH**

GROSS SALES UP AS FASIG-TIPTON NEW YORK-BRED SALE OPENS

Two colts by grade 1-winning Kentucky sires led the first session of the Fasig-Tipton sale of preferred New York-bred yearlings, purchased by buyers with deep ties to New York racing.

Hip 315 is a Constitution (Tapit) colt out of the Forestry mare See the Forest and sold for \$300,000 to West Bloodstock, agent for Repole Stable. Consigned by ELiTe, agent, the colt was bred by Ten Strike Racing.

See the Forest was claimed by Ten Strike and hip 315 is the first foal they've bred that they've sold. The mare has produced three stakes winners and five runners to earn more than \$200,000.

"We've always bred to race," said Clay Sanders, co-founder of Ten Strike Racing. "She's done so well for us, we'd figured take a shot with a commercial stallion, and if the baby came out looking good, we'd sell him."

"He's by Constitution," said Jacob West, explaining why he was willing to go to \$300,000 for the colt. "(Owner) Mike (Repole) loves supporting the New York program, and we've had a lot of luck with Constitution, so it made a lot of sense right now to do it."

Constitution stood the 2024 season at WinStar Farm for \$110,000, quite the contrast to Galilean (Uncle Mo), the other stallion that West went to six figures for.

Hip 350 is by the first-crop yearling stallion that stands at Hidden Lake Farm in New York for \$3,500. From the consignment of Eaton Sales, agent, the colt was bred by Blue Chip Bloodstock, and West purchased him for \$220,000.

"Welcome to Repole Stables," said West with a grin, by way of explaining the range of pedigrees he purchased. "I told Mike that if I'd stood this horse up and said that he was by Uncle Mo, he'd have brought (at least twice) what he brought tonight. Galilean was a pretty talented horse in his own right, and well bred."

Added Ed Rosen, who is part of a team that works with Repole at sales, "I love the female family."

Hip 350 is out of the Ireland-bred Three Am Tour.

The first session of the two-day sale concluded with 66 horses selling for a total of \$6,860,000, a 14% increase over last year's first-session gross. The average price was \$103,939, a 2% decrease over the 2023 session, and the median also fell, from \$100,000 to \$89,000. The RNA rate decreased by 6% and 29 horses sold for at least \$100,000.

"We're off to an excellent start," said Fasig-Tipton president and chief executive officer Boyd Browning. "There was consistent trade from start to finish, and I'm encouraged by the drop in the buy-back rate, which is traditionally high at this sale because of the opportunities that New York breeders have to race."

"Most of the people that I talked to on the sales grounds thought there were a little bit higher percentage of good horses (Monday) than today," he continued. "I'm looking forward to a very strong catalog (Monday)."

Trainer Christophe Clement bought the other \$300,000 yearling, a Vekoma (Candy Ride) colt out of the Shackleford mare Alana's Allure. Sold as a weanling for \$100,000 to Good Luck Farm, the chestnut colt was bred by Cheryl A. Prudhomme and Dr. Michael Gallivan and sold from the consignment of Taylor Made, agent.

"He looks fast," said Clement, grinning. "It's probably too much money, but I'm keeping the dream alive. My son Miguel told me about him, and I bought him on spec, so now I need to find some owners to support me and go from there.

"You always overspend on what you like. This is a very strong sale, and I'm glad that we got in." **BH**

RACING AND GAMING CONFERENCE WILL DISCUSS TIMELY ISSUES

At a time with no shortage of legal issues for racing, the three-day Racing and Gaming Conference at Saratoga will open Aug. 12.

The timely racing-involved topics scheduled to be discussed include the ongoing litigation involving the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority while also touching on topics about how the sport is regulated or officiated. One panel will discuss if the sport needs more communication between its stewards and fans to keep up with trends in other sports.

Several of the panels promise to dig deeper into some interesting topics. For instance, the HISA panel that gets things started Monday also will look at if the sport can expect some savings on the regulatory side as HISA takes over some regulatory responsibilities from states. The panel of four executive directors from prominent state regulators—California, Florida, New York, and Texas—are scheduled to discuss any changes they've made.

"Have the state regulators downsized? Have they laid off staff, cut their budgets, or decreased their title on the industry? Regulators from across the country will discuss how they are adapting to the new HISA world order," reads the topic description.

Other racing-related topics scheduled for the conference include on Tuesday a look at some of the sport's success stories, including the new Belmont Park being constructed in New York, the success of historical horse racing in Kentucky, and promising plans in Maryland. That panel is scheduled to include New York Racing Association CEO and president David O'Rourke as well as Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association CEO and chairman Alan Foreman.

On Wednesday the conference will look at pari-mutuel wagering issues, specifically tied to international pools, and a second panel will examine how horse racing fits in the emerging sports wagering market.

That latter panel will discuss if horse racing can find a seat at the sports wagering table. The description notes that, "Horseplayers and, more importantly, industry executives view wagering on horse racing as the original and ultimate in sports betting. On the other hand, many sports bettors and sports wagering executives view betting on horse racing as something

to do when 'real' sports are not being offered. In other words, content filler, falling somewhere between volleyball and cricket. All of this plays out in negotiations over price and integration. Are racetracks overvaluing their product or are sportsbooks undervaluing horse racing? Will the horse racing industry ever accept a niche player role on a much larger platform or is the future a more finely tuned and more competitive horse-racing-only platform? Sportsbook operators will share their insight."

Patrick Brown, co-founder of the Racing and Gaming Conference, will provide some opening remarks to begin the conference at 2 p.m. ET Monday at the Saratoga Hilton. Jason Werth, a former major league all-star and a co-owner of Belmont Stakes (G1) winner Dornoch, will deliver the event's keynote speech Tuesday. **BH**

American Patriot wins the 2017 Maker's 46 Mile Stakes at Keeneland

A total of 1,265 Japanese-bred yearlings are cataloged for the Hidaka Breeders Association Summer Sale, which begins Aug. 19.

While the sale was conducted over five days in past years, the HBA decided to expand to six days this year as they received more entries. The sale is conducted at Shizunai on Hokkaido Island.

American Patriot, winner of the 2017 Maker's 46 Mile Stakes (G1T) who has been standing at Darley Japan since 2018, sends the most yearlings of any stallion in the sale at 42. One of them, Hip 984, is a colt out of Grace Nico. His second dam, Delmonico Cat, won the 2004 Honey Fox Handicap (G3T) and was bought by Shadai Farm at the 2006 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale for \$450,000.

Kitasan Black, leading sire at the Japan Racing Horse Association Select Sale in July, is represented by three yearlings, including Hip 965, a colt out of Outsmart. Sweettrickydancer, the colt's second dam, won the 2003 Tropical Park Oaks and 2022 Hollywood Wildcat Stakes.

Hip 349, an American Pharoah colt, is one of two yearlings by the American stallion in the catalog and is the first foal out of European winner Sunset Kiss.

Graduates of the HBA Summer Sale are performing well. National Association of Racing's 2023 Horse of the Year Igniter and champion 3-year-old colt Mick Fire were both bought at the Summer Sale as was Tulip Sho (G2) winner Sweep Feet. **BH**

CHARYN ACCELERATES TO UNSTOPPABLE JACQUES LE MAROIS WIN

Charyn staked his claim to be the best miler in Europe Aug. 11 as he added the Prix Jacques le Marois (G1) to his victory in the Queen Anne Stakes (G1). The Irish-bred will now have a chance to prove himself the best miler in the world as his victory earned him an automatic berth and free entry to the \$2 million Breeders' Cup Mile (G1T) at Del Mar Nov. 2

thanks to the Breeders' Cup Challenge Series.

Charyn's second burst of acceleration at the furlong pole was the equivalent of a powerful shot curled into the very top corner of the net. Unstoppable.

Settled on the shoulder of perennial trailblazer Big Rock, jockey Silvestre de Sousa was always traveling supremely well and Charyn's final sectionals were those of a top-class horse as he recorded 1:33.98, the fastest time for the Marois since 2013, putting a yawning three lengths between himself and Metropolitan while Inspiral, who spotted the field five lengths at the start, managed to finish third.

Trainer Roger Varian admitted Charyn's success had brought a tear to his eye.

"I don't know what to say, he made me cry, he's such a beautiful horse," said Varian, whose confidence in Charyn never wavered during a 3-year-old career in which the son of Dark Angel was often pitched in against a more mature 3-year-old in Paddington.

Varian had seemed like he was still processing the victory at Ascot but now, in the narrow confines of the Deauville winner's enclosure, he was sure of the trajectory on which this ball of grey grace and speed is taking he and owner-breeder Nurlan Bizakov.

"I think we needed to see that at Ascot because we all felt he put up an incredible performance in the Lockinge," said Varian. "For him to win at Ascot I think was most

important. I guess today was about backing up what he did there, which was equally important. There are no soft races at this level and he just seems to be getting better and better.

For Bizakov, Deauville must seem to hold a special kind of charm this year, as Charyn's group 1 success followed just seven days after his Lazzat took the Prix Maurice de Gheest (G1) in similarly emphatic fashion.

For De Sousa there was a weight of expectation before the race and he batted away any notion that it had all appeared plain sailing from the stands.

"I haven't felt that pressure in a long time," he said. "Today I felt like I really wanted to win the race for the horse and for the Varian team—they're working so hard behind the scenes. I felt pressure today, but it's

a good thing that when you're riding a good horse it makes it look very easy.

"There were a lot of talented horses there and he's a talented horse, but at the same time we have to make him work hard to get his head in front. It looked like he won so easily, but the horse gives everything. When you come to a group 1, you come to a war and it's never easy."
